## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

WILLIAM BAILEY FAULKNER, 94 Maplewood Avenue, Milford, Connecticut, was advised of his rights and waived same as shown on an executed warning and waiver form.

FAULKNER advised that since approximately December, 1967, he has written a number of articles for the United Klans of America (UKA) publication "The Fiery Cross", Tuscaloosa, Alabama, which articles he stated were anti-semitic in nature. He advised that prior thereto he also wrote articles for the publication, "Common Sense", which articles he stated appeared in the December 1967, issue and was entitled, "Let's Bury The Liberals". He also advised he wrote an article for GERALD K. SMITH, the leader of the Soldiers of the Cross, which article appeared in their publication, "The Flag of the Cross" in April, 1968, and was entitled, "The International Jewish Bankers".

He also advised that he has written several leaflets for E. J. MC CALLUM's Citizens Anti-Communist Committee of Connecticut. He advised that one of these leaflets he specifically recalled had to do with MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and was entitled, "A Tribute to MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.". He stated this leaflet set forth known communist background and affiliations of KING.

He advised that for a period of approximately two years up until April, 1967, he was in the restaurant business at Warrensburg, New York, where he owned two restaurants. One of these he stated was known as Charles Restaurant, located on Main Street and the other was known as the Trout Brook Restaurant, located on Route 9, both Warrensburg, New York. He advised that due to being unable to obtain sufficient credit, he was forced to close both businesses.

He advised that prior to Warrensburg, New York, he was employed for a period of approximately four years by JESSE and DONALD GADDIS at Freeport, Bahama Islands, as a private pilot. He said during that time he was a resident of the colony of the Bahamas. He said that with regard to his pilot's license, he obtained same in approximately 1946, at Danbury, Connecticut, and has maintained it on a current basis up to the present time.

He stated that in approximately October of 1967, a Mr. WILLIAM MILLER of 94 Maplewood Avenue, Milford, Connecticut, introduced himself to FAULKNER and shortly thereafter started talking to FAULKNER about the UKA. FAULKNER advised that at about this time he was employed by the Mashkin Freight Lines out of East Hartford, Connecticut, and was a resident at 267 East Broadway, Milford, Connecticut. FAULKNER pointed out that prior to meeting MILLER he, FAULKNER, was already writing for the UKA. However, he was not a member of the UKA. He stated that he had prior to that time written away to the national headquarters of the UKA, seeking literature and information. As a result of this, he returned certain literature to the national headquarters of the UKA noting certain errors in the writing. As a result of this, he received correspondence asking him to write articles for the "Fiery Cross".

FAULKNER described MILLER as follows:

FAULKNER continued that MILLER in his conversations with him continued to talk about the UKA and through MILLER, FAULKNER obtained an application for membership within the Klan. He stated that during this period prior to becoming a member, he learned that WILLIAM MILLER holds the position of Imperial Kludd of the Realm of Connecticut in the UKA which FAULKNER stated was the same as Chaplain.



FAULKNER advised that he was sworn into the UKA at Durham, Connecticut, on April 12, 1968, in the residence of ROBERT WALKER, Stagecoash Road, Durham, Connecticut. He stated that ROBERT WALKER is the Imperial Representative of the UKA for the Realm of Connecticut. He advised that WALKER on the wall of his basement where Klan meetings are held has an official charter for the State of Connecticut for the UKA from ROBERT SHELTON, the national leader of the UKA.

FAULKNER advised that at this meeting of the UKA at which he was sworn in there were approximately 26 to 27 individuals in attendance. He stated that this is the only Klan meeting that he has ever attended. He stated that sworn in with him on that same night were two other individuals, however, he stated he only recalls the name of one of these individuals who was so sworn in. He stated this individual who was sworn in the same night as he, is known to him as SKIP BARDELL who is approximately age 24 and owns an Atlantic gasoline station on East Broadway in Milford, Connecticut. He stated that also in attendance at this same meeting in addition to WILLIAM MILLER and ROBERT WALKER and the above mentioned SKIP BARDELL, were the following:

JOHN BELLMORE, whom FAULKNER described as the Imperial Kleagle of the Realm of Connecticut. He stated he believes that BELLMORE resides in Seymour, Connecticut, however, he did not know where BELLMORE is employed.

CHARLES CONGER from Woodmont, Connecticut, who he stated is employed by the Coca Cola Company as a driver. He stated that previous to employment with the Coca Cola Company, CONGER was employed by the Milford Crane Company.

FAULKNER stated that with regard to CHARLES CONGER, he knows that CONGER has a girlfriend known only as "SANDY" who also lives in Woodmont, Connecticut, address unknown. He advised that CONGER has held Klan meetings in the home of this girl SANDY in the past.

