PRESS RELEASE

Las Vegas, Nevada April 17, 1968

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that Eric Starvo Galt is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on a Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Director J. Edgar Hoover stated that a Federal complaint was filed by the FBI in Birmingham, Alabama, today charging Galt with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. King in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

The FBI complaint charges that "On or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, ...Eric Starvo Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Martin Luther King, Jr.,... in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the constitution or laws of the United States; namely, the right to freely travel from state to state. In furtherance of this conspiracy, Eric Starvo Galt did, on or about March 30, 1968, purchase a rifle at Birmingham, Alabama..."

According to Mr. Hoover, a 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King occurred. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Mr. Hoover said that FBI Agents determined that the 30.06 rifle had been purchased from a guni dealer in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. The telescopic sight also was purchased from this dealer.

The FBI Director said that Galt, who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 11, 1968. Investigation disclosed that Galt purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August, 1967, and early April, 1968.

According to Mr. Hoover, Galt's travels in the Mustang included trips to Los Angeles, California; New Orleans, Louisiana; Birmingham, Alabama; and Mexico, as well as to Memphis, Tennessee, and Atlanta, Georgia. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta.

*

Intensive investigation by the FBI has disclosed that Galt has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi river vessels and as a merchant seaman. He is said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October, 1967; and in Long Beach, California, from December, 1967, to February, 1968.

Galt left Los Angeles on December 15, 1967, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contracting firm. He left New Orleans on December 19th and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1967.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Galt took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2, 1968.

The fugitive is described as white male. He is approximately 5'8" to 5'11" tall and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds. He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build.

Galt has brown hair, which he wears in a "brush" cut. He reportedly has blue eyes; his nose is straight and narrow; his teeth are straight and clean; and he has given his date of birth as July 20, 1931.

The fugitive is said to have a ne occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with hi ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear.

According to Mr. Hoover, persons who have met Galt describe him as a "loner" and state his language and diction have a "rural" quality and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for Vodka and beer. He is a fan of western and country music.

Galt should be considered armed and dangerous. Any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the nearest FBI office.

At about 12 noon, 4/17/68, LEE MATTHEWS telephoned the Las Yegas Office and stated he was "ready to blow the xlid off the KING murder".

LEE C. MATTHEUS, 256 Peachtree Hill Avenue, Atlanta, Georgia, was located in the vicinity of the Hickory House, Las Vegas Blvd. South, and after being advised of his rights by SA ROBERT MC/KINLEY, signed a waiver of rights form, and was interviewed/by SAS ROBERT MC KINLEY and NORRIS.

MATTHEWS stated he had been in Memphis, Tenn., at the time of the KING murder xxxxxxxx . He first stated he had been in the Veterans Administration Hospital, Memphis, Tenn., where he was treated for heart disease and alcoholism. He said he was released on 4/1/68.

At this point. MATTHEWS requested that he be taken to the Las Vegas Office, where he could be interviewed in privacy.

MATTHEWS stated that was a patient at the VA Mospital, Ward 9 South, with number . His wife LUCILE MATTHEWS was residing at 1256 White Station Road, Hemphis, Tenn. At the time of discharge he and his wife departed Memphis is a White 1965 Dodge, Polara, Florida license 3W65548. The stopped enroute LY in McLean Texas, Gallup, New Mexico, and arrived at the motel in Las vegas on the day KING was killed. His wife left MATTHEWS the next day because of his drinking.

MATTHENS displayed Georgia Driver's License V035164 issued 11/15/66. Address on the license 256 Peachtree Hill Ave, Atlanta, Georgia. HATTHENS is MIA, born 8/15/20, Perry, Georgia, is 5'11", 150, pounds, brown eyes, brown hair graying, clive complexion, slender build and speaks with a southern drawl.

At this point NATTHEWS was told that he had called the Las Vegas Office saying he was going to "blow the tid off the KING nurder.

MATTHENS then stated that he was lying. Said he had been contacted by an individual in Atlanta, Georgia, over a year and one half ago, and offered 1½ million dolaars to kill KING. His story in connection with this was disconnected and rambling. When agents tried to pin him down he suddenly said he was having a heart attack, saying he had bad pains in his chest. He took a "nitro pill". When he had quieted down sufficiently he was taken to the Clark County Health Center.

At the Health Center MATTHEWS/fainted. An ambulance was called from the Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital, and on arrival MATTHEWS was taken from the Health Center. The first aid man on the ambulance stated he did not believe that MATTHEWS had had a heart attack as his pulse and color were good. He said he believe MATTHEWS to be drunk and said "nitro pills" taken with alcohol can produce a symptom similar to a heart attack.

MATTHENS was taken to the Emergency Room, Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital, where he was examined by BRUCE GRAY MD. GRAY said that MATTHENS did not appear to have had a heart attack but stated to be certain he was having a EKG.

After review of the EKG recording, GRAY said that there were irregularities which could have been caused by a previous heart attack or bya current heart problem. He said because of this he must admit NATTHEWS to the hospital for observation.

JOE WOLCO TT, 1906 East Charleston Blvd., on 4/17/68, advised that he had received information from AA that one LEE MATTHEWS had requested help. He employed MATTHEWS as a cleaning man on 4/10/68 and provided a bed for him at his offices. On 4/17/68, WOLCOTT learned that MATTHEWS had stolen checks from WOLCOTT's office and had written a number of checks on WOLCOTT's account. MATTHEWS also told WOLCOTT's secretary that he MATTHEWS, had killed KING in Memphis Tenn. He said he had taken the weapon used and disposed of parts of the weapon in five different states.

WOLCOTT said he was filing a complaint on MATTHEWS this date.

Five of these tapes have the same length (1 1/16 inches) as Q69 and Q70. The other nine are longer, either 1 3/32 inches or 1 1/8 inches in length.

The K8 and K9 tapes were found to differ in printing from the tapes appearing on Q69 and Q70.

The tapes comprising K10 are of varying lengths; however, no significant differences were noted between the Q69 and Q70 laundry tapes when compared with some of the K10 tapes indicating they may have originated from the same machine.

Specimens K8, K9 and K10 are retained.
