PIERCE advised that due to her employment at Dee Dell's Studio, she travels quite extensively and therefore does not have a permanent address in Walls, Mississippi but can always be contacted through the photo studio. She advised that when she is in Walls she will often stay at a motel in Memphis, Tennessee.

PIERCE advised that to the best of her knowledge, she remembers calling her sister in Muncie, Indiana, on either April 5 or 6, 1968, PIERCE stated that the first time she had called had been from Jackson, Mississippi, and that the second time she called from Memphis, Tennessee, on either the same day or the day after. PIERCE stated that due to her marital difficulties, she uses the name LaBELLA, and this is the only time that she ever uses this name. PIERCE stated that there is no such person as DENO or DEE LaBELLA.

TOM NELSON DAVIS, South Acres Drive, New Albany, Mississippi, was interviewed at the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol (MHSP) Substation, at New Albany, Mississippi. He voluntarily appeared for interview.

TOM NELSON DAVIS was warned of his rights by SA ROBIN O. COTTEN and waived them, but refused to sign the Warning and Waiver form. He advised that he fully understood his rights and did not desire to execute any waiver until he learned the nature of the purposed interview.

When questioned concerning his activities on April 4, 1968, TOM NELSON DAVIS advised that he was at his home on South Acres Drive, in New Albany, Mississippi, at approximately 4:00 P.M., when his cousin ROY HARDY, who resides on Highway 30 East, stopped by his house and offered him a drink of whiskey. DAVIS pointed out that he lived at this residence with his mother, and suggested that they drive to the Beacon Hill Drive-In, located west of New Albany. He stated that he drove his 1967 white Mustang, and was followed by his cousin, ROY HARDY, in HARDY's pickup truck. He stated they sat in the truck for a few minutes in front of a small cafe, and each had a drink of whiskey.

He estimated that he left the area of the Beacon Hill area between 4:30 and 5:00 P.M., alone, driving his white Mustang, and stated he was en route to Memphis. He explained that he had planned to meet friends, BETTY SMITH and BOBBY EARWOOD, at the Manhattan Club, Highway 51 South, located just north of Lil Abners Tavern in South Memphis.

He recalled that he drove to Holly Springs,
Mississippi, and stopped at a whiskey store, located on
the north side of the square, where he purchased a pint
of Old Charter whiskey. Thereafter, he stated that he
drove on United States Highway 78 to a Savings Gas Station,
located just north of Holly Springs, Mississippi, on the
east side of the road, and stated he asked to see a friend,
JUNIOR KIRKINDAL, who previously had allowed him to purchase
gasoline on credit in the amount of \$3.00. He stated that
he inquired concerning KIRKINDAL, and learned from a
"redheaded boy" who was employed there, that KIRKINDAL
was not working at that time. He advised that he paid
this "redheaded boy" \$3.00, and in return was given his
gasoline charge ticket.

He recalled that almost immediately, after he got back into his Mustang and turned on the radio, he heard a newscast concerning the shooting of Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in Memphis. He stated that he continued listening to the newscast until he arrived at the Tennessee-Mississippi state line on United States Highway 78, where he stopped at a beer joint located on the east side of the highway, just a few feet south of the Tennessee state line, located in Mississippi. He advised he had been there on previous occasions and knows the owner only by sight, and stated he is certain the owner knows him as a customer, but not by name. He stated he talked with the owner, described only as a white male in his fifties, and stated they discussed the KING shooting. He advised he drank one beer and ate a hamburger. He estimated he stayed at this beer joint approximately 30 or 40 minutes and while having a hamburger, he stated he heard over the newscast at the beer joint that KING had died.

He stated he could not recall the exact time, but stated it was after dark when he heard concerning KING's death.

Thereafter, he advised he drove to the Manhattan Club, located on Highway 51 South, for the purpose of meeting BETTY SMITH and BOBBY EARWOOD, and upon arriving at the Manhattan Club, stated he observed several police officers armed with shotguns guarding the area. He advised that at this time, the Manhattan Club was closed, and he then drove to "Lil Abners" Club nearby, where he met BETTY SMITH and BOBBY EARWOOD. He pointed out that EARWOOD, a white male, approximately 32, is employed at the "Lil Abners" club. He recalled they were closing the club on orders of the police at the time he arrived there, and estimated it was approximately 8:00 P.M., when he met his two friends.

He recalled that BOBBY EARWOOD owned and operated a red Chevrolet pickup truck, and was invited by EARWOOD to visit his apartment for a drink, since the club was closed. He stated he followed EARWOOD in his white Mustang to EARWOOD's apartment, located approximately two miles away. He stated he was not familiar with the address, and could not state the exact whereabouts of the location of the apartment.

He estimated that he stayed at this apartment with BETTY SMITH and BOBBY EARWOOD until at least 2:00 A.M., the following morning, after drinking a considerable amount, and drove back to New Albany, Mississippi, arriving there shortly after daylight on April 5, 1968.

He advised that on this occasion he was wearing a dark business suit, dark tie, and white shirt.

He volunteered to accompany Agents along the same route, if necessary, in an effort to establish his whereabouts on this date as he claimed.

With reference to his whereabouts, during the latter part of march and the first day of April, 1968, he advised he could not specifically give the names of any persons who could account for his whereabouts other than his mother, since he advised he was in New Albany at this time, and definitely had not gone to the State of Alabama. He advised that perhaps neighbors could vouch forthe fact that he was in New Albany. He stated he did not recall going to Memphis on this weekend.

