<p>Informant advised that after observing an artists sketch of the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING in the newspapers and the description furnished through the news media, he furnished the name of JOHN BURKE DANIELS, as a good suspect. even though Informant met DANIELS in Conn. State prison in 1965, where DANIELS was serving time for burglary or Robbery. He believes DANIELS is out on Parole at leastt he was when he last saw him in 1966 at Hartford. He DANIELS harbors hatred toward the negro race and advocates violence against them as the only method to curb their advancement. On one occasion DANIELS made a statement that he would get XXXX KING someday. He considers DANIELS as a psychopath. Informant was shown a photo of DANIELS #9294, FCI, Danbury, Conn. dated 6/52 and he advised that DANIELS has changed very little since the photo taken. He has no idea as to DANIELS present whereabouts.</p> <p>Informant a dvised that SCOTT FARRELL and a LEONARD (LNU) were responsible for a break at F.J. Dayhill Co., Kimberly Ave, New Haven about a week ago, where adding machines, etc. were taken. (This info. being furnished to New Haven, P.D.) over</p>

Informant also stated that FARRELL also recently asked him if he could unload some air conditioners for him which ~~thru~~ he didn't have as yet but planned to get soon but didn't say where from.

Informant advised that VINCENT ACETO, "Vinny", a salesman with Sommers Pontiac, is a fence and gets his merchandise from various burglars in New Haven area.

He advised that EARL BRIGGS answers the description of one of the subjects in above captioned titled bank robbery at Stamford, BRIGGS is friendly with EDDIE KNIGHT and DEVLIN, both of whom own part and hang around the "Red Carpet", East Haven, Conn. BRIGGS hangs around a place located at Grand Ave. near front st., New Haven. and is capable of pulling a bank job. He believes BRIGGS works for the town of North Haven and is on parole.

DATE: 4/23/68

On 4/8/68, PRI advised that an individual named "BOOGALOO", true name unknown, had been attempting to agitate young negroes in Stamford, Connecticut, subsequent to the Assassination of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68. He said that BOOGALOO was making inflammatory statements to young negroes in an attempt to instigate some retaliation against the white community who he claimed was responsible for the death of DR. KING.

PRI advised that BOOGALOO had not been successful in his attempts to agitate the negro community as there were no incidents which could be attributed to him; however, he felt that BOOGALOO would continue attempts to agitate and unsettle the negro community in Stamford.

On the same date, Det. Capt. THOMAS O'CONNOR, Stamford Police Department, advised that BENJAMIN SINGLETON, aka. "Boogaloo" has previously been arrested by the Stamford Police Department for Breach of Peace - Interfering with a Police Officer in the performance of his duties.

Capt. O'CONNOR explained that in January 1967, Officers of the Stamford Police Department were required to make a narcotics arrest in the negro area of Stamford. He said that a crowd gathered and several individuals, one of whom was later identified as SINGLETON, yelled obscenities to the officers and tried to agitate the crowd into attacking the Police Officers. Capt. O'CONNOR advised that when SINGLETON was identified, a warrant charging him with Breach of Peace - Interfering with a Police Officer in the performance of his duties, was obtained and SINGLETON was arrested without incident. Capt. O'CONNOR advised the charge was later nolleed in Circuit Court, Stamford.

On 4/9/68, Capt. O'CONNOR advised that SINGLETON had been observed participating in a march on downtown Stamford during a disturbance in Stamford on the evening of 4/8/68. O'CONNOR advised that SINGLETON had been closely watched by Officers of the Stamford Police Department and was not involved in any of the window breaking or destruction that was later attributed to that march. He said SINGLETON was not arrested in connection with that march.

On 4/9/68, PRI advised that the word was being spread through the negro community in Stamford that a disturbance was to be created at King's Department Store, Stamford, and all who wanted would be able to loot from the store. PRI did not know who was responsible for those rumors but said most of the negro community was aware of them.

The above information regarding the potential disturbance at King's was made available to Capt. O'CONNOR of the Stamford PD who advised that his department had received several anonymous phone calls and tips which corroborated that King's was the target for the night. He advised that he was going to double the patrols in the vicinity of King's Department Store.

On 4/10/68, Capt. O'CONNOR advised that a group of about 20 negroes had gathered on Pacific St., Stamford, which is in the area of King's Department Store; however, no disturbance occurred. Capt. O'CONNOR advised that any potential riot or looting at King's was probably prevented because of the extra Police Activity in that area.

