INVESTIGATION HAS BEEN CONDUCTED BY CHICAGO, SPRINGFIELD, ST. LOUIS, AND KANSAS CITY OFFICES IN UNPRODUCTIVE EFFORT TO LOCATE THIS FUGITIVE. KANSAS CITY IS INSTITUTING A FULL AND COMPLETE REINVESTIGATION IN AN EFFORT TO DEVELOP BACKGROUND DATA, RELATIVES, AND ASSOCIATES OF SUBJECT, WHO MIGHT BE IN A POSITION TO ASSIST IN HIS LOCATION.

IN THIS CONNECTION, JAMES EARL RAY AND WALTER TERRY RIFE ON MARCH SEVEN, FIFTY-FIVE, BURGLARIZED THE U. S. POST OFFICE AT KELLERVILLE, ILL., AND STOLE SIXTY-SIX BLANK U. S. POSTAL MONEY ORDERS WHICH THEY PASSED DURING MARCH, FIFTY-FIVE, IN NUMEROUS STATES, WITH THE RESULT THAT BOTH WERE SENTENCED IN U.S.D.C., KANSAS CITY, MO., ON JULY ONE, FIFTY-FIVE, TO USP, LEAVENWORTH, END PAGE TWO

KANSAS. SUBJECT RAY HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS A LONER AND RIFE APPARENTLY IS ONE OF HIS FEW CLOSE ASSOCIATES, SUGGESTING POSSIBILITY THEY COULD HAVE BEEN ASSOCIATES IN MURDER OF DR. AN ARCHITECTURAL DRAFTSMAN FROM NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, AND JEFFERY COHN FROM FARMINGDALE, LONG ISLAND, NEW YORK, A STUDENT ATTENDING GEORGE WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY, WASHINGTON, D. C., ANSWERED AD AND ALL THREE MET STOUT AT SEVENTH AND MARKET STREETS, SAN FRANCISCO FOR TRIP TO NEW YORK AND BOSTON.

STOUT ALLEGEDLY EMPLOYEE NATIONAL CAR RENTAL COMPANY, SAN FRANCISCO OR OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA, AND WAS RETURNING A SIXTY SIX CHEVROLET IMPALA BEARING LICENSE PLATE PSJ NINE ZERO SEVEN TO BOSTON, MASS.

IMMEDIATELY UPON DEPARTING SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA, STOUT DISPLAYED A VERY OBSESSIVE ATTITUDE TOWARD THE NEGRO AND JEWISH RACES. HE STATED "WE MIGHT AS WELL KILL SOME NIGGERS ON THE WAY". DURING TRIP STOUT INDICATED HE HAD THREE FIFTY SEVEN MAGNUM REVOLVER IN THE TRUNK OF HIS AUTOMOBILE

DURING THE ENTIRE TRIP FROM SAN FRANCISCO TO KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, STOUT CONTINUOUSLY TALKED AGAINST THE NEGRO AND JEWISH RACES MENTIONING THAT DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING AND ALL THE OTHER "NIGGERS" SHOULD BE KILLED OR SENT BACK TO AFRICA.

STOUT LEFT LINDH AND HIS TRAVELING COMPANIONS OFF AT THE YMCA, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AND GIVE THE EXCUSE THAT HE HAD TO DO SOMETHING TO THE AUTOMOBILE DEPARTED, AND NEVER RETURNED.

LINDH IMMEDIATELY LEFT FOR BOSTON, MASS., ARRIVING THERE BEFORE STOUT AND WHEN STOUT ARRIVED AT THE NATIONAL CAR RENTAL, LOGAN AIRPORT, BOSTON, HE, LINDH, HAD STOUT DETAINED HOWEVER, NO CHARGES WERE PLACED AGAINST STOUT.

LINDH ADVISED STOUT CLAIMED MEMBERSHIP IN THE TEAMSTER UNION AND A TELEPHONE CALL BY LINDH TO DETROIT, MICHIGAN, VERIFIED HIS MEMBERSHIP.

Investigation indicated RAY concealed himself in a bread box and escaped from a truck making delivery to an auxiliary farm. RAY was serving 20 years on a charge of Armed Robbery - First Degree and for Operating a Vehicle without Owner's Consent. On 7/20/67, a Federal complaint was authorized by AUSA WILLIAM A. KITCHEN, Western District of Missouri, Kansas City, Mo., which was filed before the USC, Jefferson City, Mo., charging RAY with violation of Title 18, Section 1073, U.S. Code. Warrant was issued.

JAMES EARL RAY and WALTER TERRY RIFE on 3/7/55, burglarized the U. S. Post Office at Kellerville, Ill., and stole 66 blank U. S. Postal Money Orders which they passed during March, 1955, in numerous states, with the result that both were sentenced in USDC, Kansas City, Mo., on 7/1/55, to USP, Leavenworth, Kansas. Subject RAY has been described as a loner and RIFE apparently is one of his few close associates, suggesting possibility they could have been associates in murder of DR. KING, and investigation also instituted in Kansas City airtel to Springfield 3/11/68 to develop background information regarding RIFE and to locate him for interview.

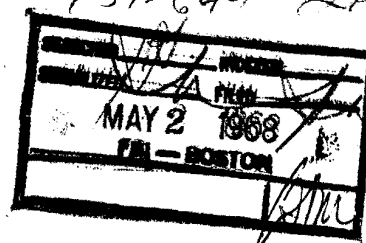

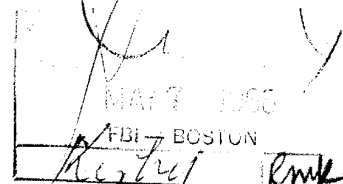

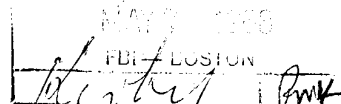
