GONZALEE HENDERSUN - PRI On 4/8/68, FRI advised that an individual named "BOOGALOO", true name unknown, had been attempting to agitate young negroes in Stamford, Connecticut, subsequent to the Assassination of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68. He said that BOOGALOO was making inflamatory statements to young negroes in an attempt to instigate some retaliation against the white community who he claimed was responsible for the death of DR. KING. PRI advised that BOOGALOO had not been sussessful in his attempts to agitate the negro community as there were no incidents which could be attributed to him; however, he felt that BOOGAL 00 would continue attempts to agitate and unsettle the negro community in Stamford. On the same date, Det. Capt. THOMAS O'CONNOR. Stan ford Police Department, advised that BENJAMIN SINGLETON, aka. "Boogaloo" has previously been arrested by the Stamford Police Department for Breach of Peace - Interfering with a Police Officer in the performance of his duties. Capt. O'CONNOR explained that in January 1980, Officers of the Stamford Police Department were required to make a narcotics arrest in the negro area of Stamford. He said that a crowd gathered and several individuals, one of whom was later identified as SINGLETON, yelled obscenities to the officers and tried to agitate the crowd into attacking the Police Officers. Capt. O'CONNOR advised that when SINGLETON was identified, a warrant charging him with Breach of Peace - Interfering with a Police Officer in the performance of his duties, was obtained and SIN LETON was arrested without incident. Capt. O'CONNOR advised the charge was later nolled in Circuit Court, Stamford. on 4/9/68, Capt. O'CONNOR advised that SINGLETON had been observed participating in a march on downtown Stamford during a disturbance in Stamford on the evening of 4/8/68. O'CONNOR advised that SINGLETON had been closely watched by Officers of the Stamford Police Department and was not involved in any of the window breaking or destruction that was later attributed to that march. He said SINGLETON was not arrested in connection with that march. On 4/9/68, RRI advised that the word was being spread through the negro community in Stamford that a disturbance was to be created at King's Department Store, Stamford, and all who wanted would be able to loot from the store. PRI did not know who was responsible for those rumors but said most of the negro comunity was aware of them. The above information regarding the potential disturb ace at King's was made available to Capt. O'CONNOR o the Stamford PD who advised that his department had received several anonymous phone calls and tips which corroborated that King's was the target for the night. He advised that he was going to double the patrols in the vicinity if King's Department Store. On 4/10/68, Capt. O'CONNOR advised that a group of about 20 negroes had gathered on Pacific St., Stanford, which is in the area of King's Department Store; however, no disturbance occurred. Capt. O'CONNOR advised that any potential riot or

looting at King's was probably prevented because of the extra Police Activity in that area.

On 4/10, 4/11/68, and 4/12/68, PRI advised that he knew of no planned demonstrations or disturbances in the area and stated he felt the racial situation in Stanford had "cooled" to the point there would be no more incidents. On each occasion, he stated he would immediately advise the FBI of any incidents which might occur in Stanford. He further said he knew of no individuals who had come into Stamford to participate in the disturbances of 4/8 and 4/9/68.

THE CRIMES: Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on April 23, 1967, while serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission. He subsequently allegedly conspired, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, to violate the civil rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel on April 4, 1968.

THE CRIMINAL: A 40-year-old white native of Illinois, who is known as a "loner" and "drifter" and has taken elaborate steps to establish a false identity, Ray has an extensive criminal record, including convictions for burglary, robbery and forging U. S. Postal Money Orders. Outstanding characteristics include a straight narrow nose, straight and even teeth, a noticeably protruding left ear and a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe. He has taken dancing lessons, attended bartending school, enrolled in a correspondence course in locksmithing and traveled widely in a 1966 Mustang recovered in Atlanta, Georgia, a week after Dr. King's murder. Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

PROCESS: A Federal warrant issued at Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charges Ray with unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement for robbery. Another Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, as Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen.



The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number. 
The following investigation was conducted by SA BRONI S. MACYS and IC JOSEPH L. SHERIDAN, JR.:

On 4/16/68, Mrs. GLORIA WILLIAMS, owner of Williams Ballroom Studio, 507 Campbell Avenue, West Haven, Connecticut, advised that ERIC STAVO GALT nor anyone by the name of LOWMYER or similar sounding names were ever students at this studio. She stated that she is acquainted with every adult who has taken ballroom dance lessons within the past couple of years and identified them further as long time residents of West Haven.

Mrs. WILLIAMS advised that her studio is the only studio in West Haven which instructs adults in ballroom dancing. She stated the remaining dance studios instruct only children and teenagers.

On the same date, Mrs. CAROL FARRELL, 1505 New Haven Avenue, Woodmont, Milford, Conn., advised that GALT is not known to her. She also advised that her dance studios, one in Woodmont and the other in Devon, are the only ones in the Milford area who instruct adults in ballroom dancing.

"TEN MOST WANTED FUGITIVES" PROGRAM

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet habelieved fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons
on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division,
succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on March 10, 1928. He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a 'loner' and 'drifter' whose language and diction reflect a 'rural' quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.




