Buffalo Office today advised Bureau that a reporter for "Toronto Star," Toronto, Canada, is going to break a story JAMES EARL RAY in with the Minutemen organization. RAY according to reporter had resided within a block of a known member of the Minutemen organization in Montreal, Canada, during Expo 67. Minuteman allegedly was in contact with RAY. The reporter claims this Minuteman, whose identity the reporter will not disclose, is being interviewed by "Toronto Star" in an undisclosed city in Nnited States.
