the name ERIC STARVO GALT, and pointed out that his last name is spelled GAULT and not GALT. EVERETT GAULT observed photographs of ERIC STARVO GALT and advised that he had never seen this individual, and that this person is definitely not a member of his family or a relation thereof. He stated that he has a brother by the name of CURTIS HOPE GAULT, and his last known address was Pioneer, Louisiana. EVERETT GAULT stated that his brother, CURTIS GAULT, was employed by the Ford Bacon and Davis Construction Company, Monroe, Louisiana. He stated he has not been in contact with his brother for some period of time, and is not sure of his present whereabouts.

He also commented that MALCOLM A. GAULT and EZRA GAULT are both brothers of his. EVERETT GAULT stated he could furnish no information concerning anyone who resembles the person in the photograph identified as ERIC STARVO GALT. EVERETT GAULT advised his brother, CURTIS HOPE GAULT, is not identical with ERIC STARVO GALT.

No lead to locate and interview CURTIS HOPE GAULT, Pioneer, Louisiana, is being set out, and this matter is being left to the discretion of the office of origin.

Informant advised that he has received no further information as to the whereabouts of BYRON DE LA WECKWITH but felt sure that if BYRON DE LA WECKWITH returned to the Mississippi Gulf Coast area he would learn of this.

Informant advised he is personally acquainted with SAM HOLLOWAY BOWERS, JR. and has had information concerning trips BOWERS has made to the Mississippi Gulf Coast. He has not received any information which would indicate that SAM BOWERS has been on the Mississippi Gulf Coast since 3/25/68. The informant stated that should he learn that SAM BOWERS had left JONE COUNTY, Mississippi, he would notify the FBI.

Informant learned that BOB MC COY, owner of the Oaklawn Motel, Mississippi City, Mississippi, had been in telephone contact with RALPH STRICKLAND of Laurel, Mississippi. At the time MC COY reportedly offered his services in connection with the trial of LUCILE "BUDDY" YUNT which is to take place at Laurel on or about 4/19/68. This trial also involves TRAVIS BUCKLEY and ROY STRICKLAND who are also subjects in this case.

The informant learned from MC COY that ROY STRICKLAND claimed they were not worried about this trial as they had the prosecutor and some members of the jury on their side. MC COY added that in his opinion the klan in Laurel had gotten a list of the prospective members of the jury and had contacted them like the recently did in Jackson County.

Informant stated that he had not been able to develop any information as to the whereabouts of ROY STRICKLAND and did not know if any relatives of his in Laurel knew of his whereabouts or not. Information had previously come to his attention that ROY STRICKLAND would reportedly give himself up prior to the trial so as to clear LUCILE "BUDDY" YUNT who is a relative of him. Informant said that if ROY did not then LUCILE YUNE night have to go to jail and if so RALPH STRICKLAND and other relatives would be mad at ROY STRICKLAND. Where they might condone or even help ROY STRICKLAND to remain a Federal fugitive they would not want LUCILE YUNT to take the blame for something ROY did.

Informant received some information to the effect that possibly some explosives will be moved from Jones County to Harrison Co. in the immediate future. This will reportedly be done by some one in the WKKKKOM but the informant was unable to learn who would do this. Informant was of the opinion that if the explosives were moved to

Harrison County he would be in a position to learn where they would be stored. Imformant was instructed to attempt to develop further information regarding this and immediately advised the FBI of anything he learned.

Informant learned that a short time ago VINCENT PURSER of Gulfport, Mississippi had a meeting with BÖB MC COY. This meeting took place after the meeting on 3/29/68 at which time MC COY, PURSER, DWIGHT SMITH and BYRON DE LA BECKWITH held a meeting. the second meeting MC COY reportedly offered to sell VINCENT PURSER an M-16 as he MC COY claimed he had several. MC COY instructed Informant learned that several PURSER to tell no one about this. days later MC COY was talking with CHARLES HALL, who operates a ice cream place on Teagarden Rd. in Mississippi City, and HALL inquired of MC COY information about the weapons he had for sale. MC COY asked HALL how he had learned of the weapons and he said CECIL At this point MC COY told HALL that he had PRENTICE told him. offered to sell VINCENT PURSER a weapon for \$250. but had told PURSER not to mention it to anyone and apparently PURSER had told PRENTICE of the offer and therefore VINCENT PURSER could not be trusted as he is unreliable and he is getting too old. indicated that he agreed with MC COY.

Informant advised that in the past he had seen an AR-15 hanging ever the living room door in the residence of BOB MC COY. This weapon has since disappeared and informant inquired of MC COY as to what he happened to it. According to MC COY he gave the weapon to DR. JOHN RUSSELL who has his offices at 1202 Broad Avenue, Gulfport, Mississippi. He reportedly gave or traded the weapon to Mayor MEADOWS of Gulfport. The last information the informant could develop was that MEADOWS still has the weapon, possibly aboard his boat, and that he and Chief of Police H. L. HOBBS of Gulfport use the weapon for target practice.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/62, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422½ South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993.

Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1963, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACRY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U.S. Code, and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

The subject should be considered possible suspect in any unsolved bank robberies, burglaries or armed robberis (possible ITSP violations) occuring after April 23, 1967. RAY should also be considered suspect in any future such violations and Bureau advised telephonically of any tentative identifications.

Any pertinent leads developed during review of past violations should be expeditiously run out and Bureau advised.

Subject's handwriting and hand printing not identified in bank robbery note file and his fingerprints are being searched against latents submitted in unsolved bank robbery and burglary violations.

The Bureau has advised that all leads must be set out by telephone or teletype.


