

RACIAL MATTERS

At 7:45 p.m., 4/4/68, USA SIDNEY I. LEZAK called me from his home (telephone 246-2798). He informed that a Departmental representative had just called him re the fact that retaliatory measures could be taken by the negro community anywhere in the United States and LEZAK should keep the Department apprised of any action occurring in Portland. I told LEZAK that we had already initiated action so as hopefully to be informed of any potential for violence that might occur in Portland, that the PPD had initiated similar action and further that we were in close liaison and working closely with the PD officers responsible for handling the matter. He was informed that we would call him if any trouble occurred and he was appreciative.

For record purposes at 6:10 p.m., 4/4/68, SA FRANK received a call from Night Supervisor HANNES K. WATZLAWEK, SF, who advised as follows:

Inspector JOE SIZOO, Division 5, had called San Francisco from Washington instructing that San Francisco alert all West Coast Offices to the fact that at that time the Bureau was completely swamped with telephone calls, inquiries, etc., and that for that reason the teletype circuits were tied up. West Coast Offices, including Portland, were to be informed that immediate contact should be had, as the result of the assassination of KING, with all sources who might possibly be in a position to give any advance information as to whether any retaliatory measures might be taken by the negro community against whites as a result of the assassination.

At 9:00 p.m., 4/4/68, WATZLAWEK called again, talked to SAC and advised that SIZOO wanted these instructions relayed:

The Bureau was beginning to receive information indicating that in the Detroit, NYC and Miami areas negroes were commencing to pull whites out of cars and some violence was occurring.

The Director was concerned of the safety of FBI employees and had instructed that each SAC, using good judgment, assure that employees coming to work would get their and back home safely.

Further, that Bureau instructions required that there be agent manpower on duty at all times and ready to move if facial trouble occurred in any particular locale. Keep Bureau informed of pertinent racial developments in area.

After the call was received at 6:10 p.m. from Night Supervisor WATZLAWEK (subsequently confirmed by the 10:19 p.m. teletype from the Bureau), SA PETER J. MEANEY, Eugene, was alerted at 7:45 p.m. and instructed to handle contacts with appropriate individuals in the Eugene area. At 8:30 p.m. SA VERN DAVIS at Salem was also contacted. He was requested to contact his sources, as well as COP BEN MEYERS and Supt. HOLLY HOLCOMB, OSP.

ADDENDUM:

Action immediately taken after the 6:10 p.m. instructions were received was that SAs FRANK, BROWN, APP HANLON, plus SAC, reported to office -- contact had already been established by SA FRANK with PD. I contacted Multnomah County Sheriff HOLZMAN and SA FRANK contacted JOHN BROWN, Intelligence Officer of the County, alerting them, and we were assured that information coming to their possession would be immediately referred to us.

The various sources alerted will be made a matter of separate communication. Further, the surveillance conducted at the "Spirit House" likewise will be made a matter of separate communication.

She has heard on news that the assassin had "a silly grin" and has "a strange feeling" that he may be the brother of her brother! wife - described as follows:

Height 5'8"
Hair Lt.Brown
Complexion Reddish

Complainant last saw him about 1951 just after he came back from the Korean war where he was a hero for shooting a bunch of the enemy single handed. He has been fond of guns all his life and is a little simple minded; "just never got over being a kid".

JOHN (Jimmy) KELLY is last known to reside with his parents in a small town about 50 miles from Memphis named Forest City, Tenn. and he visits his sister and her husband (complainant's brother and wife) who live in Memphis.

MRS. JOHN COCKRELL, ELEVEN TWELVE EAST TWENTEETH, EUGENE, OREGON,
TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THE PORTLAND OFFICE, THAT AFTER READING ABOUT
INSTANT ASSASSINATION IN NEWSPAPERS, SHE WAS REMEMBED OF A JOHN WILLIARD
THAT SHE KNEW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI DURING THE LATE THIRTIES.
HE WENT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI TO EITHER THE UNIVERSITY OF
ARIZONA OR ARIZONA STATE TO SET UP A STUDENT BIBLE CLASS. HE WAS
CONVICTED OF EMBEZZLING FUNDS, AND WAS SENT TO THE ARIZONA STATE
PENITENTIARY. SHE LAST SAW HIM ABOUT ## TWENTY THREE YEARS AGO
IN SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA, AND HAS HEARD SINCE THAT HE IS STILL
ALIVE AND SPENDING MOST OF HIS TIME IN FLOP HOUSES. SHE DESCRIBES
HIM AS WHITE, MALE, NOW FOURTY EIGHT OR FIFTY YEARS OF AGE, FIVE
FEET ELEVEN INCHES, SLENDER BUILD, DARK HAIR, HAS A SILLY GRIN,
METICULOUS DRESSER, OF RELIGIOUS NATURE, AND PSYCHOTIC.

