

Re DAVID HAWKINS - SUSPECT

On 4/17/68, Mrs. HARLEY HERRALD (BETTE HERRALD), 974 Cornelius Street, El Pæo, Texas, advised that at 6:35 p.m. on 4/17/68, she received a person-to-person telephone call from one DAVID HAWKINS. Mrs. HERRALD advised that she knew HAWKINS when they were both in the Army in Frankfurt, Germany, 1955 through 1957, and that she had been corresponding with him by mail perodically since that time. When the call came to the HERRALD residence, the operator asked for Mrs. HERRALD and then told the caller that "That will be 25¢ more." The conversation went as follows:

HAWKINS: 'BETTY?"

Mrs. HERRALD recognized the voice and said, "Hi."

 $$\operatorname{\textsc{DAVE}}$$ HAWKINS said, "We only have three minutes and I'm on my way."

Mrs. HERRALD said, "Where?" He replied, "There."

He went on to explain that he was in New Orleans and that he was coming to El Paso. Since HAWKINS sounded as though he was out of breath, Mrs. HERRALD asked why, and he answered that he was "on the run". Mrs. HERRALD asked him from what, and HAWKINS replied, "From the family." Mrs. HERRALD then asked him if he was in trouble and he said that he would tell her when he got to El Paso. He said he was leaving for El Paso on the morning of 4/18/68, and gave the impression that he was driving, but he did not actually say this. He estimated it would take him 24 hours to get to El Paso.

Mrs. HERRALD said that the conversation terminated at that point, and she did not know whether HAWKINS was travelling alone or not.

She said that this was very strange, and particularly since she knew that after HAWKINS got out of the Army in late 1957 or early 1958, he was undergoing psychiatric treatment, but that she did not know the reason for this treatment.

Mrs. HERRALD furnished the following background information which was to the best of her recollection, since she had not seen HAWKINS since about 1957.

HAWKINS was a Sergeant First Class in the Regular Army, and during 1955 through 1957, was stationed at Headquarters Company, 7811th Army Service Unit, APO 757, New York. He was stationed during this time at Frankfurt, Germant, in the Adjutant Generals Corps. It is believed that he served in Korea prior to his tour of duty in Frankfurt, and that he was released from the Army in late 1957 or early 1958.

After his release from the Army, and until the present time, he lived with a brother and sister-in-law at RFD #1, Box 18, Wellborn, Florida. His brother's name is BERNARD HAWKINS, and is a member of the Suwannee County Livestock Promotion Project sponsored by the Suwannee County Livestock Chamber of Commerce, P. O. Box 662, Live Oak, Florida. It is believed the brother owns a beef farm in Florida.

HAWKINS lived with his brother, with the exception of the period during which he was under psychoanalysis, during which time he lived at 1098 NE 34th Court, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.

Mrs. HERRALD furnished three photographs of HAWKINS which were taken at a party in Germany about 12 years ago. Also depicted in these photographs is a girl named DORIS, with whom HAWKINS was very fascinated while they were in Germany. This girl is now Mrs. DORIS ANDERSON, P. O. Box 895, Balboa, California. It is not known whether or not she is divorced from her husband, but it is believed HAWKINS is very entranced by her.

Mrs. HERRALD made available a letter that HAWKINS wrote to her which was postmarked 2/10/68 at Wellborn, Florida. This letter reflected that a Judge in Florida had awarded HAWKINS the custody of a boy named JOHNNY, whose mother and father were in the process of getting a divorce. Mrs. HERRALD noted that this boy is about le years old and it is possible that he may be travelling with HAWKINS. A xerox copy of this letter is attached.

Mrs. HERRALD advised that she would like to have the original letter and photographs returned to her.

Mrs. HERRALD said that HAWKINS is described as:

White Race Sex Male Age 40 5' 9" - 5' 10" Height Sandy brown Hair Build Slight Weight 140 - 160Long, pointed nose Features Possible wearing glasses

Mrs. HERRALD said that this description is as she knew him (except for the age) 12 years ago in Germany. She recalled that in one of the letters she had received from HAWKINS in Florida, he mentioned to her that his hair had gotten so light from the sun in Florida that he had bleached it, but then may have let it go back to its natural color.

Mrs. HERRALD said that since the description fit the description given of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., so closely, since HAWKINS said that he was on the run, and since he had undergone psychiatric treatment in the past, she felt that the possibility existed that he could be the assassin.

Mrs. HERRALD stated her husband works at Southwestern Portland Cement Company from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and can be contacted at 544-1750, extension 70.

She stated she works at the New York Life Insurance Company, University Towers, 1900 North Oregon Street from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., and can be contacted at work at 533-6894.



ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FBI HAS IDENTIFIED JAMES EARL RAY, AN ESCAPEE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY, AS ERIC STARVO GALT, AGAINST WHOM A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED LAST WEDNESDAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE FATAL SHOOTING OF THE REVEREND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI"S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.
