


This date CESAR PEREZ SOLIS, Jefe (Head) Mexican Immigration Service at Juarez caused a search of the Visa (Tourista) files of his office and no record was located reflecting the issuance of a Visa or other documentation to HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER since 4/1/68. PEREZ SOLIS noted that any American passing through Juarez to the interior of Mexico would need Visa documentation issued by his office for such travel regardless of the mode of transportation. PEREZ SOLIS stated that he would advise appropriate personnel to remain alert for the issuance of a Visa in the names LOWMEYER or LOWMYER.

Captain ROBERTO MILLAN, Identification Officer, Juarez PD, and JOSE RUBALCAVA, Asst. Cmdr., Chihuahua State Police, on 4/9/68 checked the files of their respective departments and no record identifiable in the names LOWMEYER or LOWMYER was noted therein. No credit bureau exists in Juarez, Mexico, this area being covered by the El Paso Credit Bureau.

MARIA FIERRO, Secretary, American Consulate, reviewed the files of the Consulate and no information concerning LOWMEYER or LOWMYER was located. These files contain mainly the names of U.S. citizens residing in the Juarez area and those American who have travelled to Juarez to receive Mexican divorces.

There are no other logical agencies at Juarez which have available records which might conceively contain names of U.S. citizens.







At approximately 10:30 a.m. on 4/10/68, Sgt. W. R. BARRON, El Paso Police Department, El Paso, Texas, advised that he had received information from one GLORIA MEREAZ who is employed at the Aaronson Brothers Clothing Store in the Layaway Department, that she had been approached by a man who fit the description of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING a few minutes earlier. BARRON advised that MEREAZ had said that this subject had asked her to go to dinner and also had asked her what time the shows in El Paso opened, and she told this individual that they opened about 12:00. BARRON further advised that this individual had parked his car near the corner of Overland and Stanton Streets in downtown El Paso and that according to information from MEREAZ walked towards the trolley car.

SAS WALLACE A. CROSSMON and FRANCIS J. PRASEK immediately proceeded to the corner of Stanton and Overland where it was noted that there was no white Ford parked in the immediate vicinity. Agents CROSSMON and PRASEK then walked the one block to the Aaronson Brothers Clothing Store and interviewed GLORIA MEREAZ. MEREAZ advised that at 9:40 a.m. on this date she was walking towards her employment when a young man, age about 26, approached her on the street and asked her what time the shows in town opened and told her that he was new in El Paso. She told him that the shows opened about 12:00 and some of them opened at 2:30. He then asked her if she wanted to stop in and have something to eat with him and she refused, explaining that she had to go to work. MEREAZ described this young man as being 5'9" tall, wery thin with reddish brown hair and freckles. She said that he had a long nose and chin and a thin mouth. He was wearing a white shirt and a white sweater with tan pants and when she first observed him, he was putting money in a parking meter near the corner of Stanton and Overland Streets. She advised that the car which was parked there was a white Ford.

MEREAZ then accompanied the Agents to the location where this car was parked and pointed out a white Ford Mustang which was parked in the spot after which she returned to her employment.

It was immediately noted that the parking meter corresponding to the place where this white Ford Mustang was parked had 57 minutes remaining, the maximum on the meter being one hour. This indicated that money had just been put in the meter approximately three minutes prior to that time. The Ford (white Mustang) parked at this spot bore 1968 Texas license plates CNG 486. Telephone contact was made with the El Paso FBI Office and it was determined that this car was registered to an H. M. ELMORE, 3009 Frankfort at El Paso. Approximately 13 minutes after Agents CROSSMON and PRASEK arrived at the place where this car was parked, a woman, age approximately 85, entered this car and drove away.

No attempt was made to interview this woman inasmuch as it appeared that the individual who had approached MEREAZ on the street had driven his car away prior to the arrival of Agents CROSSMON and PRASEK. Inasmuch as there is no way to identify this individual and since the description furnished by MEREAZ does not match that in the possession of the FBI, no further action is taken in this matter.






