In all probabliity, since RAY spent approximately seven years at the Missouri State Penitentiary prior to his escape, if he met any ex-cons from the New Orleans area, this would probably have been done during his incarceration at Missouri State Penitentiary.

Office of Origin should consider contacting prison officials for identities of ex-cons who might reside in the New Orleans area and who were released subsequent to RAY's escape April, 1967.