FAULKNER advised that from his experience and contact with MILLER and several other members of the Klan in Connecticut, he is of the belief and understanding that the majority of the Klansmen are uneducated, and most have felony records. He stated that present at the meeting at which he was sworn in were rank and file members from Litchfield County, New London, Milford, and New Haven, Connecticut.

He advised that meetings of the Klan are usually held every two weeks at the home of ROBERT WALKER on a Sunday night and usually at 7:00 p.m. He stated, however, that this is presently being changed and that meetings will henceforth be held at different members homes, place to be announced very shortly before the meetings are held.

FAULKNER advised that there are no Klaverns of the Klan in Connecticut, however, he stated that WILLIAM MILLER has enough members in the Milford, Connecticut, area to have a Klavern. He said that in order for a Klavern to be established, 25 members must be recruited.

He advised that in sense of rank in the State of Connecticut, ROBERT WALKER is the head as Imperial Representative. JOHN BELLMORE ranks second as the Imperial Kleagle and WILLIAM MILLER ranks third as the Imperial Kludd.

FAULKNER advised that WALKER as leader of the Klan in Connecticut is opposed to violence and demonstrations. He stated that WALKER's aim is simply to recruit large numbers to the Klan in order that the Klan could have a voice. He stated that WALKER's aim is to cooperate with the police and that he is opposed to anti-Negro and anti-Jewish activities. He advised that WALKER is opposed to activities such as that which the Minutemen engage in. He advised that he has been told on several occasions that previous attempts were made by the Minutemen and the Klan to get together but that WALKER wants nothing to do with the Minutemen.

He also advised that WALKER has urged everyone in the Klan to get a handgun or a weapon but that such must be obtained legally. He said that he does not want any member of the Klan to have a gun who does not have a permit to carry it. He advised it is his understanding that WALKER has applied for such a permit but that he has not yet received it.



FAULKNER advised it was his understanding that on the weekend of May 18-19, 1968, a large meeting of the Klan was to be held at Tuscaloosa, Alabama. He stated that WALKER was supposed to attend this meeting but that he was not going to be able to attend due to prior commitments. He advised that he knows that WILLIAM MILLER has been asked by WALKER to attend in his place but he doubts very much if MILLER will be able to make it. FAULKNER stated that this meeting to take place at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, is to be made up of State representatives and State officials of the UKA from throughout the United States. He advised that he does not know the exact date, time or place in Tuscaloosa, where this is to be held other than the fact that it is to be on the weekend of May 18-19, 1968.

FAULKNER advised that he desired to break off relationships with WILLIAM MILLER inasmuch as he was of the impression that MILLER was soon to be in trouble as a result of a robbery. He stated that he had no hand in any robbery performed by MILLER or any of MILLER's friends, but that on the night of May 12, 1968, he learned as a result of being at MILLER's residence, that one ROBERT WILLIAMS and ROBERT GURLEY, both youths, to his knowledge not affiliated with the Klan, came to MILLER's house and with them had a tin box containing \$51.00 and some stamps. He stated it was his understanding that this box of money was stolen from the Milford Crane Company, on Sunday night, May 12, 1968, and that MILLER, WILLIAMS and GURLEY were responsible for this theft. He also advised it was his understanding that this group of individuals including MILLER's wife and two children, were going to leave the State of Connecticut in the near future and were going to travel out West, exact plans unknown. He stated, however, MILLER had told him he had plans to go out West and obtain guns and return them to Connecticut and sell them to Minutemen. He said that MILLER told him he could easily obtain these guns from robbing armories. However, MILLER did not elaborate or go into specifics.

During the course of interview with FAULKNER, it was noted that he bore a marked physical resemblance to the subject of MURKIN case, namely JAMES EARL RAY. FAULKNER definitely has a left ear which protrudes the same as RAY's left ear. He also has a scar on his forehead and also a scar on his hand as described in the description of RAY. He has also used the alias of EARL in the past.

In order to eliminate the possibility of FAULKNER being identical with RAY, a telephone call was directed to the Identification Division of the FBI in order that the known classification of RAY's prints could be compared with the prints of FAULKNER on file at the Bureau. This matter was handled by Night Supervisor CRAIGHTON of the Identification Division and he advised that the fingerprints were not identical.

Information relative to the robbery which took place at the Milford Crane Company, was furnished to Chief of Police ROBERT DIXON, on May 14, 1968. DIXON advised that such a robbery did take place and that \$51.00 was actually stolen. DIXON was furnished with the identity of the individuals who reportedly perpetrated this theft.

