Communication from Atlanta advised vehicle owned by DORTA JOHNNY GALLIMORE, Perry, Georgia. Vehicle at time of theft registered approximately 1,400 miles and at time of recovery indicated 6,777 miles.

Mr. CLAIBORNE WEBB, Parking Attendant, Liberty Parking Service, 231 S. Villere St., described the driver of instant 1968 Oldsmobile as being a lone w/m, in his late 30's, 6', slender build, gray hair, style not recalled, wearing a brown shirt and dark trousers and not wearing glasses or a hat.

The following day, on 5/3/68, Mr. WEBB was exhibited a group of photos of which contained photos of JAMES EARL RAY, which he positively eliminated as the driver of instant 1968 Oldsmobile.

The vehicle was thoroughly checked for evidence for fingerprints of which some were located and obtained. Investigation re the theft of this vehicle continuing.

He advised his father, HENRY STARNs, Baton Rouge, La., had just informed him telephonically that the FBI in Baton Rouge had on the morning of 5/7/68, contacted HENRY STARNs regarding the present whereabouts of RAYMOND HENRY STARNs. STARNs stated the purpose of his call is to find out why the FBI is interested in him and to let the FBI know his present whereabouts in the event the FBI is looking for him. He said he does not know why the FBI might be interested in talking with him.

STARNs furnished his residence address as Apartment F, King David Apartments, 2816 David Drive, Metairie, La., Tel. # 888-9092. He said his business address is Suite 120, Courtland Plaza, 3900 Veterans Highway, Jefferson Parish, La., Tel. # 888-7640. STARNs stated he also has a telephone in his automobile, Number 367-2741 Unit 459.

## Predication

In the investigation of captioned matter New Orleans has been attempting to identify an alleged fence by the name of COIN (ph), with negative results.

Investigation has determined that JAMES EARL RAY and CHARLES STEIN left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67 and arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67. STEIN has indicated that en route, somewhere in Texas, RAY made one or two long distance telephone calls from coin phones and also indicated he was going to contact either architectural or contracting firm.

Check of City Directories revealed there is a Coyne Construction and Engineering Company, 201 Richard, Gretna, La., telephone 367-4624.

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. The date listed under each name is the date the individual or individuals stayed at the motel. Each Office should locate and interview these individuals for any knowledge or contact they may have had with the subject. Various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which have been furnished to all Offices, should be displayed to these individuals to ascertain if they recall RAY.

In order to assist Memphis, the Office of Origin in this matter, each Office should set forth the results of this investigation in report form with copies of the reports designated for the Bureau and Memphis.
