SAC GAMBLE, Birmingham, at 8:00 a.m., 4/12/68, advised that concerning the letter sent to the bank in Birmingham in reference to the safety deposit box, that there was no envelope but merely a notation on the bank records that the letter had come from Baton Rouge, La.

He stated based on information currently available to the Birmingham Office, GALT was in the rooming house until approximately 10/5/67; that in November, 1967, he was reportedly in Los Angeles; that Birmingham has nothing concerning his whereabouts until he appears again 3/39/68 in Birmingham, if he is identical to the suspect purchasing the gun. He stated based on telephonic information he had received, there was over 19,100 miles put on the Mustang since it was purchased; that it indicated two trips to Mexico based on information developed in search of car.

According to a Los Angeles teletype, GALT, based on description, had lived in a rooming house four blocks from a laundry where the possible evidence in reference to laundry mark was located, and four blocks from a hardware store where the needlepoint pliers purchase was located.

SAC GAMBLE advised that all airline records were being checked out of Atlanta for any possible flights to Mexico or elsewhere since the car was abandoned on 4/5/68 approximately 15 minutes away from the airport/in Atlanta.

He advised that JEROME WALLACE VERNON was on probation as a forger.

Inspector SULLIVAN advised 4/12/68 that Atlanta had determined an address in Los Angeles that GALT had been living in a rooming house, and moved to the St. Francis Hotel in February, 1968, in Los Angeles, and paid \$85 a month for a room. He left 3/17/68 with forwarding address General Delivery, Atlanta, until 4/25/68. A check in Atlanta reflected two pieces of mail: a bill for GALT's utilities at the apartment he had in Los Angeles, and a Locksmith Ledger magazine from New Jersey.

Information was further developed by Atlanta that GALT had purchased a Firestone tire and tube in Mexico.

Relief Supv. RICHARD BLOESER, Los Angeles, at 5:11 p.m., 4/12/88, was furnished information developed concerning LOUELLA LUTZ by the New Orleans Office. This was confirmed by teletype.

SAC GAMBLE at 5:40 p.m., 4/12/68, advised that a check of postal receipts in Atlanta showed that GALT had purchased \$370 worth of photographic equipment from a mail order house in Chicago. The items had been sent to Birmingham; one had been returned and GALT had given an address in Mexico where the refund could be sent, on 11/30/67.

In talking to SA BLOESER, he advised that the owner of the laundry in Los Angeles knew GALT; there had been a mix-up in GALT's laundry. The laundry tag was issued to a GUY PRINCE, that the shorts and T-shirt had been sent to PRINCE, and actually belonged to GALT. SA BLOESER stated this information had just been obtained and there was some question about it.

It is recommended that he be dropped as a suspect in any future bombings, this being based on the fact that no evidence has been obtained indicating he has a participant in any bombings since this file was opened. Further, he was cooperative with the FBI and was instrumental in the solving of the bombing of the First Uniterian Church in New Orleans, Louisians, and is understood to have acted as a witness in that case for the state which cooperation resulted or assisted in the obtaining of a conviction in that case.

Further, DONALD S. HARPER, Dean of Men, Southeastern Louisiana College, Hammond, Louisiana, who has talked with CROSS on a number of occasions, has advised that CROSS truly seems repentant of his past activities and is making a great effort to be a good student. He said CROSS has a good attendance record and is not a trouble-maker on or off the campus.

For these reasons, as stated above, it is recommended this case be alosed and not reopened until and unless information is received in the future that he was a participant in some bombing inside.
