He further stated that the man appeared very nervous and made the comment that it seemed cold here indicating, according to GROSS, that the man was new to the area. He advised that the vehicle bore Colorado License PM7888.

The individual was wearing a black sweater and GROSS said that he fit the description of GALT.

**HOLLYWOOD** — Eric Starvo Galt, prime suspect in the murder of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., emerged Thursday as:

—A fervent supporter of the presidential bid of former Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace.

—An anti-Negro who once got into a wild argument at a Hollywood cocktail lounge with a girl who defended Negroes.

—A man who made at least one mysterious trip in recent months to New Orleans, a fact which appears to be of great interest to the FBI.

—A steady drinker, alternately

moody and contentious in public.

This picture came into focus as the result of a series of exclusive interviews conducted by the Los Angeles Times with persons who knew Galt when he lived here.

**ALIAS SUSPECTED**

A songwriter whom Galt drove to New Orleans and back in a white Mustang in December said he had a strong impression that the suspect was not using his right name.

The statement was made by Charles Stein, 38, who was offered the free ride after he agreed to add his signature to the drive by Wallace to qualify for a place on the California June primary ballot.

Stein and his sister, Rita, made the arrangements. While at the Sultan Room, a lounge

at 5533½ Hollywood Blvd., she had let it be known that her two children had to return soon from her sister's place in New Orleans. Galt let it be known that he would be going there.

Stein appeared at the Sultan Room that same night and Galt agreed to take him along to fetch the children if Stein would sign up for Wallace.

The next day, Stein said, Galt picked him up at the sister's home and drove him to the Wallace headquarters.

"I thought he was some kind of politician," Stein recalled. "I got the impression they all knew him."

**VIEW DISPUTED**

Robert Walters, campaign coordinator for Wallace in California, disputed this. "We checked all of our name files here — particularly those from

the North Hollywood office — and found nothing under the name of Galt or the other names he reportedly used," Walters said.

Stein said that after he had registered for Wallace's American Independent party, he and Galt departed that afternoon on the two-day trip to New Orleans.

Galt did not disclose why he was making the drive. He told his passenger he "knew some people there." He said he had been there before.

While passing through Texas, according to the songwriter, Galt made several long-distance calls from phone booths, but declined to discuss any of them.

Stein said Galt went to uncommon pains to impress upon him his name, emphasizing it in unnecessary ways, such as when they checked in at motels.

"I think he was establishing a fictitious identity," Stein said. "I got these vibrations. I don't think it was his real name."

Galt told his passenger he had just sold a bar in Mexico. "I didn't believe it," Stein said. "His Spanish was too touristy."

During the drive the suspect also remarked that he liked to hunt, Stein said.

Stein said he believes the suspect made a subsequent trip to New Orleans. "I heard he was asking people if they wanted him to drop anything off while he was down there," Stein said.

Stein said FBI agents have been visiting him almost every day, showing great interest in the suspect's activities in New Orleans.

He said, however, that he and Galt went their separate ways while in that city, and he had no idea what his companion was up to.

At the time of the trip, Galt was staying in a Los Angeles apartment. Residents there either did not know or remained tight-lipped about him.

However, Galt subsequently moved to a hotel, the St. Francis, at 5533 Hollywood Blvd. One block away is a cocktail lounge known as the Rabbits Foot Club.

The crowd there remembers Eric Starvo Galt very well.

Until three or four weeks ago, according to bartender Bob Del Monte, Galt was a nightly patron.

He would come in at around 9 p.m., perch on a stool near the door and order the first of several screwdrivers (vodka and orange juice).

Adele Lewis, who was working there at the time, recalled that Galt often got into arguments when he tried to strike up conversations.

"He once asked if he could buy me a drink," she said.

"Since I was working, I said no."

"Huh, you think you're too good," Galt bristled.

#### DISPUTE RECALLED

But the thing everybody at the Rabbits Foot Club remembers most about Galt is the big dispute he got into.

Jim Morrison, who was the bartender that night, recalled that Galt had begun talking with a young woman named Pattie. Somehow the conversation turned to Negroes, and she declared them to be "good people."

Suddenly, Galt began dragging her by the arm toward the door.

"I'll drop you off in Watts and we'll see how you like it there," Galt shouted.

Del Monte said another customer who had been dating the girl followed the pair outside, and Galt fled.

A short time later, according to Del Monte, a Negro was struck in the head by a rock while in a nearby parking lot. Morrison remembered that as Galt would sit at the bar sipping his screwdriver, he often preached his support of Wallace.

"He's the man we want," the bartender quoted Galt as saying.

