



Gun Reported To Be One Used To Kill Dr. King

BIRMINGTON Alabama (P)—
The Birmingham, Alabama News said yesterday in a copyright story that a gun which the FBI said was purchased in Birmingham has been determined by ballistics tests to be the weapon used in the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King.

The story said also that the search for Eric Starvo Galt, who is charged with conspiracy ir King's death, has spread outside the United States.

Quoting an unidentified source, described only as an investigator, the News said it is believed that Galt has fled to Mexico or Cuba.

The FBI has said previously that Galt, on or about March 30, bought a rifle in Birmingham.

The statement also said that a .30-06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight, was found near the motel in Memphis, Temessee where King was slain.

Hunt Pressed For King Murder Figure

April 18 (AP) — The nationwide hunt continues today for Eric Starvo Galt, identified by the FBI as one of the men involved in the assassination of Martin Luther King.

—La Policía detuvo a un individuo bajo sospechas de que pudiera ser el présunto asesino del dirigente negro norteamericano Martin Luther King, Hijo, según anunciaron hoy las propias autoridos

Los agentes del orden arrestaron ayer por la tarde al sospechoso en un café de esta localidad, situada en el estado de Sonora, y lo sometieron a interrogatorio durante 12 horas en su habitación del Hotel San Carlos. Según informó el propietario de dicho Hotel, Carlos Valencia Beltrán, al cabo de el interrogatorio, el detenido fue llevado por la Policía en automóvil a Hermosillo, capital de Sonora.

Valencia Beltrán afirmó a la United Press International que él había avisado ayer a la Policía para que comprobaran la identidad de un norteamericano que se había alojado en su hotel en la noche del martes. Explicó que el individuo se parecía mucho a las fotografías que han circulado del supuesto asesino de King, James Earl Ray, quien está reclamado por la Oficina Federal de Investigaciones (FBI) de Estados Unidos.

El huésped dijo llamarse Daniel David Kennedy y tener 42 años. Aseguró que su domicilio está en Baltimore (Maryland) y que había venido a Méjico como turista con el propósito de dirigirse al Desierto de Altar, en Sonora. Añadió Kennedy que tiene una hija en Baltimore y que está divorciado, de acuerdo con Valencia Beltrán.

El teniente Roberto Fletcher, perteneciente al Departamento de Investigaciones de la Policía de Caborca, declaró por su parte que había observado al sospechoso antes de entablar conversación con el. Hecho esto, lo lleyó a la habitación que odipaba en el Hotel citado y all lo mantuvo en icalidad de detenido. El Hotel fue rodiado simultáneamente por varios agentes. No se hallaron armas en la habitación aludida.

WUERTH took a close look at this individual and is positive that his eyes were green, not blue as are RAY's. He is also positive the individual to whom he is referring did not have a protruding left ear.

The manager, and employees of the theater were exhibited photogra hs of KAY and stated they want had definitely not seen anyone answering RAY's description in the theathr. and that only two or three "Continentals" had entered the theater for the matinee, and that none looked anything like RAY.



James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

APR 29 1968 FBI — SAN JUAN An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

THE CRIMES: Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on April 23, 1967, while serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission. He subsequently allegedly conspired, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, to violate the civil rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel on April 4, 1968.

THE CRIMINAL: A 40-year-old white native of Illinois, who is known as a "loner" and "drifter" and has taken elaborate steps to establish a false identity, Ray has an extensive criminal record, including convictions for burglary, robbery and forging U.S. Postal Money Orders. Outstanding characteristics include a straight narrow nose, straight and even teeth, a noticeably protruding left ear and a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe. He has taken dancing lessons, attended bartending school, enrolled in a correspondence course in locksmithing and traveled widely in a 1966 Mustang recovered in Atlanta, Georgia, a week after Dr. King's murder. Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

PROCESS: A Federal warrant issued at Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charges Ray with unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement for robbery. Another Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, as Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen.






