New Orleans, General Investigative Intelligence Report dated 11/22/55 contained the following information under the heading of "Lake Charles, Louisiana Area (E) Gambling":

The Calcasieu Parish Sheriff's Office, according to the Lake Charles American Press of June 17, 1955, arrested EUGENE FONTENOT, manager of The Sierra Club, Lake Charles, and LUCAS PAPANIA, a well known local pimp and gambler, and an airman assigned to the Lake Charles Air Force Base on gambling charges at the Sierra Club. The American Press of June 16, 1955, reported that the Calcasieu Parish Sheriff's Office arrested one LEE PRUITT of Vinton, Louisiana, in a gambling raid at the Little Grove Nite Club on Highway 90 near the Texas line, at which time a dice game was found in progress.

File 137-1211 subject: RAYFORD J. VEILLON PCI

On 3/24/59, PCI, advised SA JAMES W. HAMILTON that he had known of the 2505 Club which had operated in Kake Charles at 2520 Ryan St., in about Januray and February, 1959 and understood that LUCAS PAPANIA of Lake Charles owned and operated the club. (cc filed in 31-6569).

New Orleans report made by SA GUY B. LEONARD dated 6/4/59 at New Orleans contained the following:

Investigation at Salina, Kansas and Oklahoma City, Okla. negative. Investigation reflects DOUG SIMMONS operated 2505 Club, Lake Charles, La. with one LUCAS PAPANIA of Lake Charles during early 1959, Former employer of club interviewed and advises several girls were employed at the club who were engaged in prostitution activities on premises.

On 3/4/59, MIKE L. HOGAN (NA) Chief of Detectives. Lake Charles, Louisiana was interviewed, and advised he was acquainted with DOUG SIMMONS' supposedly from Lafayette, Louisiana, who was first known to have come into Lake Charles in about January, 1959, and was thereafter associated for several weeks with one LUCAS PAPANIA in the operation of the 2505 Club at 2505 Ryan Street. PAPANIA is known to HOGAN as a local pimp. His family owns considerable real estate, including the property at 2505 The two-story building at this address was Ryan Street. formerly occupied by the Calcasieu Parish Welfare Department. When it was opened by PAPANIA as a club, the downstairs portion consisted of a bar and several small rooms and the upstairs portion purportedly consisted of a number of individual rooms where HOGAN later was informed prostitution dates were had by girls brought to the club by SIMMONS.

The local Sheriff's Office was also interested in the operations of the club and when the girls were ordered to report to the Sheriff's Office for fingerprinting, SIMMONS and the girls suddenly left town.

HOGAN advised no arrests were made by his department, or by the Sheriff's Office to his knowledge, as definate evidence of prostitution had not been obtained by either.

After SIMMONS and the girls brought in by him left, the club continued to operate as a bar only for a short time and is now out of operation. HOGAN said the names of the girls accompaning SIMMONS were not known to him. The only local girl employed in the club was one KATHY, last name not known, who worked as bartender and who was believed still in Lake Charles.

HOGAN advised he was not aware of any other men possibily associated with PAPANIA and SIMMONS in the operation of this club.

Memo from SA ROGER E. MAXWELL dated 9/29/66 indicated that captioned subject has received gambling paraphernalia from HASKELL F. JONES as a result of Greyhound Bus shipments. JONES is the owner of Jones Brothers Parlor Supplies, 1204 Jefferson Highway, New Orleans, Louisiana, which was searched on 9/15/55, as a result of a search warrant issued by the U. S. Commissioner, New Orleans.

On 10/31/66, Mrs. ANNA FONTENOT, Supv., Take Charles Credit Bureau, advised her office file on LUCAS PAUL PAPANIA was opened on 2/25/48, and lastbrought up to date in August, 1964. The file showed he is married to ROSALEE, lives at 1103 Live Oak St., Take Charles, and from 1948 to 1960, operated Papania's grocery and bar. He had three collection accounts from 1960 to 1962, has had three accounts paid as agreed, two paid out unsatisfactorily and one on which he was paying slow. The only current account listed was at Enterprise Pharmacy, Lake Charles, in 6/66, for \$33.42. She stated PAPANIA was managing the Reno Club, on Highway 90, Edgerly, La.

