



By teletype dated 4/29/68, the Bureau instructed that all offices having law enforcement agencies in their territories which maintain unidentified latent fingerprints in connection with matters under their jurisdiction should immediately contact these agencies and request that the fingerprints of subject JAMES EARL RAY as set forth on the I.O. be compared with latents obtained since his escape from Missouri State Penitentiary on 4/23/67.

Note, this lead is to be covered only for a period of approximately one year.

All Agents assigned to liaison with respective police departments should immediately check that department regarding the above lead and submit a memorandum for the file concerning results of same.

Also, note all leads in this case are to be handled within twenty-four hours.