MRS. COCKRELL HAS NO IDEA WHERE WILLIARD MAY BE LOCATED, BUT STATES SHE DEFINITELY FEELS HE IS CAPABLE OF INSTANT CRIME.

WELCH, Telephone # 645-2880, address unknown however is on Skyline Blvd, Portland, Oregon telephonically advised writer that she had been watching Channel 7 and a program entitled PBL regarding the life of MARTIN LUTHER KING and about mid-way through the program she had seen a fellow sitting around a table in the program somewhere where KING was that looked exactly like the composite drawing of the assassin that appeared in the 4/7/68 issue of th Oregonian.

MRS WELCH stated that she and her husband had just recently moved to Fortland and that is why she did not know her exact address.

Bureau instructions require any leads this case be given immediate and the highest priority. No excuses will be accepted for any delay in handling any lead.

Although I cannot at this point advise you details, pertinent investigative periods we are interested in at this time are 3/29/68 and 3/30/68 at Birmingham, Alabama, and 4/4/68 at Memphis. If any suspects are developed, above dates are the ones we are interested in in possibly eliminating a suspect. If we cannot eliminate the suspect, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects and forward to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination. Descriptive data should be included with photograph. Composite description of subject this case is as follows:

SA ELVIN L. BARTON conducted the following investigation on 4/9 and 4/10/68:

THOMAS T. GEORGES. JR., manager, Oregon Laundry and Dry Cleaners, 232 SW Columbia Street, Portland, Oregon, advised that his firm uses the Thermo Seal marking machine to put on their cloth laundry tags. He stated that they used the red cloth laundry tag for specials that require only one day service for which they require an extra charge for a customer. He stated that the laundry mark such as O2B-6 or D2B-6 is not their laundry mark as they begin with a two-digit number starting at 10 and going up through 99, and would never use a letter prefix. He stated that JOHN POPP, 9305 SE Harney Court, Portland, Oregon, telephone 771-0725, is the manufacturer's representative that handles this marking machine for the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York. He stated that the distributor in the State of Oregon for this equipment is Van Waters and Rogers, 3950 NW Yeon Blvd, Portland, Oregon, telephone CA 2-1721, and the person to see there for the identity of other laundries using this equipment would be LARRY H. GIRVAN, manager of their Laundry and Dry Cleaning Department.

LARRY H. GIRVAN, Laundry and Dry Cleaning Department, Van Waters and Rogers, 3950 NW Yeon Blvd., Portland, advised that the manufacturer's representative JOHN POPP is almost impossible to find at his Portland address and telephone number as he handles several lines of laundry equipment, including the Thermo Seal marking machine and travels about five states including Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, as well as British Columbia.

Mr. GIRVAN stated that they distribute the Thermo Seal marking machine to various laundries, but that small laundries cannot afford the machine as it is very expensive and is only employed by the larger laundries throughout the State of Oregon. Mr. GIRVAN supplied the names which will appear hereafter of 13 laundries in the State of Oregon which are the only ones that handle this equipment. In addition, he stated they distribute to 3 laundries in the State of Washington which he identified as Griffees Heights Cleaners, and New Method Cleaners, both of Vancouver, Washington, and the Troy Laundry at Longview, Washington. He stated that for the rest of the laundries using this machine in the State of Washington, the Seattle Office of the FBI should contact RALPH OLSON, Manager of Van Waters and Rogers, Seattle, Washington.

SAC, W.B. SOYARS, JR. telephonically furnished the information concerning the State of Washington to SAC J. EARL MILNES, Seattle Office, on 4/9/68.

The following laundries were contacted by SA ELVIN L. BARTON telephonically on 4/9 and 4/10/68 and in each instance, the laundry marking involved was gone over with them carefully and in all instances, the persons contacted advised this is not their laundry mark. In all instances they stated that their Thermo Seal marking machine begins with either one numeral or two numerals rather than a letter such as D or O. None of them use 0 as a prefix.

On instant date, GERALDINE MARIE TANNER, a prostitute presently incarcerated at the Portland Jail, Portland, Oregon, upon request was interviewed by SA WILLIAM A. TENWICK, Portland Division. She made available a copy of a letter (one xerox copy enclosed for San Francisco and Memphis) which she received from PEARL R. MILLER, aka KATHY LAWTON, Room 52, London Lodge Motel, Broadway at 7th Street, Oakland, California. In the letter the fellowing quotation is contained: "I knew whites was going to kill that man," referring to KING.

TANNER states that she is well acquainted with MILLER and she insists that MILLER knows something about the individual who killed KING. She is unable to give any basis for this supposition other than she knows MILLER so well and this is so "unlike her" that she is confident MILLER has knowledge of the murder.

MILLER apparently left Phoenix, Arizona, 3/26/68 for Oakland, California. Under Portland PD File #44-261, she has a prior arrest for prostitution.
