At approximately 8:30 a.m. today, SAC KARL W. DISSLY, Kansas City, furnished the following information in captioned matter:

A confidential source of the Kansas City Office, who is a Gypsy, was recently in touch with Mrs. JOHN WILLIAMS, Sparks, Nevada. Mrs. WILLIAMS is a Gypsy fortune teller who operates under the name THERISA BROWN at 1548 B Street, Sparks, Nevada, telephone 358-9216. THERISA BROWN reportedly told the Kansas City Office source that sometime between 4/1 and 10/68 a male individual came to her establishment at Sparks, Nevada. He gave ROWN \$150 for a reading. While Mrs. BROWN was praying for him in connection with her reading, she placed her hands around his waist. At that time she detected that he was wearing a money belt which appeared to her to be perhaps quite well filled with money. When she told the customer he was due to take a long trip, he said that was correct. There was also some indication that he verified the fact that he had in the recent past had a hotel room in San Francisco.

BROWN reportedly told the informant that about four days after MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassination, she saw a picture on television of the assassin and was certain it was the same individual described above.

The Kansas City source admitted the possibility that the information may not be true. She pointed out, however, that if it is true, THERISA BROWN should be able to make an excellent identification in view of her personality and the fact that she gives the type of readings which require an excellent memory generally.

The Bureau's source of this information should not be disclosed when contacting THERISA BROWN. Additionally, the source has stated that in the event it is disclosed to BROWN that another Gypsy was the Bureau's source in this matter, she feels it would jeopardize our attempt to obtain information, inasmuch as the other Gypsy would certainly either refuse to talk or fail to tell the truth.

PRESTON states his company manufactures an auto safety product which is sold nationally. He said his company does not handle any of the sales of this product, noting all sales are handled exclusively by Allstate Safety Control, Inc., Room 201, Tanglewood, Office Building, 7509 Cantrell Road, Little Rock, Arkansas. He said if NISSEN was selling this auto safety part, he would be employed by Allstate Safety Control, Inc. He suggested ROBERT SPEARS, manager, of that company be contacted.

Leavenworth, Karsas, from Jaly, 1965, until his release in April, 1967, he became very friendly with another inmate identified as 1900 Mela and kemanash was originally from Western Rauses, form unrecalled, and was alleged to have bootlegged in Mississippi. According to MISSEN, he and McHANAHAN worked together in the shoe factory at Leavenworth. MISSEN claimed that the FBI had tried to "get" HeMANAHAN on bank burglary charges but were unsuccessful and McHANAHAN was presently in the penitentlary on charges of concealing three stoles autos and was due for release semetime next year.

RIESEN said he had previously met McMANANAN before going to the penitentiary in Jackson, Hississippi, and he recognized McMANANAN "in the joint."

NISSEN said that just before he was scheduled to be paroled from Leavenworth, McMAMAN approached NISSEN, stating that he knew MISSEN was going to Atlanta as soon as he squared away two local detainers and McMAMAN told MISSEN he needed him to set things up for him.

MCHANAMAN told NISSEN that \$100,000 had been offered by the White Enights of the Ku Klux Klan to be paid to anyone who would kill MARTIN LUTURE KING, JR.

HISSEN stated that after he was squared away on his two local Toxas charges, HcHAHAHAH wanted him to contact a Hrs. FMU EURE, at the Eure Realty, Jackson, Hississippi. HcHAHAHAH claimed Hrs. EURE is listed as a correspondent by him at Leavenworth Ponitentiary. According to instructions, HISSEN was to contact Mrs. EURE and ask her when she next writes to HcHAHAHAH at the penitentiary to tell him "DOH" had arrived. NcHAHAHAH indicated he would write and tell EURE that HISSEN was "O.K."

If HISSEN wanted to try to "pull this" bimself, Hrs. EURE would put him in contact with two people identified to NISSEN only as FLOYD LNU, as becorary colonel in the National Guard at Jackson, Hississippi, and a second person when HISSEN cannot now identify. NISSEN stated, however, that the unidentified person, according to McMANAHAN, had recently been appointed a Deputy U. S. Harshal at Jackson.

It was NISSEN's understanding that if he were willing to pull the job, he was to get in touch with Ers. EURE, advise her, and who would thereafter put him in touch with the above two men, both of whom NISSEN understands are associated with the White Knights. NISSEN stated those men would insure payment if KING were killed.

NISSEN continued, saying that if he was supposed to interested in doing the job binself, he was supposed to "case KING's place," (location not specified) in Atlanta, and check the layout. NISSEN pointed out he could do this rather easily, as before serving time, he worked for Encyclopedia Americana. After getting the layout, MISSEN was to tell McMANMAN the set-up so that when McMANMAN was released from the penitentiary he could handle it himself. HISSEN stated he would get a percentage of the money received by McMANAMAN for casing MING's residence. MISSEN stated that based on his knowledge of McMANAMAN, he believes McMANAMAN is perfectly capable of committing the plot. He stated McMANAMAN "hates Negroes and lete them know it in the pen."

NISSEN also claimed that another inmate at Leavenworth, a JOHN MAY, a nearby celluate of NISSEN's when he was at the penitentiary, has knowledge of the aforementioned plot.

