On 4/8/68, Lt. MORRIS MEEK, Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, Clearwater, Florida, advised that the manager of the New Yorker Motel, Clearwater Beach, Florida, had notified the department that a guest of the motel, CHARLES E. MALEY, III, due to his strange actions was considered by her to be a suspect in the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

On 4/8/68, Mrs. TERESSA LEON, Manager, New Yorker Motel, 332 Hamden Drive, Clearwater, Florida, was interviewed by SAs JOHN J. RUTLAND and CHARLES D. VANCE.

Mrs. LEON said that she is the individual who contacted the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office after having seen a sketch of the KING assassin in the local paper who to her resembled a guest of the motel.

She said that an individual using the name CHARLES E. MALEY, III, 1125 Poplar Boulevard, Jackson, Mississippi, registered at the motel alone on 4/1/68, and paid through 4/9/68. MALEY gave occupation as "tourist", for license shoed Hinds County, Missippi H 46321, for a Chevrolet auto, model not specified.

Mrs. LEON said that MALEY left the motel on Thursday A.M., 4/4/68, at approximately 10:30 =11:00 A.M. and did not return until about 3:20 A.M., 4/6/68. Mrs. LEON said that she wondered about the strange hour of arrival and considered that he may have returned from an airline flight. He then departed on the morning of 4/7/68, with two days rental paid in advance. She said that MALEY apparently on occasions left his automobile elsewhere as he would arrive at the motel walking. She said that whereas she is confident that MALEY did not arrive at the motel until approximately 3:20 A.M., 4/6/68, he was insistant that he arrived at 1:00 A.M. but could not gain entrance though he rang the motel bell. She said that he repeated this on at least five occasions for no cause.

Mrs. LEON said that prior to MALEY's departure on 4/6/68, he appeared highly nervous and would pick up a paper, glance at it, then throw the paper down and walk away. She said that his overall actions at the motel were very strange.

She said that when he returned to the motel he commented that he had been in Daytona Beach, Florida, at the time of the KING assassination. He once commented that he had never had to attend school with Negroes but that his children would likely have to do so. He made no further comment concerning racial matters.

She described MALEY as white, male, age 26, 5'9", 175 lbs., light brown hair, medium complexion. She said that the sketch of the assassin resembles MALEY other than the sketch appears older and to not have as much hair as MALEY.

She said that she also noted that when MALEY left the motel on 4/4/68, that he left all identification behind in his room.

She said that she can furnish no further information but feels that from description and strange behavior MALEY could be identical with the KING assassin.

CULLINS noted that he, his father JEPRY CULLINS, and his brother-in-law Jack LE DOLk own and operate the Orlando-Seminole Dog Track at Urlando, Florida, and the Sarasota Kennel Club, Sarasota, Florida.

Mr. COLLINS stated that he has only a few employees at the track who work both the Orlando and Sarasota dog tracks, and he can only recall only three employees who have sons in their late teens or early 20's who are married. These men are:

- 1. JOE GIRARD, Dog Man, Orlando Dog Track
- 2. DICK RANKING, Assistant Mutual Manager, Orlando Dog Track





Justice Dept. received a telephone call this date from Mr. E.L.BING, Plant City, Florida, telephone number 752-6896, operator of a night club at Eatonville, Florida known as Rainbow Club. A patron at the club last Sunday night 4/7/68, wanted to cash a check on a Chattanooga, Tenn. bank and claimed he lived in Memphis and worked at the Holiday Inp. as a painter. Patron had a bus ticket from Orlando to Miami, BING saw sketch of killer in newspaper and thought it resemble the patron in the bar.

Bureau instructions were to interview BING.

TP file 157-2209 is on E. LUTRELL BING, a liaison source assigned to SA DOYLE. SA DOYLE was advised of above and processing to the state of the stat made contact with BING and sent teletype to Bureau.