On 4/10, 4/11/68, and 4/12/68, PRI advised that he knew of no planned demonstrations or disturbances in the area and stated he felt the racial situation in Stamford had "cooled" to the point there would be no more incidents. On each occasion, he stated he would immediately advise the FBI of any incidents which might occur in Stamford. He further said he knew of no individuals who had come into Stamford to participate in the disturbances of 4/8 and 4/9/68.

THE CRIMES: Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on April 23, 1967, while serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission. He subsequently allegedly conspired, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, to violate the civil rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel on April 4, 1968.

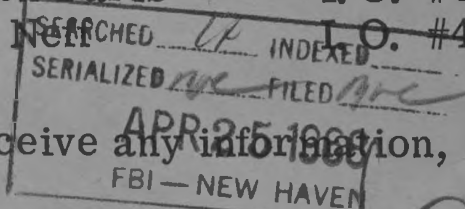
THE CRIMINAL: A 40-year-old white native of Illinois, who is known as a "loner" and "drifter" and has taken elaborate steps to establish a false identity, Ray has an extensive criminal record, including convictions for burglary, robbery and forging U. S. Postal Money Orders. Outstanding characteristics include a straight narrow nose, straight and even teeth, a noticeably protruding left ear and a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe. He has taken dancing lessons, attended bartending school, enrolled in a correspondence course in locksmithing and traveled widely in a 1966 Mustang recovered in Atlanta, Georgia, a week after Dr. King's murder. Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

PROCESS: A Federal warrant issued at Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charges Ray with unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement for robbery. Another Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, as Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen.

Reference is made to memo SA Julian C. Nichols, 4/11/68 and memo SA James G. Nagle, 4/15/68, pertaining to laundry markings of the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York.

The FBI Laboratory has advised the Memphis Division that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "20R-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Co., Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type.

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.

Memphis requests this office recontact all laundries determined to be operating Thermo-Seal Marking Machines in an effort to locate laundry using the code, "20R-3."

There follows a complete listing of the laundries as set forth in referenced memoranda.

Each Senior Resident Agent is requested to coordinate contacts at laundries in your territory.

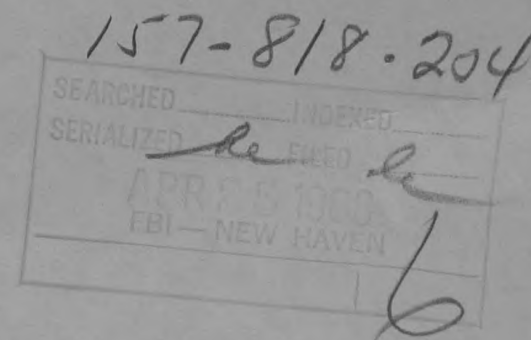

The following investigation was conducted by SA BRONI S. MACYS and IC JOSEPH L. SHERIDAN, JR.:

On 4/16/68, Mrs. GLORIA WILLIAMS, owner of Williams Ballroom Studio, 507 Campbell Avenue, West Haven, Connecticut, advised that ERIC STAVO GALT nor anyone by the name of LOWMYER or similar sounding names were ever students at this studio. She stated that she is acquainted with every adult who has taken ballroom dance lessons within the past couple of years and identified them further as long time residents of West Haven.

Mrs. WILLIAMS advised that her studio is the only studio in West Haven which instructs adults in ballroom dancing. She stated the remaining dance studios instruct only children and teenagers.

On the same date, Mrs. CAROL FARRELL, 1505 New Haven Avenue, Woodmont, Milford, Conn., advised that GALT is not known to her. She also advised that her dance studios, one in Woodmont and the other in Devon, are the only ones in the Milford area who instruct adults in ballroom dancing.

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on March 10, 1928. He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Anyone with information concerning this fugitive is requested to immediately contact the nearest office of the FBI, the telephone number of which may be found on the first page of local telephone directories.

In view of his son's present employment, and residence, Mr. YAGLENSKI stated that it was entirely logical for his son and the above car to be seen on April 9, 1968, at Arlington, Virginia. Mr. YAGLENSKI exhibited a photograph of his son to the interviewing agent at this time, and it was noted that the photo does not match the description of the suspect who committed the shooting. Also, Mr. YAGLENSKI advised that JOHN's eyes are brown and his hair is black, combed with a wave in it.

In addition, the name ERIC STARVO GALT was included in checks of the Credit Bureaus, Police Departments, Voters Registration, Laundries, Dance Studios, etc. in the Stamford RA.

On 4/9/68, the records of the Stamford Police Department were checked with negative results. Sgt. DANIEL HANRAHAN caused the records to be searched at the request of SA WILLIAM C. BRADSHAW.

On 4/10/68, the police departments at Greenwich, Darien, (which includes Noroton) and Norwalk (which includes Rowayton) Wilton, Ridgefield, and New Canaan were checked with negative results.

