



Unit #1, Covington County, met on 3/29/68, at CHAIN's barn, Mt. Olive, Mississippi, in their regular weekly meeting. Officers present were HUBERT HAUGHTON, C. W. CHAIN, HOMER SULLIVAN, members, CECIL CHAIN, JOHN S. PONDER, JESSE NICHOLS, J. O.TILLSON. HUBERT HAUGHTON read the names of the members paying for tickets to the benefit dinner held at Laurel, Mississippi, for a benefit of the APWR and the Defense Fund of the DAHMER subjects. HAUGHTON said he had given \$335 to the APWR and \$200 to BOWERS from the unit #1 treasury. CHAIN said he expected the private school to close after this time, and was most disappointed over the citizens of Covington County in their not supporting this school.

C. W. CHAIN reported that only 25 members had paid up their dues. He said that about twenty more owed for one quarter and he was of the opinion that they would pay when contacted.

HAUGHTON said all those members he had contacted selling the tickets to the APWR dinner had given him a \$10 donation for the APWR. On 4/5/68, source reported that HAUGHTON had commented that he had gotten \$10 donations, from a number of people other than Klansmen, for the APWR dinner.

Source reported that the membership was still talking of the trials in Hattiesburg, and that they were still expressing pleasure and confidence in the trials since the result of the DE BOXTEL hung jury. He stated that he felt that their loyalty to the Klan was being maintained through the trials of these individuals, but if there are other convictions, he believes they (the Klan) will gradually die out. He doubts very seriously

if all the members will pay their dues; however, they may, but remain away as they have in the past, only contributing their dues to the Klan.

There has been some comments in the member-ship about BOWERS not blaming PITTS or his testifying against him, and it is believed that this reaction by BOWERS was motivated mainly by the fact that PITTS had based his changeover on his religious beliefs.

On 4/5/68, source reported that about all he had heard that day were comments concerning the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING. Many resented the big play he was getting, and very few expressed any displeasure at the act. He stated he was surprised at some of the business people that were commenting as they were; however, he felt that any other reflection would indicate they thought it was a very bad thing because of the influence on the rest of the nation.

Source advised that on 4/9/68, everything in the Negro ghetto area on Lynch Street was quiet. Source stated that all the establishments were closed and that the taverns were expected to open at approximately 6:00 p.m. Source related that there was a rumor on the street that Negroes would assemble in small numbers in front of the Masonic Lodge, 1072 Lynch Street and would depart in groups of two or three in order to get through the police barracades on all the main roads leading to Lynch Street. The groups intended to meet at the Booker T. Restaurant on Farish Street at approximately 8:00 p.m. from which they intended to conduct a demonstration on Capitol Street. Source indicated that the demonstration would be that of rock throwing and the breaking of store windows. However, source felt that the required number of Negroes would not show up at the Masonic Temple or the Booker T. Restaurant because of the recent arrests in connection with the rioting . and the plan would never materialize.

At 7:00 p.m. source advised that approximately 18 individuals showed up in front of the Masonic Lodge, but no one went to the Booker T. Restaurant because enough peopel did not congregate or show up at the Masonic Lodge.

Source stated that DON JACKSON, MARVIN WILSON and GEORGE WARE appeared on the scene, looked the situation over, hailed a taxi-cab and advised those present that they are en route to Tougaloo, Miss.

MARVIN WILSON stated that he, JACKSON, and WARE intended to depart Jackson, Miss., on either 4/12 or 13/68, en route to Memphis, Tenn.