Del Monte said Galt once tried to begin a conversation with a Negro girl, but that she walked away from him.

Nobody interviewed at the Rabbits Foot Club remembered Galt furnishing his name. In fact, nobody realized who he was until his picture appeared in newspapers on Thursday.

Del Monte said the photo of Galt with his eyes closed caused an immediate recollection.

"That's the way he sat here," the bartender said. "When he wasn't talking, he would sit sort of dozing."

# FBI Names Suspect As James Earl Ray

WASHINGTON—(AP)—The FBI Friday identified Eric Starvo Galt, wanted for the killing of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., as James Earl Ray, 40, an escapee from the Missouri State Penitentiary.

The FBI said he was identified through "a systematic and exhaustive search of latent fingerprints" uncovered in the King case against the fingerprints of the more than 53,000 persons for whom notices are on file in the bureau's identification division.

Ray was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City April 23, 1967. He was serving a 20-year sentence for an armed robbery in St. Louis and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission.

Ray, who had been at the prison since March 17, 1960, spent some time in September 1966 in the maximum security ward at the state hospital in Fulton, Mo.

The man known as Galt was charged Wednesday with the first-degree murder of King April 4 in Memphis, Tenn. He also is charged in a federal warrant with conspiracy and murder in the King assassination.

A drifter since he left school in the 10th grade at Alton, Ill., Ray served as an enlisted man in the Army from February 1946 to December 1948 when he was given a general discharge for ineptness and lack of adaptability, the FBI said.

During his Army career he received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and "breaking" arrest.

The FBI said Ray has an arrest record dating at least to 1949, when he was convicted for burglary in Los Angeles. He also was convicted in 1952 for armed robbery in Chicago and in 1955 for forging U.S. postal money orders in Missouri.

He has served terms in a Los Angeles County jail, state prison at Joliet and Pontiac, Ill., and a federal penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kan.

The FBI said Ray has used the names of James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conner.

Ray claims to have been born [redacted] in Illinois. The Alton city clerk said he was born there. Ray is about 5-foot-10, weighs 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair and two scars: A small one on the center of his forehead and another on the palm of his right hand.

He has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

The FBI said Ray has been a federal fugitive since July 28, 1967, when an FBI

complaint was filed at Jefferson City charging him with unlawfully fleeing from Missouri to avoid confinement.

Wednesday, the FBI had distributed "wanted" posters on Eric Starvo Galt and reportedly was searching for him in California.

Wendel Wilson then told Phil Wilson to buy a local paper, look at the photographs of Fugitive RAY, and then call Wilson back. Phil Wilson then returned the call, and told his father that he felt there was similarity in the photograph, and further told his father that suspect JONES has a scar on his forehead and a scar on his right hand. Wilson said at the time of the phone call, his son stated he was returning to the ranch with the suspect JONES and wife.

Above information furnished ASAC MORLEY who instructed that SA LEO FORD be contacted and instructed to proceed to Rock Springs and join SA LITTLE, and that SA LITTLE be advised with instructions not to have "locals" involved at this point.

SA LITTLE was advised at 4:00 PM of contents of Phoenix teletype and phone call. LITTLE advised that he is acquainted with the general area, but has never been on the Currant Creek ranch. LITTLE stated it has been snowing all day in the area; that the ranch is located south in the direction of Flaming Gorge, and the area is "mountain goat" country, and with the snow and spring thaw, driving other than paved roads is impossible without a four-wheel drive vehicle. LITTLE stated there are no roads as such to ranches in the area, and the paths are commonly called "ways", and consist of a set of tracks. LITTLE stated normally it is not possible to block off any ranch road leading to a paved road, since a 4 wheel vehicle or horse can use any level area desired to reach pavement.

Davis stated he would obtain this information as soon as possible and telephone Denver.

At 4:35 PM, SAC WERNER telephoned from Colo. Springs, and was furnished background in this matter. He requested that SA LITTLE telephone him at the Broadmoor immediately.

At 4:55 PM, SA LITTLE was instructed to contact SAC WERNER immediately.

As of 3:45 PM, stops were placed with PD, SO and State Patrol to locate SA FORD at Riverton, as no answer at home or RA.

At 4:55 PM SA LITTLE advised he had checked out the Rock Springs area on the possibility that the 1962 Chev. with Arizona license plates was parked in town, but LITTLE was unable to locate the car.

At 5:25 PM SAC WERNER instructed that SAS SIEFERS, NELSON and ADSIT be placed on standby. This was done.

At 5:30 PM SA LEO FORD was instructed to proceed toward Rock Springs and join SA LITTLE. FORD stated it was snowing toward South Pass, that he would make every effort to get over the pass and would advise of any difficulty.

