On 4/26/68, John Key, Chief Engineer, Oak Park Cleaners 3410 E. Broadway, Tampa, Fla. advised that he makes all repairs on the Thermo-seal machines located at Oak Park Cleaners and also services many other Thermo-seal machines throughout the Tampa area. He advised that no changes, such as position of letters or numbers and different point size letters or numbers have been to the Thermo-seal machine at Oak Park Cleaners during the last year.

Key further advised that it is a simple matter to change the position of the numbers or letters or to change the point size of the letters and numbers. He stated that any Thermo-seal machine can be changed to use any sequence or combination of letters or numbers or any size of letters or numbers. He further advised that a six character machine could be made to produce a 5 character code, simply by removing a row of characters.

The FBI Laboratory advised that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "20R-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type.

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.

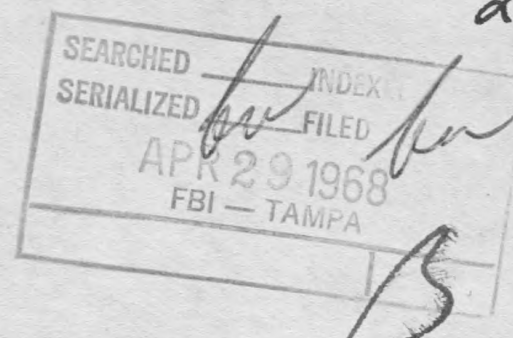