The City Directories for all the towns listed above were also checked and one reference was found to a WALTER LOHMEYER wife JEANNE. Results of further inquiry regarding WALTER LOHMEYER will be set forth hereinafter.

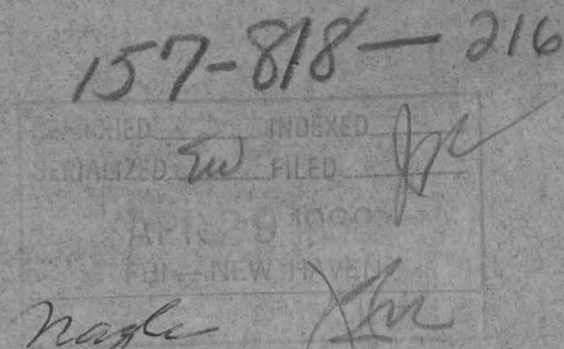
On 4/11/68, Mrs. RUTH MARSHALL, Greenwich, Connecticut, Credit Bureau advised her files contain no references to any of the above variations of the subject's name.

On the same date, MAX BARON, Manager, Stamford, Connecticut, Credit Bureau, advised his records were negative for all names except LOHMEYER. He stated he had one listing for a WALTER G. LOHMEYER, 46 Dorset Lane, Stamford, wife JEANNE, with employment at Perkin-Elmer Corp., Wilton, Conn.

LOHMEYER was described as being 56 years old in 1964 married for the third time and has been known to the Credit Bureau since 1937. A previous residence of Northport, Long Island, N. Y. was shown as was a previous employment at Fairchild Camera, New York.

On 4/11/68, the various registrar's of voters for the Towns listed above were contacted regarding variations of the subject's name with negative results.

Memo of SA JULIAN C. NICHOLS, dated 4/11/68, sets forth the names of the various laundries and cleaning establishments which allegedly used the Textile Marking Machine Co., Equipment in their operation:

Memo of SAC CHARLES E. WEEKS, to all agents dated 4/10/68, sets forth background data concerning the cloth laundry tags pertinent to the investigation. These tags bore the code numbers 02B-6 or D2B-6. Information received from Mr. TED MARTINO of the Springdale Laundry, Stamford, Conn., determined that there are only three laundries in Stamford, Conn., which do flatwork. The other two being Woodside Laundry and Consolidated, a New York organization which does all their laundry work in New York. Subsequently Mr. FRED VON TOBEL of the Woodside Laundry was contacted and both he and Mrs. MARTINO advised that they did not use the textile marking system. All the other laundries listed in the memo of SA NICHOLS were contacted without developing any information pertinent to the investigation.

Subsequent a memo of SAC dated 4/15/68, where in it was instructed that all dancing schools in the pertinent RA territories be contacted for any prior attendance at such schools by ERIC STARVO GALT.

On 4/16/68, a survey of the yellow pages covering the Stamford Resident Agency territory was made, all the dancing schools listed therein were contacted with negative results.

Previously mentioned in this memorandum was WALTER G. LOHMEYER. The records of the Stamford, Connecticut, Credit Bureau, reveal that WALTER LOHMEYER is employed at Perkin-Elmer Corp., Wilton, Connecticut.

On 4/15/68, Mr. HERBERT DUNNING, Security Officer, Perkin-Elmer Corp., Wilton, Conn., made available information concerning WALTER G. LOHMEYER. LOHMEYER was born 12/10/07 at New Haven, Conn., has Social Security Number 043-03-9141. He has been employed at Perkin-Elmer since 8/14/61. LOHMEYER's wife's name is given as JEANNE. He has no children, or relatives whose names are pertinent to the investigation except one CARLTON R. LOHMEYER, born 1909 at New Haven, Conn., and presently residing 906 Rolling Rock Rd., Pittsburgh, Pa. The above information was taken from LOHMEYER's employment records which were dated 1961.

DUNNING advised that LOHMEYER does not travel on behalf of Perkin-Elmer and a review of the employment records for the pertinent period determined that LOHMEYER was at work at the time. It is noted that a teletype was received from the NYO dated 4/11/68, (serial 84) wherein LOHMEYER's name was evidently forwarded to the Office of Origin by the Charlotte Division. LOHMEYER was arrested for speeding in Wilson, N. C., on 7/10/53 at which time he forfeited his bond. Subsequently it was set forth to identify LOHMEYER and locate him with leads in the teletype for Cincinnati and New York. It is noted that a teletype was sent by the NHO on 4/15/68, advising both Cincinnati and New York that LOHMEYER's residence and employment had been determined.
