One of his tenants, Mrs. Rose Fletcher, apt 8, an elderly woman 70 yrs old, called him tonight and said she had seen an individual three times Tuesday and once today that she believes is Eric Starvo Galt. He was visiting Mr George Mc Cammon, apt 2 same address, works for IRS, was referred to the apartment house by a local real estate agency, and took the apartment 4-1-68. Mrs. Fletcher did not notice Galt driving an automobile nor did she have any additional information. Connell thought he should bring this information to the FBI.

On 4-18-68, William Connell, Agr., Regency Apts., Melbourne Beach, Florida telephonically advised Tampa of the fact that a resident of the apartments thought she observed an individual identical to Eric Galt.

On 4-19-68, Connell was contacted and Mrs. Rose Fleeter, Apt. 8, interviewed for further information. She advised that she observed the unknown individual in the company of George McCammon, Apt. 2. McCammon was identified as being a salesman for IBM, Cocoa Beach, Florida. McCammon interviewed on 4-19-68 and identified individual in question as fellow worker, Don Smallman. McCammon positively identified Smallman as not being identical with Eric S. Galt, et al.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422½ South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as [REDACTED], his height as 5'11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

The Bureau has reiterated instructions that all leads in this case will be covered within 24 hours and all leads must be set forth by telephone or teletype. In addition, all border offices covering entry into Mexico or Canada and exit therefrom, are to insure that appropriate stops are maintained re subject and all names known to be used by him at respective offices of U. S. Immigration and Border Patrol.

The Bureau has also directed that sufficient quantities of wanted flyers and IO's to narcotic investigative agencies be made so that informants may be contacted. In addition, all criminal informants and appropriate racial and security informants should be contacted.

Copies of wanted flyer issued in the name of JAMES EARL RAY and his known aliases have been distributed to Agents. It is desired all Agents immediately contact all informants assigned to them to uncover any possible information leading to the whereabouts and apprehension of JAMES EARL RAY, aka.

RAY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.

The Unanswered Questions

"HE CAN run, but he can't hide."

This quote, attributed to former heavyweight boxing champion Joe Louis, may very well apply to Eric Starvo Galt or James Earl Ray—the two are said to be identical—sought in connection with the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King.

Starting from the slimmest of facts, the Federal Bureau of Investigation has compiled an impressive dossier on King's alleged assassin. In addition to raising hopes that he will soon be

apprehended, this provides a dramatic demonstration of the effectiveness of law enforcement agencies and may have the effect of discouraging similar crimes of violence.

Galt, whose real name is said to be Ray, has been described as a high school dropout with a lengthy criminal record. He is a prison escapee who has used numerous aliases and has been in trouble with the law since early youth.

His capture is extremely important as a means of understanding the depth of the conspiracy which led to the murder of Dr. King and the wave of rioting which swept the country following his death.

WAS RAY a paid killer, or did he conspire, as the FBI puts it, with "an individual said to be his

brother," out of sheer prejudice to slay the civil rights leader?

Everything points to the fact that the murder was carefully planned. Ray had to know King's whereabouts, something of his schedule and the best means of establishing his ambush. In addition, all signs suggest that his escape was equally well planned, perhaps with the assistance of others. There is even speculation at the moment that Ray may no longer be in the country.

Obviously, this was no spur of the moment murder. It had been thought through completely and was executed with professional finesse. Ray did leave behind a highly visible trail. But this, too, could have been a decoy, pinning the guilt on one Eric Starvo Galt who, in fact, did not exist.

Ray was identified, according to the FBI, following a "systematic and exhaustive" search through its fingerprint files. And when Ray and Galt were determined to be one, certain of Galt's prior activities had to be rejected because Ray was in prison at the time they had been pinpointed.

The discrepancy was attributed to "investigative error."

THERE IS a temptation to draw a parallel in the murder of Dr. King and the assassination of President Kennedy. Both Lee Harvey Oswald and Ray were dropouts from society. Both had been failures in almost everything they had undertaken, except in the final and fanatic act of violence.

A dead Oswald leaves behind a mountain of unanswered questions. A live Ray may be able to shed some light on the killing of Dr. King, if Ray can be captured and persuaded to talk — and, of course, assuming his guilt.

We need to know more about the inner — and outer — compulsions which go into the composition of a killer. What were the compelling influences which caused Ray to make what on the surface appears to be a social protest against Dr. King's activities? Why, indeed, should a social outcast such as Ray even want to become involved in such a protest?

These are questions in search of an answer.

Eric Galt: One Man Or Many

Wide-spread speculation given by witnesses to newsmen and to the FBI has prompted speculation that Eric Starvo Galt was a "cover" name used by several men in a conspiracy to assassinate The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

After the FBI said yesterday that Galt really was James Earl Ray, a 40-year-old escaped convict, it was noted that his description did not match that given by earlier witnesses in the case.

PRIOR TO yesterday's bulletin on Ray, the description from witnesses who had known Galt in the past months had included:

- ✓ A long-nosed man in late 20's who was seen in Memphis at a rooming house from which the shot was fired that killed Dr. King.

- ✓ A 30-year-old, dark-spoken man who talked about the weather at a Birmingham rooming house last fall.

- ✓ A 36-year-old "avid dancer" who bought a rifle in Birmingham and who took dancing lessons in New Orleans at the time when James Earl Ray, the fourth Galt, was imprisoned in Missouri.

- ✓ James Earl Ray, a five-

year-old, five-foot-

seven, 165-pound, sandy-

haired man with a

southern accent.

Galt at a Memphis rooming house the day Dr. King was slain said that he was 5 feet 11 inches or 6 feet tall, slender, weighting 165 pounds, with sandy hair. The oldest estimate of his age was 32 years, the youngest 26. He was said to have a long pointed nose and a southern accent.

At a Birmingham rooming house where Galt lived for weeks last fall, he was described as being 5 feet 11 inches tall, weighting 175 pounds, with brown hair and a slightly southern accent. He was described as being about 30 years old.

The first FBI description of Galt, which came principally from a gun dealer in Birmingham where Galt bought a rifle and a gun dealer in Memphis where he bought a pair of binoculars, was not precise.

THE FBI description that was released Wednesday might said that Galt was between 5 feet 8 inches and 6 feet 11 inches tall, weighed about 160 to 175 pounds, was of medium build, and had brown hair and blue eyes.

This description said that his birth date was

a date that the FBI apparently got from an application that Galt made for an Alabama driver's license. The FBI said that Galt's voice had a "neutral" tone.

James Earl Ray was described as being 40 years old.

Ray had a scar in the center of his forehead and on the palm of his right hand.

ON MARCH 1, 1968, after Galt telephoned the Alabama Highway Patrol to ask for a duplicate copy of the driver's license that he had gotten in November 1967.

The FBI had said that Ray was in California during this time.

In its bulletin on Wednesday describing Galt as an assassin, the FBI said that he had taken dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1967 and that Galt, under the name James Earl Ray, had been in prison in Missouri from 1967 until he escaped in April 1967.

Yesterday's bulletin did not mention Galt's alleged robbery charge, which the FBI said he was convicted of in April 1967 from the Missouri Penitentiary.

Ray had been in prison from 1967 to 1968 for his civil rights.