Records of the Calcasieu Parish SO, checked on 10/31/66 showed, under SO#80305, that LUCAS P. PAPANIA was arrested on 3/17/46 for Investigation and was released, no charge. He was again arrested on 6/17/55 for Gambling, released on bond, no disposition listed. The last arrest was on 5/2/64, for gambling, pleaded guilty, paid fine of \$150.00 plus costs.

Records of the Lake Charles PD, checked on 10/31/66 showed LUCAS PAUL PAPANIA KNAWA had the following arrests: 1/14/62-Disturbing Peace by Fighting; 2/9/62, Ran red light; 2/9/62-Fighting; 2/18/62-No Driver's License in possession; 3/8/62-Fighting; 10/14/64-DWI. He paid the fines in all the arrests.

Attempts to contact PAPANIA at 1103 Live Oak St., at Southway Furniture Co., Ryan St., and in downtown Lake Charles were made on 11/1,8 and 21/66, with negative results.

On 11/1/66, Acting Chief Deputy, ALBERT MANUEL, Calcasieu Parish SO, advised PAPANIA was involved in gambling in Lake Charles in the 1940's, but ceased such activities when the Parish closed down on gambling in 1951 and 1952. He stated PAPANIA has done a

little gambling in recent years at varoius Bars or at his home, but it

has been just small poker or bourse games or some crap shooting. He stated his Office has determined that PAPANIA is not involved in any large scale gambling, that he definately is not involved in any interstate gambling, and is now just managing his mother's estate.

When interviewed on 11/23/66, PAPANIA advised he purchased a poker dice set about ten years ago, another similar set about 7 years ago, and six pairs of dice, about 3½-4 months ago, from Jones Brothers in New Orleans. He stated he bought these items for other people. He stated he never ordered any crooked dice or other gambling paraphernalifrom Jones Brothers or anyone else, and stated he has never been involved in any interstate gambling activities.

In view of the above, it is suggested the attached rough draft 302 of PAPANIA be filed without typing up as a finished produce, and that this case be placed in a closed status.

LUCAS PAUL PAPANIA was contacted at his residence, 1103 Live Oak Street, Lake Charles, Louisiana. He was advised of the official identity of his interviewer as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureaucof Investigation. He was told that information was desired concerning his being a customer of Jones Brothers Parlor Supplies, New Orleans, Louisiana, and possible interstate gambling activities.

He was advised of his rights. He then read and signed a rights-waiver form. He stated he had not broken any gambling laws, that he did not desire to furnish a signed statement, but he would freely and truthfully furnish any information desired.

He advised the following:

About six or seven years ago, JACK DILLON, now deceased, was selling opperabricated houses in Lake Charles. DILLON was a member of the Petro=Chem Club in Lake Charles, and he said he wanted to get a set of poker dice, and a leather cup for the dice, to use in the Petro-Chem Club at the Bar. He stated he knew that Jones Brothers of New Orleans sold the dice and cups, so he ordered a set for DILLON. The dice and cup came by Greyhound Bus and cost a total of about \$9.75. He gave them to DILLON and was rreimbursed by DILLON.

About ten years ago, he also bought a similar poker dice set for a JOHN MARIC (Phonetic), who lived in Lake Charles, at the time and was going to open a Bar someplace. As he recalls, he might possibly have picked up this set at Jones Brothers when he was in New Orleans.

The only other business he had with Jones Brothes was about three and one-half to four months ago. At this time, a man be knew as RED PETERSON was in Lake Charles.

working as a welder-pipefitter for some construction company at one of the Lake Charles Oil Refineries. PETERSON was rooming someplace in downtown Lake Charles, and he met him at local bars. PETERSON said he wanted to buy some good dice so that he could use them in dice games in the various towns he went to do welding work. He suggested Jones Brothers, and ordered six pair of dice in his name. They came in by Greyhound, total cost was \$21.50, and PETERSON paid for them when they picked them up at the Greyhond Terminal in Lake Charles.

