Vehicle registration records for Washington County were reviewed on April 5, 1968, and April 6, 1968, concerning all Ford Mustangs license in Washington County. On April 6, 1968, Chief of Police WILLIAM C. BURNLEY, Captain ROY LONG, Captain HARVEY TACKETT, and several other older members of the Greenville Police Department as well as one reportedly highly reliable source of the Greenville, Mississippi, Police Department, reviewed names of all persons owning Mustang automobiles in Washington County, in an effort to locate individuals with white Mustangs and other persons who have shown in any way a propensity for violence or strong opposition to the civil rights movement.

Chief of Police HAROLD SHAW, Hollandale, Mississippi, reviewed names of individuals in the Hollandale, Mississippi, area having Mustang automobiles on April 6, 1968, with no suspects being developed. No Klansmen in the Hollandale area have white Mustangs.

WILLARD; however, she stated she knows WILLARD personally through his wife, BARBARA WILLARD, who formerly worked for Mrs. EDWARDS at the Tupelo Credit Bureau and is presently the manager of the Credit Bureau at Oxford, Mississippi.

Mrs. EDWARDS stated that she has personal knowledge that JOHN H. WILLARD is presently employed at the Day Brite Lighting Company, Incorporated, Tupelo, Mississippi. She stated that as far as she knows, JOHN WILLARD is an honest, trustworthy individual, who does not normally get involved in any type of trouble. She stated that to the best of her knowledge WILLARD presently owns a pickup truck and his wife drives a new 1968 white Volkswagen. Mrs. EDWARDS stated that she has never known WILLARD to be a radical individual; nor has she ever known him to carry any firearms.

Mrs. EDWARDS stated that she could not furnish any additional information concerning JOHN H. WILLARD, since she and Mrs. WILLARD are not in daily contact since BARBARA WILLARD is no longer employed at the Tupelo Credit Bureau.

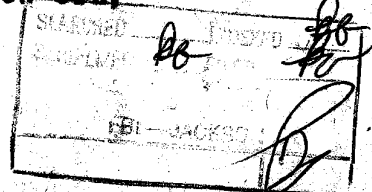

This informant advised that DALE ODUS WALTON, 804 West Jackson Street, Tupelo, Mississippi, the former Imperial Wizard of the Knights of the Green Forest, KKKK is in bad financial shape. He said Walton is being sued by several businesses for back bills and is being sued by an arms company for eight or nine thousand dollars for guns Walton took on consignment and never paid for. He also said Walton is being sued by an attorney for fees involved in the voter suit that Walton entered after the last county election.

Informant said that he believes that Walton has signed over most of his property to his wife to avoid the civil court from attaching his property. He said he has heard that Walton is contemplating bankruptcy. Even with his financial conditions as it is Walton is making a small addition to his store at 804 West Jackson Street, Tupelo, Miss.

Informant related that several weekends ago he was at Walton's store when a man now known to him as L.E. Mathews was at Walton's. He said this individual was wanting Walton to donate or help raise money for the defense of some klanman in south Mississippi. He related that does not believe that Walton is in any position to raise or donate any money at this time.

This informant further stated that he does not believe that there is any klan activity in the Tupelo, Miss. area. He said however JOHN BOWLIN of Sallis, Miss. still talks about the klan but is not doing anything about it.

Informant said he does not have any information concerning the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and has heard very little conversation concerning the murder. He advised that Dale Walton was viewed by him at his store on Saturday afternoon March 30, 1968.

HARROLSON stated that cash-register receipts for cash purchases made in his drugstore are automatically dated by the cash register. He stated that each cash-register receipt carries the title

Rexall Drug  
Columbus, Mississippi

Following this heading is the date of the purchase and below the date of the purchase is the amount of the purchase.

HARROLSON stated that each cash-register receipt has a number; however, these numbers are immaterial to the business of his store. He stated that when the numbers reach a level which he thinks is high, he flips a switch on the cash register and the numbers start over. Therefore, the numbers mean nothing and no information concerning the accounting procedure of the store is filed by these numbers.

HARROLSON continued that the only other tickets handled by his drugstore are charge tickets, which carry the name G and H Liggett Rexall Drugstore, Columbus, Mississippi. He stated that the date has to be written in by a clerk and the numbers on these receipts go only to 50.
