King Death Probe Centers on Auto

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — The presence of a second white Mustang near the doorway which police say the slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. used to escape gave rise today to published reports that it may have been the getaway car.

The Memphis Commercial Appeal said the car with Arkansas tags and a similar vehicle, parked a short distance north, both left the scene within 15 minutes after King was fatally shot a week ago today.

BOTH VEHICLES were within 100 feet of the doorway to the second-floor rooming house where police said the assassin waited and shot King as he stood on the balcony of a motel across a rear street.

The killer was believed to have walked out of the Main

Street entrance to the rooming house, turned south and dropped the murder weapon in front of a business firm next door.

Guy Canipe, owner of the firm, said he saw the young white man drop the package which contained the gun, but did not see his face.

THE COMMERCIAL Appeal speculated that the man then walked a few steps farther along, got into the dirty white Mustang with Arkansas tags and sped away.

The second Mustang, parked north of the rooming house entrance, also left the scene near the time of the shooting.

Police said they would investigate reports that a supposed police chase in north-east Memphis—eight miles from the scene—30 minutes after the shooting may have been a decoy to allow the killer to escape.

A RECORDING of the police radio dispatcher's transmissions showed seven calls in 12 minutes from a lieutenant's car in the northeast section of the city detailing the case.

The lieutenant said Tuesday he did not make the calls. This led to speculation that someone other than police may have sent the calls on the police frequency to draw officers away from the escape route.

The Mississippi state line is about 10 miles directly south of the shooting scene, and the bridge leading to Arkansas is about two miles southwest of King's motel.

FBI Cancels Alert To Florida Police

MIAMI (AP) — The FBI distributed a teletype pickup order to Florida police yesterday for Eric Starvo Galt, then withdrew the message four hours later because it had been released by mistake.

The message gave a description for Galt matching the description they circulated for the killer of Martin Luther King and said he was driving a white Mustang similar to that believed driven by King's assassin.

When asked by The Associated Press if they were releasing the identity of the suspect in the King murder, FBI Special Agent John Hanlon said, "I cannot comment."

Hanlon issued a bulletin on the police teletypes about 9:35 p.m. withdrawing the message.

The original message, signed by Special Agent Charles Bell, described Galt as a white man, born [redacted] about 5'11", 175 pounds, with blue eyes and brown hair.

The message was originally put on statewide police teletypes at 5:22 p.m. yesterday.

The message said Galt was driving a white Mustang with 1968 Alabama license tags, 1-38993.

Murder Rifle Traced

MEMPHIS — The rifle believed used to assassinate Dr. Martin Luther King was purchased in Birmingham, Ala., the Los Angeles Times learned yesterday.

The FBI refused to comment, but informants said FBI agents traced the rifle through its serial number to a store in Birmingham and that it was purchased new over the counter a few days before the slaying here last Thursday.

The weapon, which has been under going tests at the FBI laboratory in Washington is a Remington 30.06 pump rifle with a telescopic sight. It fires the same bullet as the Army's M-1 rifle.

Results of laboratory tests have not been disclosed. It could not be determined whether the telescopic sight also was obtained in the Birmingham store or whether the purchaser left any information about his identity.

AUTHORITIES also have traced binoculars left near the scene by the suspected slayer. The binoculars, The

Times learned, were purchased at York Arms Co., a sporting goods store located about six blocks from the run-down rooming house on South Main Street where the slayer set up his ambush.

The rifle and a rectangular blue leatherette case containing the binoculars were dropped on the sidewalk on South Main Street a few feet from the entry to the rooming house by a man who was seen leaving the rooming house a few minutes after the slaying.

The binoculars were purchased in Memphis on the afternoon of the slaying and the clerk who sold them has been interviewed several times by Memphis police and the FBI.

IF THE MAN who purchased the rifle in Birmingham and the man who bought the binoculars in Memphis is the same person who fled from the rooming house, then at least four persons have seen his face.

Besides the sales' clerks, the others are Mrs. Bessie Brewer, the landlady who rented an \$8.50-a-week room to the suspect and Charlie Hugh Stephens, one of her tenants.

'Quick Arrest' Hopes Fade in Memphis

MEMPHIS — Predictions by the Memphis police and by Attorney General Ramsey Clark of a quick arrest in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. have not materialized. King was shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis motel a week ago last night.

And despite what Clark called an "unusually large amount of physical evidence," the four men known to have been arrested for questioning about the slaying have been released.

Two of the men were law students who were in Memphis last week to help plan a civil rights demonstration. The third was a bald-headed man arrested over the weekend near the assassination site, and the fourth was a minister arrested Tuesday in Joplin, Mo.

Both the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Memphis Police Department have continued to refuse to comment on the status of the investigation.

But their activities in the last few days have indicated that a quick solution may not be at hand.

FBI agents in Mississippi and Alabama were known to have been checking the whereabouts on the night of the murder of known violent segregationists. Many members of the Ku Klux Klan were included. So far, the agents have been unable to turn up any useful leads, a source said.

FBI agents have been re-interviewing persons who

claim to have seen the man believed to be the assassin. An FBI sketch of the suspect may be made public soon.

A sketch made from descriptions furnished to police by clerks in a Memphis sporting

goods store and a Birmingham gun shop and by the landlady and a roomer at a Memphis rooming house was being shown to those who claim to have seen the long-nosed white man assumed to be the assassin.

The police yesterday refused further comment on any developments in the police broadcasts of a false chase of a white Mustang automobile which drew police attention away from downtown Memphis about 30 minutes after Dr.

Reference is made to the teletype I dictated on 4-8-68 to Bureau, Cleveland, Jacksonville and Atlanta with leads to check on a possible suspect, one THOMAS THOROMAN. This info was furnished on 4-8-68 by EDGAR HENRY HUBER, Carolina Moon Trailer Court, 498 N. OBT, Orlando, Fla. HUBER asked that his name be protected.

HUBER phoned to say he had additional information to furnish and upon interview on 4-10-68 he said he still felt that the drawing might be of THOROMAN. He further said that he was now of the thinking that THOROMAN had talked about moving to Lakeland, Fla., due to the fact that his wife has sinus and that living in Eustis, Fla., on a lake, THOROMAN seemed to think that the weather in Lakeland would be better for his wife's sinus.

HUBER said that he no longer associated THOROMAN with Tavares, Fla., but rather with Lakeland.

HUBER phoned on 4-11-68 to say that he had heard the report that the officer at Memphis, Tenn., denied giving out a report that the man thought to be the murderer was being pursued. HUBER continued by saying that it appeared that a false report had been given out and that this would have to be done by someone familiar with electronics. HUBER said that he recalled that THOROMAN had some knowledge of schematics and knew enough to be able to give out a false report.

HUBER on 4-8-68 furnished a postcard written by THOROMAN. This postcard is being submitted to the file and if it turns out that THOROMAN is in fact a good suspect the specimen can be forwarded to the Laboratory. HUBER has found a second handwriting specimen of THOROMAN.