At 5:48 PM SA LITTLE called and advised he had determined PHIL WILSON and suspect JONES were apparently then in Rock Springs, and LITTLE has information that WILSON and suspect will eat dinner in Rock Springs. LITTLE stated he was contacting SAC WERNER immediately regarding this new development.

At 5:55 PM, SAC WERNER advised that he desired SA LITTLE to check out suspect JONES in Rock Springs.

At 5:58 PM, SA FORD was contacted and advised to hold his departure in abeyance.

At 6:00 PM SAS ADSIT, NELSON and SIEFERS were advised of above developments, and instructed to remain available the balance of the evening.

At 6:35 PM SA LITTLE advised he hadn't been able to locate PHIL WILSON or any of his ranch hands.

At 9:03 PM SA LITTLE advised he finally located PHIL WILSON who advised that suspect JONES had departed Rock Springs and went back to the ranch. LITTLE said he would interview WILSON and advise this office.

At 9:55 PM SA LITTLE advised he has interviewed PHIL WILSON and his wife and pretty well eliminated JONES as a suspect. He advised JONES has space between his teeth and they are discolored. He wears thick lensed glasses all the time and they don't think he could get along without them. They did not notice a protruding ear. He likes to listen to music but never dances. Has a wife named BETTY who is heavy set and claims she married ~~subject~~ JONES in July 1968 while subject was with the Campus Police at Cornell University. **Subject** does not have a noticeable accent. JONES does fit the description as far as age and size and does have a half inch cut scar in the middle of his fore head with a small scar on the back of his right hand. No scar in the palm of his hand noticed. JONES is not a good ranch hand and seems to lack experience. LITTLE advised that JONES and his wife are presently at the ranch and their car is broke down and they have no way of leaving the ranch without the ranchers help. LITTLE stated he is planning on going to the ranch early 4-21-68 with officers from the local SO and at that time will determine if JONES is identical.

At 10:15 SAC, ASAC, SA ADSIT, SA SIEFERS were advised of the above information.

ADDENDUM:  
4/22/68

SA RIPPE called me at 3:50 p.m. on 4/20/68, concerning the background on above matter, and I in turn was in immediate contact with SAC WERNER concerning the situation.

I was subsequently advised during the evening of the information set forth on the top of page 3 of SA RIPPE's memo and at 10:50 a.m., on 4/21/68, I telephonically contacted SA JOHN ALBERT in the Tucson RA. I advised SA ALBERT that the matter had been pretty well resolved through the interview of Mr. and Mrs. PHILIP WILSON, but that SA LITTLE was still attempting to get to the WILSON ranch for the purpose of personally observing JONES. A snowstorm was still raging in the Rock Springs area and SA LITTLE advised he was attempting to obtain a four-wheel jeep to get out to the ranch and that the Phoenix Office would be advised concerning the outcome of this lead.

It is noted I contacted SA ALBERT in the absence of SAC MULL and ASAC ROWAN, both of whom were temporarily away from their homes at church according to the Phoenix operator.

# FBI Hints It Has Brother, Hunts Galt

By HENRY P. LEIFERMAN  
BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (UPI)—  
FBI sources indicated today  
that the "alleged brother" of  
Eric Starvo Galt may be in  
their custody, helping them  
search for the man accused of  
slaying Dr. Martin Luther King  
Jr.

The FBI also apparently had  
reason to believe that Galt, a  
mysterious graduate bartender  
with a rural accent and several  
aliases, may have returned to  
Birmingham after disappearing  
in Atlanta.

The FBI would not comment  
on whether it had anyone in  
custody in connection with the  
assassination. But a source in  
the FBI said that after Galt  
purchased a gun at a Birming-  
ham sporting goods store about  
a week before King was killed,  
he took it to the man he said  
was his brother.

His brother, the source said,  
told him "that's not the gun we  
need." The source refused to  
say whether the knowledge of  
this conversation meant that the  
unnamed second man in the  
alleged conspiracy was in their  
custody.

A check of rooming house  
operators in Birmingham re-  
vealed that within the past  
three days, FBI agents have  
been making the rounds asking  
them if a man answering Galt's  
description had stayed with  
them in the past two weeks.

The FBI charged Galt in a  
warrant Wednesday with con-  
spiring to violate the civil rights  
of King, slain by a sniper in  
Memphis April 4. Memphis  
police later filed a murder  
charge against Galt. Only the  
FBI warrant mentioned the

alleged brother. FBI did not  
include him in the charge.