MAY is from Rock Island, Illinois, and has worked as a machinist at the arsenal in Rock Island. He is presently at Leavenworth on a Dyer Act charge. McMANAMAN had asked NISSEN to contact MAY to determine if MAY could build a long barrel and firing pin for a new type of .38 automatic pistol. McMANAMAN knows that MAY is an excellent machinist and a friend of NISSEN's. According to NISSEN, McMANAMAN intended to use this long barrel pistol with the scope and firing pin to be made by MAY in the killing of XING. McMANAMAN planned to dispose of the scope, fixing pin and long barrel, and replace the original barrel and firing pin and in this manner the gun could not be traced to McMANAMAN.

NISSEN claims be contacted MAY about HeMAMAMAN's proposal and MAY reportedly told MISSEN he did not want anything to do with the plan, but he stated he could make a long

barrol for the gun if so desired. MISSEN advised it would be "O.K." for the FMI to contact MAY in order to verity NISSEN's story. NISSEN feels MAY will protect him, as they are good friends.

MISSEN claims that MAY also told him he also had heard of the \$100,000 sum put up for the death of KING. MAY's information apparently came from an unrecalled source in either North or South Carolina.

NISSEN understands the \$100,000 is supposed to be a standing offer.

JOHN EMMANUEL MAY, USP-L, Inmate #82459, PBI #4 714 728, sentenced in USDC, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 9/27/65 to 5 years for ITSHV on interview 7/19/67 by SA MAX E. RICHARDSON advised that he considered the story by NISSEN regarding an alleged plot to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. just one of HISSEN's "cock and bill stories".

EAY stated that he is not an associate of inmate MC MARAMAN, knows him only well enough to recognize him in the institution and has never talked to him. He added that he, MAY, keeps to himself, trying to serve his sentence without becoming involved in the troubles of other inmates and that he is not acquainted with the associates of MC MANAMAN. He denied knowing the identity of any inmate known as "LITTLE RED".

According to MAY it is well known to all immates in the institution that he is a capable machinist and that he does a great deal of the mechanical drawing in connection with the work done in this institution. He added that when he became acquainted with former inmate BONALD JAMES HISSEN he learned that MISSEN had few friends among the other immates. Further that MISSEN liked to talk about himself as well as about any subject, with anyone who would listen to him. He explained that MISSEN found him a good listener and would often spend several hours in the doorway of his, MAY's cell, talking while he, MAY was working on his drawings. He added that he celdem did much of the talking but only agreed with whatever NISSEN had to say on whatever topic was being discussed.

MAY stated he does recall that on one occasion NISSUN had mentioned that one "MAC", and he assumed NISSUN was referring to MC MANAMAN, had informed him there was a plot to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. for \$100,000. He added that NISSUN stated that it was "all set up" but that he did not want to tell him too much about it. MAY stated he informed NISSUN that he did not want to know anything about the matter. He said he further told NISSUN that KING was probably so well guarded that a person could not "reach him with a ten foot pole". MAY also recalled that HISSUN claimed that "MAC" had told him to get in touch with someone whose name he mentioned but which he does not now recall, in the real estate business when NISSEN was released.

MAY went on to state that he believes he indicated to NISSEN that he, NAY had heard some similar comment regarding \$100,000 being offered to kill KING. MAY stated this referred to an occasion several years ago when he was drinking in some bar in Raleigh, N. C. He explained that he was not acquainted with any of the occupants of this bar. He added that some of the occupants were discussing the current racial problems and one individual made the comment that "Someone had a good idea when they offered \$100,000 to get KING killed".

HAY further stated that at no time had NISSEH ever requested him to make any part of a gun. He stated that NISSEH had once inquired if he, MAY, could make a gun and that he informed NISSEH that any machinist with any ability could make a rifle. MAY recalled that he and NISSEN at the same time were talking about what an advantage it would be for the military to have a rifle with a longer magazine or clip that would carry more cartridges than the one presently used.

MAY advised that when MISSEM mentioned the alleged plot to kill KING he paid little attention to what was being paid and passed it off as just another of MISSEM's stories.

CHARLES L. FORLMAN, JE., USP-L Innate \$81476, FEI \$970 939 sentenced in USDC, Cheyenne, Myoming, 5/12/64 to 6 years for ITSMY, advised on 7/19/67 that he was not an associate of MC MANAMAN, that he knew no innate associate of MC MANAMAN's who was known as "LITTLE RED" and that he had never heard any comment from any source regarding a plot or offer of \$100,000 for the killing of MARTIN LUTKER KINS, JR.

FOREMAN stated that for a period of time when he first arrived at this institution he frequently ate at the same table with MC MANANAN but that although there was no friction between then they made other friends with whom they eat. He stated that he is aware that MC MANAMAN diplikes edored people and avoids contact with colored insates but that he is not outspoken on the subject. He added that he had

never heard MC MANANAN make any type of threatening or critical remark to any colored inmate and he is not known to have had any trouble with such inmates. FOREMAN stated that he did not know any of the present associates of MC MANAMAN.

USP, Leavenworth records reflect that LEROY BASIL MC MANAMAN #81371, FEI #1 244 125 was sentenced in USDC, Wichita, Kansas 1/18/63 to 8 years for ITSMV and on 3/31/64 in USDC, Topeka, Kansas to 1 year consecutive for Barboring a fugitive.

Under present mail procedures at the USP, Leavenworth, Kansas, no record is kept of what mail if any is actually received from or sent to any particular correspondent on an inmate's authorized correspondent list. SYBIL ZURE, Jackson, Hississippi is not on HC MANANAN's authorized visitor list.
