JAMES EARL RAY, Inmate, Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, escaped from the Penitentiary on 4/23/67. Investigation indicated RAY concealed himself in a bread box and escaped from a truck making delivery to an auxiliary farm. RAY was serving 20 years on a charge of Armed Robbery - First Degree and for Operating a Vehicle without Owner's Consent. On 7/20/67, a Federal complaint was authorized by AUSA WILLIAM A. KITCHEN, Western District of Missouri, Kansas City, Mo., which was filed before the USC, Jefferson City, Mo., charging RAY with violation of Title 18, Section 1073, U.S. Code. Warrant was issued.

JAMES EARL RAY and WALTER TERRY RIFE on 3/7/55, burglarized the U. S. Post Office at Kellerville, Ill, and stole 66 blank U. S. Postal Money Orders which they passed during March, 1955, in numerous states, with the result that both were sentenced in USDC, Kansas City, Mo., on 7/1/55, to USP, Leavenworth, Kansas. Subject RAY has been described as a loner and RIFE apparently is one of his few close associates, suggesting possibility they could have been associates in murder of DR. KING, and investigation also instituted in Kansas City airtel to Springfield 3/11/68 to develop background information regarding RIFE and to locate him for interview.

SHIELDS was employed from 3/28/68 to 4/1/68, as a bellboy. Talking to SHIKLDS, BLONSTROM larned that he was divorced and was contemplating re-marriage. He reportedly had several children. He seems to recall SHIELDS mentioned sometime about going to Tennessee, but the name of the city is unknown.

BLONSTROM was unable to locate the employment application for SHIKLDS and admitted his records were extremely disorganized. His motel has highly transient help and in fact the supervisor for SHIELDS at the time has since departed. BLONSTROM viewed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT and said he did not believe this photograph was identical to SHIKLDS. He indicated SHIKLDS has more hollow cheeks and a wider mose, although the hairline and eyes are similar.
