

The background of this particular phase of this investigation is that CHARLES STEIN, of Los Angeles, Calif., has advised he was driven to New Orleans, La., from Los Angeles, Calif., by JAMES EARL RAY. They left Los Angeles on 12/15/67 and arrived New Orleans 12/17/67. They left New Orleans and returned to Los Angeles on 12/19/67.

STEIN advises that while en route to New Orleans and while in the State of Texas, RAY made one or two long distance telephone calls from a pay telephone.

As a result, the Bureau has instructed El Paso, Houston and San Antonio to obtain the long distance telephone calls placed from each public telephone on the route that STEIN and RAY traveled in their Divisions.

As a result, the Houston Division has provided a list of approximately 300 telephone calls made for the period 12/15-17/67 from coin telephones located on Interstate Highway 10 and Route 90 within the Houston Division to Louisiana:

There is attached for each Resident Agent a list of calls from these coin telephones to the area covered by the Agent. The following investigation should be conducted:

She advised that HARRY MILLER appeared to fit the description of subject RAY except that he did not have a crew cut. She advised that the two men were driving a blue paneled truck, bearing Texas license, number unknown.

Chief Deputy CASTON GROS, Assumption Parish SO, Napoleonville, La., was contacted and advised that subject RAY's photo was displayed to LABARRE. Chief GROS advised that LABARRE, a very suspicious individual, who is frequently contacting the SO with complaints, told him that MILLER did not resemble either of subject RAY's pictures very much.

On 5/10/68, Chief GROS stated that MILLER and JONES were employed for Associated Pipeline, working throughout various areas of Southern La., and that he had been unable to contact them for a complete description. MILLER, aka, "EAST DALLAS" and CHARLES JONES both of 203 Beaumont St., Jacksonville, Tex., terminated their employment with Associated Pipeline on 5/8/68.

In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U.S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to