PAPANIA stated he never ordered any crooked dice or other kind of gambling paraphernalia from Jones Brothers or anyone else, and he has never been involved in any kand of interstate gambling activities.

Los Angeles teletype to the Bureau 5/14/68 set forth results of a re-interview with MARIE MARTIN in which MARTIN advised that after JAMES EARL RAY made his first trip to New Orleans to obtain the children of RITA STEIN, RAY said he had visited friends in the Industrial Canal area of the Chef Menteur Highway in New Orleans. No further identification was made of these friends by RAY

You will recall RAY has been definitely established to have resided at the Provincial Motel in New Orleans during the period 12/17-19/67, this being his first known trip to New Orleans and was the trip on which he picked up the children of RITA STEIN.

You will further recall that RAY has also been placed in New Orleans on the approximate date of 3/21/68 and his next known whereabouts was in Atlanta on 3/24/68.

The Industrial Canal stretches from Lake Pontchartrain to the Mississippi River, a distance of several miles, and the point at which the Industrial Canal crosses Chef Menteur Highway is a highly industrialized area and is not conducive to a neighborhood check in an effort to ascertain the identity of RAY's friends.

It is felt that any friends that RAY might have contacted in New Orleans would probably be ex-convicts and individuals with whom he has served time. It is conceivable that these individuals are presently on probation or parole.

John Eugene Garron was interviewed by St. Louis Office and advised be tanght Day to be a burglar. He stated that on or about 6/23-24/67, he read in the Chicago "Tribune" of a \$50,000 bank burglary in a southern state and recalled that he and Ray cased the same bank in 1953 or 1959, but did not rob the bank at that time because he injured his leg. A few days after reading this article Gawron claims he was visited by a man whom he refuses to identify and whom he believes he introduced to Ray in 1959. This man told Gawron he and others had robbed the bank, displayed a valise full of money and gave Gawron \$250. About six weeks ago this man again visited Gawron and allegedly indicated to him that Ray and one or more other persons had been involved with him in the bank robbery.

During this interview Gawron refused to Mentify the bank or the man who visited him. He did say that the bank was in the deep South in a State like Mississippi, but not in Mississippi, in a city that is not small and is near a river. The robbers were out of state in five minutes and the loot amounted to \$50,000, plus or minus two thousand.

Based upon available information, the Chicago "Tribune" and the Bureau's bank robbery files have been reviewed without finding any reference to a robbery such as Gawron described.

Gawron has now been reinterviewed and he denies having any contact with Ray since Ray's escape. Regarding the southern bank robbery Gawron previously alleged Ray was involved in, Gawron now states that this could have occurred in July, 1957, instead of June, and was in a city on the east bank of the Mississippi River.

Each office receiving this communication should make a review of their records to determine if such bank robbery or any other robbery coming within the jurisdiction of the Eureau occurred. You should make inquiry at appropriate police departments to determine if a robbery of this magnitude exists in their files.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Rerep sets forth check of various agencies previously conducted with negative results. Upon determination by Bureau on 4/19/68, that subject of this case is JAMES EARL RAY, these agencies were appropriately rechecked, that is, airlines, banks, birth, city and telephone directories, credit, arrest, car rentals, drivers license, dancing schools, hotels, INS, laundries, motels, public utilities, MVB, Selective Service, public transportation other than airlines, labor unions, and criminal and racial informants.

In addition, the authors of want ads appearing in the metropolitan Atlanta newspaper reused cars for sale during the period 3/24-4/5/68, were contacted, all lookalike complaints resolved through interview, appropriate agency checks and neighborhood investigation where warranted.

The foregoing efforts proved negative and results are not being set forth in this report. Results of each inquiry appear in Atlanta file in appropriate form.

Copies of this report for the United States Attorneys at Birmingham and Memphis are included with copies for those offices, but not marked as such. Dissemination to be held in abeyance pending Bureau instructions.

With reference to interviews of RAYMOND LOUIS CURCIS, this individual stated he would not testify to the information he furnished because he feared for his life. It is noted that CURTIS furnished the same information to the national news media.