He advised that he does not know a JOHN WILLIARD or a HARVEY LOWLEYER, and advised he has never used either of these names as an alias.

He advised that on the night of April 4, 1968, he did not at anytime go into the city area of Memphis, where the shooting took place.



Investigation conducted to date indicates ERIC STARVO GALT has either established or alleged residences in the following field divisions mentioned: Atlanta, Birmingham, Jackson, Kansas City, Los Angeles, Mobile.

GALT listed on Alabama driver's license he was city and state not listed (this has not been verified.) Bureau has pointed out that Selective Service inquires had been made regarding the three names known to have been used by suspect GALT, LOYMEYER, and WILLARD, however, there remains a number of years in subject's background not accounted for. In normal procedures, subject would have been required to register, if such was done, on or about July 20, 1949, or at least within a two-week period thereafter.

The local Selective Service boards should be contacted for a review of registrants in the pertinent period. possibility exists some data may be developed re familiar names or some other items that may lead to establishing the identity of the subject in this case. Each Agent assigned a county should contact local boards and review appropriate records.

BLACKWELL REALTY BOMBING:

Source advised that he had had conversation with

L. E. MATTHEWS, JR. on April 16, 1967 concerning his arrest
in connection with the above bombing. MATTHEWS maintained
that the night of the bombing he was in Crystal Springs,

Miss. with Mrs. ELAINE SMITH, who he claims will testify
to this fact. In connection with the planning of the bombing at BURRIS DUNN, JR's. residence, MATTHEWS claimed that
on the night of February 11, 1967 he had been at DUNNS home
but that he had left before it was planned. Source pointed
out that about a week previous to this conversation, MATTHEWS
had told source that he was at a loss to understand why JACK
SHEARER, SR. had not also been arrested as he too was at the
party at BURRIS DUNN's residence, and that he MATTHEWS specifically recalled leaving with SHEARER.

the FBI has a palm print taken as evidence after the bombing, but that it could not be one of those involved as they were gloves. MATTHEWS said that there were four people in on this bombing, at the scene, J. L. HARPER, JOE DANIEL HAWKINS and two ethers whom he refused to name. MATTHEWS volunteered that one MIME BROWN of Plain told him that a Grand Jurer had told BROWN what transpired at the Grand Jury proceeding, and that the GJ heard testimony that SAM BOWERS, BURRIS DUNN, JR., HARRY KELLEY and J. L. HARPER were the individuals who did the actual bombing in this case.

MATTHEWS stated he had nothing to do with the BLACKWELL bombing, but that he was guilty of conspiracy in the bembing of the Synagogue, Rabbi NUSSBAUM's residence, and the home of ROBERT KOTCHITSKY, recently in Jackson, Mississi ppi.

MATTHEWS reported to source that HARRY KELLEY and he had gone to Laurel, Mississippi on 4-16-68 to discuss their arrests with SAM BOWERS. They also visited BURRIS DUNN'S wife father and mother, city not recalled, obviously attempting to locate KATHERYN DUNN and ROBERT WILSON. MATTHEWS said that if the FBI did not or does not have paid informers, the group cannot be convicted for this bombing. MATTHEWS said eventually the FBI will get him on the above three bombings, but claimed that he was either in Los Angeles or Louisiana at the time of one of the bombings. Source pointed out that MATTHEWS made the trip to Los Angeles as Governor of the NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION.

L. E. MATTHEWS, JR.:

MATTHEWS advised that he has lost his contract with Deposit Guaranty Bank in Jackson, with Drake Electric getting it.

MATTHEWS was in Cystal Springs Sunday night 4-14-68. From something he said it was indicated he had probably spoken to a group, told them that if they weren't going to do anything, then it was time for them to get out of the organization. He was observed to have called ELAINE SMITH on several occasions, wanted to spend the night with her, but apparently was refused. MATTHEWS was gone for about two hours at one time, but his whereabouts were unknown. He was questioned as to whether he was with JOE BERTCH, but he so swered negatively.

MATTHEWS was questioned as to whether BYRON DE LA BECKWITH had anything to do with the assistantion of MARTIN LUTHER KING, and he said no, why don't you ask de la (BECKWITH)

MATTHEWS showed how he mounts a regular alarm clock on a board, the clock to a mercury switch which turns over when it reaches the amointed place on the alarm, making connection between the switch, a 6 volt or cell battery, which has electrical caps connected thereto. He used in place of the caps for demonstration purposes a small light bdb.

Source checked the carbine of L. E. MATTHEWS and determined that it does not have an M-2 conversion kit on it. He is again hauling it around in the back seat of his car, has a pistel in his pocket most of the time, and another on his car seat.

APWR, HINDS COUNTY, MEETING, 4-16-68:

This meeting was held at the Red Hill Baptist Church near Byram, Miss. with the President ROY CAMPBELL in charge.

ELMORE GREAVES spoke on the differences between white and Negro people. Mrs. CAMPBELL, Dr. and Mrs. A. E. COPELAND, HARRY KELLEY, L. E. MATTHEWS, JR., ELAINE SMITH, PAT & NELL THOMAS, BURRIS DUNN, JR., DANNY HAWKINS & WIFE, BENNIE WALDRUP & WIFE, BUS BOBBITT, ANN BARBER, CATHY AINSWORTH, JESSIE MC RIGHT & wife. There were a number of others present that source did not know, but it was one of the largest meetings held to date, that source has attended.