Information pertaining to the Klan meeting which FAULKNER stated is to be held over the weekend of May 18-19, 1968, was furnished to Birmingham by teletype dated May 14, 1968, in the New Haven file 100-7386.

It is recommended that new cases be opened on WILLIAM MILLER, SKIP BARDELL and also captioned case.

## 2 State Girls Claim They Saw James Earl Ray

HARTFORD, (AP) — The Federal Bureau of Investigation is looking into the claim of two girls that they saw a man in San Juan International Airport who they believe to be the man accused of killing Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., an FBI spokesman said Thursday.

The story of the girls' encounter with the man whose face and actions closely resembled that of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, was reported in Thursday's edition of the Hartford Times as told by the girls to a Spanish columnist for the paper.

The two, Lucy Eneida Gomez, 19, and Carmen Ana Maldonado, 16, informed the FBI on arrival here Tuesday of their experience while buying tickets at the San Juan airport Thursday.

A man shoved into the line ahead of them at the Pan American Airways, they said. He had a nervous habit of pulling his right earlobe and constantly bit his lower lip and was bug-eyed when talking with the ticket agent.

The girls said the man asked for a ticket to Jamaica or "anywhere in South America," Lucy said. When informed of a vacancy on a flight to Miami, she related, "he said, 'No, I don't want to go to the States.'"

Lucy said she and her friend noticed the similarity between the man's appearance and photographs of Ray that had been published in Puerto Rican newspapers.

The FBI spokesman would say only that the report had been received and passed on to "the proper authorities," including those in Puerto Rico.

Referenced airtel instructed that New Haven should contact MRS. RUTH C. JONES and her son WILLIAM JONES, a student at the University of Conn., Storrs, Conn.

It was ascertained that WILLIAM N. JONES, whose home is at 557 Israel Hill Rd., Shelton, Conn. (according to records of Univ. of Conn.) was a Freshman and reside in Room 416, Eaton House, on campus.

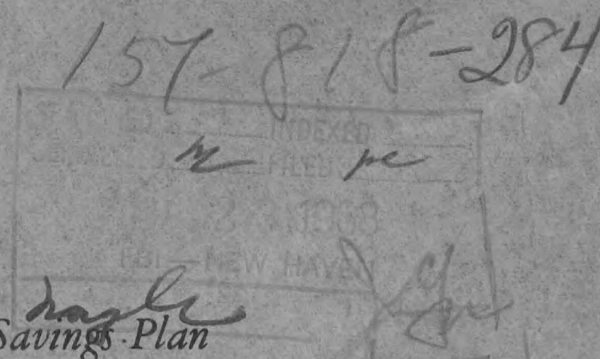
WILLIAM N. JONES was interviewed on May 17, 1968, at which time repeated information that his mother had previously furnished the Director by letter dated May 8, 1968. MRS. JONES, in her letter, had explained that her son was hitch-hiking in Florida during April 1968, and on April 10, he had received a ride from a man, who may have been "GALT, the man that shot MARTIN LUTHER KING."

WILLIAM JONES stated that while his school was closed for the Spring vacation, he went to Florida by hitch-hiking and after arriving in that state he spent some time ~~between~~ during early April 1968 in Lake Alfred, where he visited an aunt, Fort Lauderdale, and in Miami. He decided to visit the Keys, and on April 10, while he hitch-hiking there, he was picked up in Marathon, Fla., by a white male, who was driving an "old and beaten up" foreign automobile - make not known. Its color was "greenish and the paint was fading." JONES advised that during the ride, the driver, who did not reveal his identity, informed JONES that he had been released from a jail that day. The man did not name the jail, but JONES felt that it was located in the Miami, Fla., area. JONES added that the man did not reveal why or for what period of time he was incarcerated. He stated that the man said that he was driving to Key West, Fla., to look for work.

JONES advised that he did not care to remain very long in the

company of the driver and left the car at the first/traffic light in Key West. He advised that he had no definite reason to believe that the driver was JAMES EARL RAY, and it was ~~his~~ MRS. JONES' idea to notify the FBI.

WILLIAM JONES advised that he has seen photographs of RAY, or ERIC GALT, as he first read about him, and he did not believe that there was anything specifically about the man who ~~picked~~ gave him a ride that would make him think that he was RAY. JONES described the driver as being about in his 30's, 5' 10", 185 lbs., with a medium to heavy build. He had brown hair which was slightly curly, and his complexion was light to medium. He had no particular accent. JONES stated that the man "looked broke and bummish." He wore a white T shirt, dark brown pants, and had no luggage.
