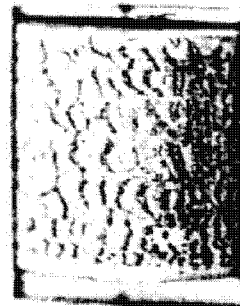
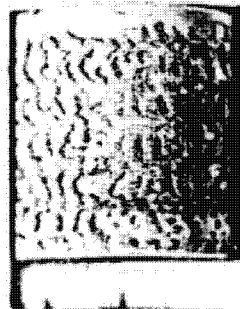

Excerpts from CIA Documents

64 documents destroyed in 1974. Dir. Colby said CIA had no business keeping files on American citizens.

Mail Intercept

1. Letter dtd 6/14/63 from 16 year old American Black girl, ~~attending~~ attending sch in Moscow, to King in City jail, Birmingham. Expressed concern of racial injustice and offered to help.
2. Letter from trade union (AUCCU) forwarding copy of statement published by Union and expressing confidence in Negro working people's struggle.
3. Three other letters of condolence to Mrs. King.
