



The following investigation was conducted by SA JOHN DENNIS MILLER on the date and at the places indicated. This investigation concerned JOHN WILLARD, HARVEY LOWMEYER, HARVEY LOWMYER and ERIC STARVO GALT. Unless otherwise indicated, the investigation was negative:

On Saturday, April 6, 1968, the following individuals were contacted regarding WILLARD and LOWMEYER:

Sheriff HOMER JEANES, Tippah County Sheriff's Office, Ripley, Mississippi;

Ripley, Mississippi Chief of Police TROY LUNA;

Sheriff LYNN GRAVES, Benton County Sheriff's Office, Ashland, Mississippi.

Telephone directories covering Benton and Tippah Counties were examined.

On April 10, 1968, a negative attempt to contact Sheriff GRAVES was made. The records of the Benton County Sheriff's Office were checked.

On April 10, 1968, appropriate investigation was conducted at the Ripley Credit Bureau, Ripley, Mississippi. It was observed that the Tippah County Courthouse was closed On the same date, a negative attempt to contact LAWSON MATHIS was made. MATHIS is the Circuit Court Clerk, Ashland, Benton County, Mississippi.

On April 11, 1968, the records of the Tippah County Circuit Court Clerk, W. A. MULLIGAN, Ripley, Mississippi, were checked. Tippah County Sheriff HOMER JEANES was recontacted, as

was Benton County Sheriff LYNN GRAVES.

On April 11, 1968, it was ascertained the local Selective Service Board, Ashland, Mississippi, was closed.

On April 11, 1968, the records of the Chancery Court Clerk, Ashland, Mississippi, were checked.

On April 12, 1968, appropriate telephone directories were examined for the presence of the name GALT.

On April 12, 1968, the following individuals were contacted:

Sheriff GRAVES, Ashland, Mississippi

Sheriff JEANES, Ripley, Mississippi

TROY LUNA, Chief of Police, Ripley, Mississippi

Also on April 12, 1968, the records of the Circuit Court Clerk, Ashland, and the Chancery Court Clerk, Ashland, the Benton County Sheriff's Office, Ashland, and the Tippah County Sheriff's Office, Ripley, were checked.

On April 16, 1968, Sheriff GRAVES and Sheriff JEANES were recontacted and the records of the Chancery Court Clerk, Ripley, Mississippi, were checked.

On April 12, 1968, W. B. GRESHAM, First National Bank, Ashland, Mississippi, was contacted.

The above mentioned contacts and investigations therefore include all appropriate telephone directories, all law enforcement agencies in Benton and Tippah Counties, all

motor vehicle registrations in Benton and Tippah Counties, all voter registration lists in Benton and Tippah Counties, and all parties to any Chancery Court proceedings, including divorces in Benton and Tippah Counties from the 1930s to the present and the Only Credit Bueau in Benton or Tippah Counties.

On April 12, 1968, JEFF RICHARDSON, Richardson's Store, Ripley, Mississippi, advised that about twenty or twenty five years ago, a man whose first name he could not recall, but whose last name was GAULT traveled in the vicinity of Ripley, Mississippi, proclaiming himself to be a "black shirt" and extolled the virtues of ADOLPH HITLER and the Nazi Party. RICHARDSON stated that to the best of his memory, (First Name Unknown) GAULT did not have any children.

RICHARDS ON continued that GAULT was a brother of EZRA GAULT, who at that time farmed in Tippah County, Mississippi. RICHARDS ON described EZRA GAULT as a white male, who is now approximately 55 years of age, and who currently resides on Highway 90 at Lowtey or Lawton, Florida, where he is engaged in the pulp wood and saw mill business. According to RICHARDS ON, EZRA GAULT was, when in Tippah County, and still is, a business partner with TOMMY TATUM. TATUM, the brother-in-law of RICHARDS ON, is a white male, approximately 55 years of age, who resides in the same city in Florida as GAULT.

RICHARDSON continued that TATUM and EZRA GAULT moved to Bearer Creek, Alabama, about 20 or 25 years ago, where they resided several years. RICHARDSON could not recall how long they resided in Alabama. He stated that they then moved from Alabama to Lawtey or Lawton, Florida. RICHARDSON advised that EZRA GAULT has one daughter, but no sons.

RICHARDSON was unable to furnish any additional information concerning the GAUET family.
