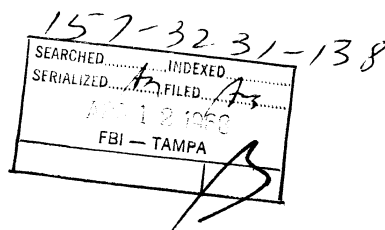

The following investigation was conducted by the writer to locate the above suspect:

On 4/8/68, former PCI DAVE WARD, Sanford-Orlando Kennel Club, Dog Track Superintendent furnished information which revealed the owner of the track, Jerry Collins had a son who was married to the daughter of a Virginia who was with the suspect at Palm Harbor, Fla. Ward suggested that the son of the Daytona Beach Dog Track former owner maybe married to a person named Virginia and that the son William Kirkpatrick had been paid to have been committed to a mental institution. Efforts were made and a copy of the artists conception of the murder was obtained and shown Ward but he said it bore no resemblance to William Kirkpatrick.

Dave Ward advised that G. A. "Sonny"

Alderson could be reached through the St. Petersburg, Fla. dog track and a lead was set out in that regard through Supervisor #4.

On 4/8/68 information was received from Supervisor #4 that suspect James Kidder had purchased an automobile in Clearwater, Fla. in February, 1968 at which time he listed NORRIS K. SHUSTER 117 EDBURG Winter Park, Fla. as his nearest relative.

On 4/8/68, NORRIS K. SHUSTER, ^{JR.} 117 EDINBURGH DRIVE Winter Park, Fla. advised he is not related to James Kidder but that his, Shuster's, younger brother JAMES SHUSTER, employed by the Sanford-Orlando Kennel Club is married to CHRISTINA aka "CHRIS"

Shuster, maiden name unknown, who is the daughter of VIRGINIA (LNU) who is either married or the common law wife of JAMES KIDDER. NORRIS Shuster said he knows little about Kidder and he acts strange as though he may be a wanted person. He said he had been in Memphis, Tenn. came to Fla. with Chris' mother Virginia, Chris & James Shuster but Chris & her mother had recently returned to Memphis and Kidder's actual whereabouts were unknown to him but James Shuster may know.

On 4/8/68, James Shuster advised he resides with his father NORRIS K. SHUSTER, SR. Seminole Blvd Carleberry, Fla. and works with his father at the Sanford-Orlando Dog Track. He said he is married to CHRISTINA MCDANIEL aka CHRIS the daughter of VIRGINIA MC DANIEL divorced from CHRISTINA'S father C.V. MC DANIEL, aka "BUNNY". He said VIRGINIA MCDANIEL is either married or the common law wife of JAMES KIDDER, but he does not actually know their marital status.

Shuster said that his wife Chris and her mother VIRGINIA had recently gone back to Memphis, Tenn. and he planned to join them

as soon as his job was finished upon closing of the dog track. He said his wife is staying with her father C. V. McDaniel at 632 NORTH DUNLAP Memphis, Tenn. He said she had no telephone but he could reach her through telephone number 526-7349 in Memphis at the residence of Daisy Brewer who would go around the corner and call Chris to the telephone.

James Shuster said he felt James Kidder was with VIRGINIA who was staying at DAISY BREWER'S residence but he could not recall the name of the street or the Brewer's house number.

James Shuster said he had talked to Chris ~~on~~ either Thurs. April 4, 1968 or Fri. April 5, 1968 on the telephone and although he was not certain he believed it was on April 5, 1968. He said that at that time Chris remarked that KIDDER was back and working but he had no other details as to where he was actually staying or working.

James Shuster said that he had not known James Kidder by any other

name or alias. He said he acts strange as though he is a wanted person because when he first met him in about April, 1967 he worked for a concession stand at the Sarasota Dog Track in Sarasota, Fla. and he tried to get him to seek a job with him directly with the dog track but he would not as this job required you to be photographed and fingerprinted. He said that one time while drinking Kidder indicated he was in some kind of ~~trouble~~ trouble but he said it would not cause anyone to be hurt but himself and did not furnish any other details.

James Shuster said that KIDDER always sat separately in a group and did not join into conversations but remained silent hour after hour. He said the only time he seemed to talk was when he was drinking and he was quite a heavy drinker. He said KIDDER had made remarks indicating he had been married in the past and had about a thirteen year old daughter. He indicated he was from the northern part of California but had not said which city or town. He made remarks

indicating he had been in military service, he believed the USAF and was in either Korea or Japan. Shuster said Virginia had remarked Kidder received a dishonorable discharge from the USAF due to being AWOL. Shuster said KIDDER made remarks indicating he had a plate in his head and a bad back. He said KIDDER is sensitive, moody, he pouts with little or no provocation and gets depressed easily. He said KIDDER constantly takes Anacin and aspirin.

Shuster said that he and Kidder had worked together at several dog track concession stands through out the country and when he married Chris in Memphis, Kidder took up with her mother Virginia. He said they all came to Florida from Memphis, Tenn. and that KIDDER and VIRGINIA last lived in DUNNEDIN, Fla. where he Shuster picked her up about three weeks ago and brought her back to Cassleberry, Florida in order to go with Chris back to Memphis. He said that prior to living in DUNNEDIN, Fla. KIDDER and Virginia did live at Palm Harbor, Fla. He said that KIDDER had bought about a 1956 or 1957

model Dodge with an electric push button shift which was mostly white with a light green stripe down the sides of the body and a white top. He did not know its registration data.

Shuster also said Kidder had mentioned being employed in South America for a long time helping to build a power plant but its location was unknown.

Shuster said he intended to call his wife at 9 AM on 4/9/68, and without divulging he had been contacted by the FBI he would ask her KIDDERS whereabouts and place of employment.

Shuster described Kidder as a white, male, about 32 or 33 years of age, probably born in California, apparently American, about 5' 9" about 145 lbs. to 150 lbs. medium build, on the thin side, ^{POSSIBLY} dark brown but most likely black hair, full nice head of hair, combed straight back on top and sides, not receding at temples, slight wave at top in front and duck tails on sides at rear of his head. He said he has a swarthy complexion but looks neat and clean except upon close inspection looks a little

greasy like a Mexican's complexion. He could not recall the color of his eyes. He could recall no unusual scars or marks. Peculiarities; looks away when faces people to talk to them and talks out of corner of his mouth. He has a favorite pair of black shoes, moccasin type with black rubber cleated soles which he constantly wears. He said that while in Memphis, Tenn. KIDDER frequented the OASIS BAR which is located across from the Greyhound Bus Station. Shuster said KIDDER maintains himself in a neat clean manner frequently wearing levis and sports shirt.

James Shuster said Virginia once remarked while in Florida that the FBI had been around in the past but gave no other details and he assumed she meant looking for KIDDER.

Shuster said that when drinking K idder tries to talk as though he is tough but he is not known to have any weapons and because physically he presents no threat to most persons he never took him seriously.

On April 9, 1968, James Shuster advised he had difficulty in reaching his wife by telephone as she was out. He did reach her on April 9, 1968 and said he did not indicate any contact or interest by the FBI. He said his wife told him KIDDER and Virginia moved out of Daisy Brewers place on the past Sunday and took a temporary residence for only one week at an unknown number on Peabody in Memphis, Tenn. She said Kidder was employed making paper cups way out on Lamar Ave. in Memphis. Shuster said he believed he recalled Dixie Cup Co. being in that area.

Shuster advised he would furnish any additional information but as of April 10-12, 1967 he had received none.
