

HOWARD CARTER, at which time he related the following information:

BACHELOR stated that he is a clairvoyant and that on very infrequent occasions he receives an intuitive feeling from the ether, which he describes as a nebulous source of information and that recently he received a message, the contents of which are as follows:

JAMES EARL RAY, who killed MARTIN LUTHER KING, has left the country on Flight 414, no particular date other than the fact it occurred in the past. On 4/25/68, Mr. EARL JOHNSON, 3191 Broadway, Boulder, Colorado, viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, and stated the side view of RAY depicted in Wanted Flier 442-A bears a slight resemblance to an individual he knew as TAD KRUPPA, whom he met in the bar at the Laguna Dance Hall, east of Kentucky Avenue and Morrison Road, Denver, Colorado, sometime in 1966. JOHNSON stated he has always been interested in ballroom dancing and in conversation with KRUPPA determined that he was also a participant in this form of entertainment.

JOHNSON continued that he subsequently introduced KRUPPA to GLORIA HORRIGAN, manager of the Fred Astaire Dance School in Boulder, who became impressed with KRUPPA's ballroom dancing ability and actually hired him to give lessons for her on a part time basis. JOHNSON advised he has not seen KRUPPA for approximately one year, but is certain that it was during 1966 and 1967 that KRUPPA was employed at the Fred Astaire Dancing Studio.

JOHNSON advised he knew little of KRUPPA's background other than the fact that he was from the State of New York and at the time he met him at the Laguna Dance Hall was of the understanding that KRUPPA had just recently arrived in this area from New York.

On 5/13/68, Mrs. MOSELLE DROLLINGER, 12300
East Nevada Avenue, Aurora, Colorado, advised that the following information was furnished to her third-hand. She does not want her identity disclosed to any of her relatives, including her husband.

She attended her mother's funeral at Phil Campbell, Alabama, and recently returned to Denver. She said her sister-in-law, MABEL WHITTEN BROWN, from Akron, Ohio (DEOLLINGER refused address), and DROLLINGER's brother, DEWEY BROWN, were at the funeral. DEWEY received this information from MABEL. MABEL has a first cousin named HOWARD SIDE, who is supposed to have a criminal record. SIDE left many years ago, location unknown, but returned to Alabama shortly after KING's death, and is currently residing with MABEL's uncle, WALTER WHITTEN, and cousin ODELL WHITTEN at Hackelburg, Marion County, Alabama. WALTER is in the business of cutting pulpwood while ODELL and SIDE go into the woods to cut the timber. ODELL is supposed to have told MABEL that SIDE is very suspicious of anyone who comes to the house and usually hides behind the door with a gun. She said that SIDE is in his late 40's, but is supposed to look like the sketch made of KING's assassin.

Since it is established that JAMES EARL RAY is the subject of this investigation, this information is being furnished Birmingham in the event it is later learned that a conspiracy may be involved and SIDE could logically be considered a suspect.
