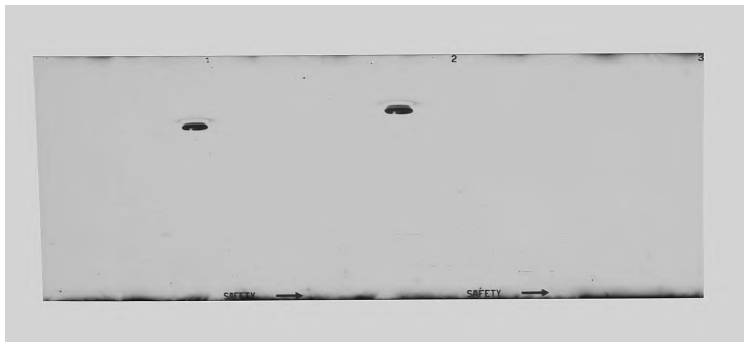

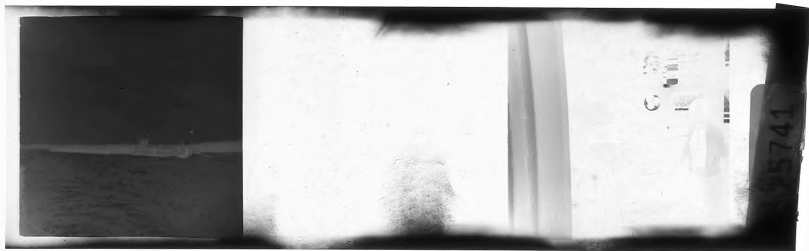

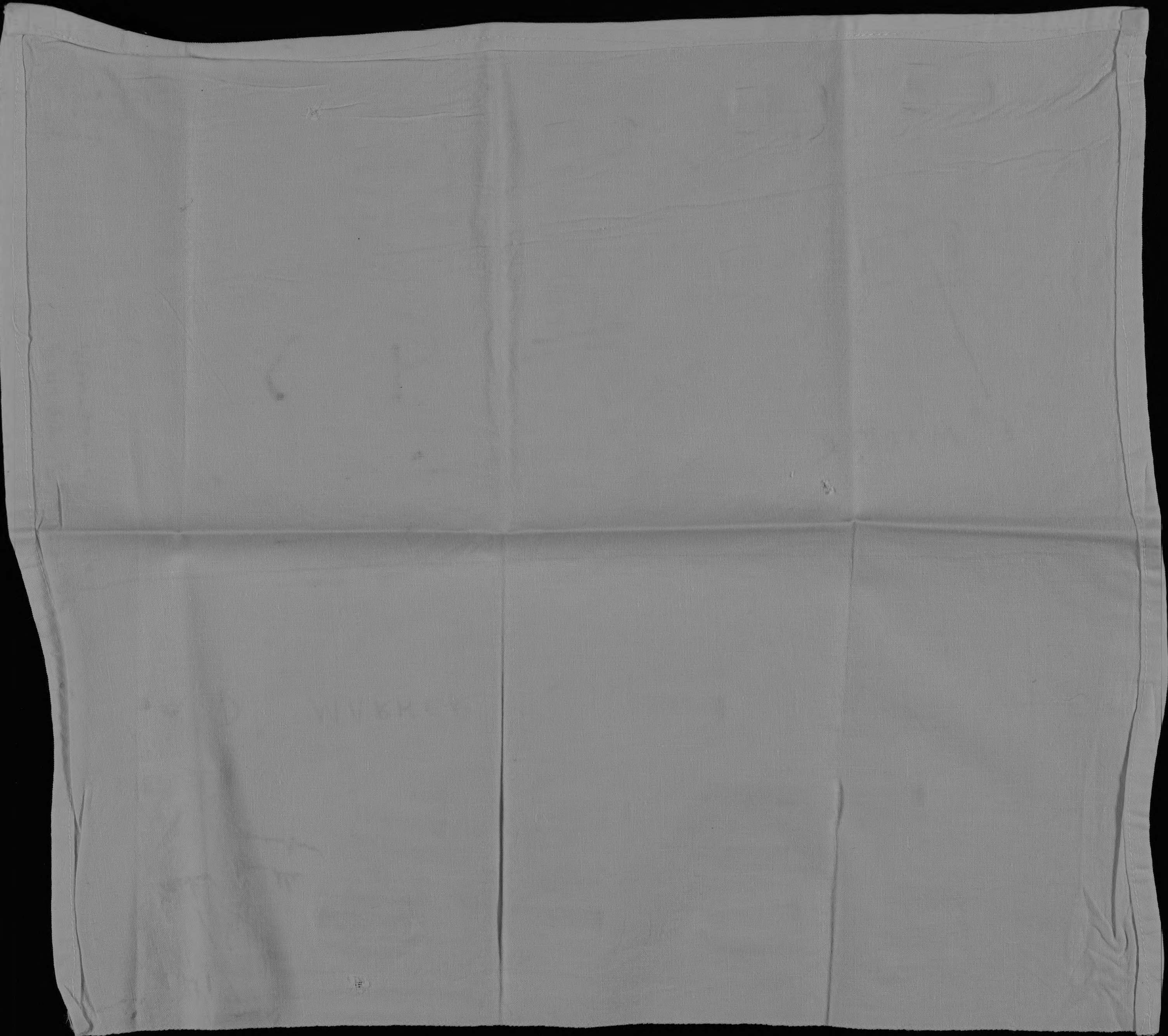

headed by George McWhorter
McWhorter was formerly connected
with company in Atlanta, Ga.
McWhorter Materials Handling
Inc of Atlanta which later
merged with some type of company
in Texas - info was developed
indicating strike prolonged as
investigation as with support
McWhorter with knowledge
of Joe Davis Mayor of
Huntsville in order to
obtain contract with city -

Violence was encouraged
by McWhorter to prolong
strike & result in stable state -

Tracy - Contract came two days after
strike commenced -
lasted about 3 months
before settlement - Behind
organized crime connection