FBI also released a  
photograph of Galt, 36, de-  
scribed as a "blond" with a  
"rural quality" in his voice.  
There was immediate conflict  
or uncertainty among witnesses  
who said they had seen Galt.

"No, that's not him," said  
Peter Cherpes, operator of a  
rooming house where Galt  
stayed from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7,  
1967.

"I can't be sure," said Percy  
Strickland, a roomer at the  
house.

The woman who runs the  
Memphis flophouse from where  
the killer shot King as the  
Negro leader stood on his motel  
balcony also was undecided  
about the picture. "I just don't  
know if it's him," said Mrs.  
Bessie Brewer.

The FBI ins-  
pected the picture was of Galt. "It's him,  
all right," said Joseph H.  
Gamble, special agent in charge  
of the Birmingham FBI office.  
He said the photograph was  
taken this year, "in March, I  
think."

The FBI issued two pictures  
of Galt, also known as Harvey  
Lowmeyer and John Willard.  
Galt's eyes were closed in one  
photo. The other featured eyes  
sketched in by an FBI artist.

The FBI complaint, filed in  
Birmingham, charged that Galt  
and an individual "whom he  
alleged to be his brother  
entered into a conspiracy" to  
harm King, and Galt purchased  
a rifle in Birmingham about  
March 30.

## Trace Weapon

A 30.06-caliber Remington  
pump rifle with a telescope  
sight was found near the  
Memphis flophouse and FBI  
agents traced the weapon to a  
Birmingham sporting goods  
store where records showed it  
was sold to Galt.

A rifle, a Mustang

resembling one seen speeding  
from the murder scene—was  
found abandoned in Atlanta the  
day after the slaying. It was  
registered to Galt at a  
Birmingham rooming house,  
where residents had not seen  
him in three months. The FBI  
said Galt purchased the 1966  
car from a private citizen in  
Birmingham last August and  
put 19,000 miles on it—driving  
to such places as Los Angeles,  
New Orleans and Mexico.

According to the FBI, Galt  
claimed to be a riverboat cook  
and merchant seaman and was  
an avid dancer with a  
preference for country and  
western music. He also likes  
beer and vodka, the FBI said,  
and "probably does not have a  
high degree of education."

Agents said Galt took a  
course at a bartending school in  
Los Angeles this year and  
graduated March 2.

The FBI said Galt had a  
nervous habit of occasionally  
pulling at an earlobe with his

At 6:14 PM, 4/18/68, this SA received a telephone call from the Denver office and was advised that a man by the name of JOHN BRENNAN, who was at telephone number 234-9001 in Casper, Wyoming, allegedly had some information on captioned case.

Contact was made with this person telephonically, and later he was interviewed in person.

He identified himself as JOHN BERNARD BRENNAN, Jr., of Beaver Brook, Pennsylvania. He alleged that one ANN RAIND, author, had something to do with the conspiracy involved in the killing of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. He learned this by reading her books. He also stated that he believed GALT to be in California. He was asked how he knew GALT was in California, and he stated "I just feel it".

Conversation with BRENNAN elicited the information that he has been in mental hospitals 4 times, has been an alcoholic for 10 - 12 years. He is 29 years of age. He had Selective Service cards and Social Security card in this name. He claimed the power to communicate with his girl friend by ESP. At one time he mentioned this girl was in California, and another time in Fargo, N. D. He said that he and his lawyer had just beaten a sanity hearing board in Fargo, N. D., which had attempted to declare him insane.

It is obvious from conversation that this person is mentally unbalanced, and no credence can be given to his stories.

Efforts were made to travel to Laramie, Wyoming on 4/17/68, however the roads were closed between Cheyenne and Laramie that day and were not opened to vehicular travel until the morning of 4/18/68. However, Detective FRANK HOADLEY, Laramie PD, was telephonically contacted on the afternoon of 4/17/68, and he advised that PAUL HAMLEN LEDWELL could not make bond and would be available for interview on 4/18/68.

On 4/18/68, Detective HOADLEY furnished the following information in addition to that which he furnished to SA RIPPE on 4/17/68:

HOADLEY contacted Dr. WILLIAM S. BENNETT, Laramie, who advised LEDWELL visited his office on 4/16/68, and asked for dextatrene because he was a jockey and wanted it to curb his appetite to enable him to lose weight but did not mention that he had recently obtained any of this medicine. CANN (appointment card) showing no address or date; receipt of Dr. ERNEST SCHWARTZ dated 3/13/68, for physical examination of PAUL LEDWELL; statement of Dr. NATHAN MANN, 1904 Franklin Street, Oakland, dated 3/15/68, for services rendered to PAUL H.
