Subject as ERIC STARVO GALT stayed alone at the Hotel Rio, Room 212, Morelos 86, Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Mexico, October 19 to November 6, 1967. On November 7, 1967, GALT checked into the Hotel "Tropicana" in Puerto Vallarta, occupied Room 417, and checked out on November 13, 1967.

There were no telephone toll charges for GALT at either hotel.

Leads to contact relatives of Mrs. MAC ARTHUR were left to the discretion of OO in view of which, and since investigation subsequent to the preparation of retel has established the subject sought in the captioned assassination is in fact JAMES EARL RAY who assumed the alias ERIC STARVO GALT, - it would not appear coverage of the lead set forth in retel is in order.

No further inquiries are contemplated unless a request therefor is received from Memphis and the lead at Springfield is considered covered.
