





Mrs. MARION HILLYER, Desk Clerk, Skyways Motor Hotel, advised that a LEROY RAY, 1352 W. 38th Ave., Phoenix, Ariz, connected with the Combined Insurance Co., checked into the Motel at 5:54pm 4/27/68 and checked out at 12:53pm, 4/28/68. A woman alledgedly driving a red car with local license was with him when he checked in and may have stayed the night

She described the man as a "nervous Nelly", 6', slim build, thin moustache, dark hair frosted at the temples, late 30s, gold watch, dark suit, white shirt, no tie. She said he resembled the Mexico photograph of RAY, He may have been wearing glasses.

In view of the many discrepancies between RAYS (JAMES EARL) description and this man's looks, no further investigation is warranted.



Two New **Ray Photos** Released

WASHINGTON - (UPI)-The FBI Tuesday distributed two newly obtained photographs of James Earl Ray, the ex-convict sought in the slaying of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. One was described as "an extremely good likeness."

A candid photograph of Ray, which the FBI said was taken in late January or early Febru-California, shows him almost full face in a business suit and tie.

The second photograph, which the FBI said was taken last November somewhere in Mexico. also is a candid shot. It shows him in dark glasses wearing what appears to be a white sports shirt.

The FBI declined to say how the photographs had been obtained. They will be displayed throughout the country along with two other photographs of Ray which appear on the FBI's "wanted" poster.

One is a photo of Ray when he was said to be posing as a man named Eric Starbo Galt and was taken at his graduation from a bartending school in Los Angeles early in 1968. The other photo is actually two likenesses of Ray on the same print-prison photographs taken in 1960 at Missouri State Penitentiary.

King was shot by a sniper in Memphis April 4. The FBI announced April 17 it had issued a warrant for the arrest of Galt. Two days later it said Galt was an alias and that the wanted man actually was Ray.





The following investigation was conducted by SA ROY I. MISCHKE on 4/3/68.

Mr. LADD FELIX, Manager, and Mrs. LADD FELIX, Bookkeeper, Mayflower Hotel, 1700 Grant Street, advised that a check of registration records revealed that no one was registered in that hotel under name of CARL RAY during period of April 28, 1968, to May 2, 1968. A photograph of JAMES EARL RAY was exhibited to each of these individuals and each stated that no one resembling RAY has been a guest at the hotel during recent weeks.

JAMES HEFFNER, Desk Clerk, Mayflower Hotel, advised on 5/3/68, that his only recollection of the name of "RAY" was that on or about 5/1/68, a very tall thin man, who was not a guest in the hotel, paused at the desk and told him that his name was "RAY" and that he was attempting to meet someone at the hotel. He requested that if anyone should call for him at the desk, that they be told that he would be in the lounge of the hotel. According to HEFFNER this individual then entered the tavern at the hotel and he did not have any further contact with him. HEFFNER stated that this individual was very tall, thin, and definitely did not resemble photograph of JAMES EARL RAY.







In a motel-hotel canvass by telephone on 5/3/68 SA RICHARD B. FLEMING contacted the Clarko Hotel, 813 East Colfax, to determined if CARL RAY had been registered between 4/27/68 and 5/3/68. The person who answered stated that "he has not come in yet".

On the evening of 5/3/68 SA's WALLACE M. GLOVER and PAUL E. BUSH contacted CHARLES CASTELLE, manager of the Clarko Hotel, who produced his guest register which failed to reflect the name of anyone by the name of CARL RAY being registered between 4/27/68 and 5/3/68.

He recalled receiving a telephone call that evening inquiring about CARL RAY and stated that in answering he mentioned that "RAY" had not come in. He stated that he was referring to RAY PEEBLES, age 62, who has resided for the past seven years in room number two at the Clarko Hotel. He examined photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated that they in no way resemble RAY PEEBLES and that he has seen no one around the hotel who was identical with the photographs.

On 5/3/68 SASWALLACE M. GLOVER and PAUL E. BUSH completed telephone canvas of the following Denver motels and hotels to determine if CARL RAY was at any of these motels or had been registered at any of them between 4/27/68 and 5/3/68.

All checks were negative except the Mayflower Hotel where the clerk on duty said that CARL RAY was not then registered but that a person by that name might have been registered during the past week. ASAC JOHN MORLEY assigned SA ROY I. MISCHKE to check out the records of the Mayflower Hotel. SA MISCHKE reported that through the hotel manager LAD FELIX he had obtained access to the hotel registration cards covering the period of 4/27/68 to 5/3/68 and that no one by the name of CARL RAY had been registered during that period.




