Request (U)

1. (U) Attached please find a copy of a request for information from the House Select Committee on Assassinations dated 19 January 1978.

Notes taken from your material by Committee staff should be classified at the highest level of the material being reviewed and each staffer should sign a log sheet indicating access to the material. 3. (U) Committee staff will generate summary reports based upon their file review and notes. After sanitization, the reports will be transmitted to the Committee, classified, if necessary, at the highest level of classification appropriate.

4. (U) Advise me if you are unable to respond within a reasonable time or if you have any questions regarding our procedures for dealing with the Committee.


