on the morning of April 6th, Saturday, I boarded a
a R School-middle Bus on Kalakaua Ave in Waikiki,
Honolulu for the Bishop Museum, on Kalih Street. About four or
five blocks before that a young girl sat on seat down, be-
gan asking questions of the Bus driver. Suddenly I heard
mutterings from a man across the aisle from me (who was
working a cross-word puzzle). I looked over, he smiled a sort
of silly smile of disgust, shook his head at the girl, obviously
thought her questions of the driver ridiculous. I looked again at
his profile thinking how very much he looked like the drawing
of a man, I had seen in the morning paper, who was being
sought as a suspect for the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King.
I stared at the contour of the face - a rather long nose (not as
full a face as the picture I have since seen). Only saw
the profile which certainly resembled the artist's drawing.
He turned to see me staring, folded his paper and left
the Bus. I watched him walk up the hill to the right
of the main street (may have been King Street menueon).
There seemed to be some large bldgs. up on the hill -
perhaps a Hospital?

This has worried me ever since - so here it is for
what it may be worth to you. The possibility of
a hint in Hawaii which I pray does not prove
to be false.

Dear Mr. Weeks :

Here's a lead - perhaps a slim lead - on Galt. I don't want to get mixed up in this situation and I request that nothing with my name on it be forwarded to the National Archives if the lead checks out as a fact.

Erich (not Eric) Starvo Galt may - repeat may - have stayed here in New Haven at 366 Elm Street around February and March this year. Galt may have received mail there from (1) a trade association of dance school operators or teachers - 4 X 9 brown envelope, no window; (2) a trade journal magazine, standard size, very thin - 15 pages, for dance school operators or instructors. Please check Arthur Murray-New York for advertising mail to him, plus exact names of the above.

The building may be managed by Ripps-Calechman, now. Oldest tenant there is Royce Smith, pervert and head of the Yale Co-op Bookstore. Smith comes from a small town near Atlanta, Ga. (According to the radio, a housewife in Atlanta said Galt lived there in January.)

Several weeks before the King homicide there were two sedans parked nearby - one with Arkansas markers and white and the other from Alabama - color not recalled.

Galt may have been in this neighborhood as early as the beginning of the school year last fall, with 5'6" friend.

The FBI can easily and quickly check the mailing lists mentioned above without interrogating anyone at 366 Elm, just a phone call to New York. If investigating this slim lead does establish that Erich Starvo Galt did indeed live at 366 Elm, then it still would not be necessary to send in show-the-card FBI agents to that building or to otherwise publicize it. Accordingly I would like to suggest official questioning of area tenants be held up until I can add a few more details. This would be a waste of time unless and until Galt is placed at 366.
