On 4/26/68, FANNY GUNN, P. O. Box 641, Clarksville,
Va., advised she is a cousin to SHIRLEY JEAN BALMORICH, nee
Pauget. She stated that she never traveled to the State of
Fla. with her cousin, SHIRLEY JEAN, and, in fact, has never
left the State of Va. She also advised that to her knowledge
SHIRLEY JEAN has never traveled to Fla. She stated that SHIRLEY
JEAN has had some difficulty with men and her marriage to
KIRK BALMORICH is her second. She further stated that
while BALMORICH was in Vietnam SHIRLEY JEAN lived with another
man in Texas. She said it is her opinion that SHIRLEY JEAN
is trying to get away from BALMORICH. She stated she does not
know anyone named ERIC RAY or RAYL RAY and never heard SHIRLEY
JEAN mention anyone by that name. She observed photographs
of JAMES EARL RAY and advised she has never seen anyone who
resembles the photo nor does she know this man.

Mrs. FAUCETT observed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY and advised she did not know him nor did she recognize any of the photographs. Mrs. FAUCETT advised that should she learn the whereabouts of her daughter, SHELLEY JEAN, she would advise this office.
