forwarded to the Bureau an original and 7 copies of a letterhead memorandum showing information received from JOHN ARTHUR CHAMBLEE, a detective of the Jackson, Mississippi Police Department, considered by Jackson a reliable individual who is acquainted with members or former members of the WKKKKOM. CHAMBLEE, in reporting this information that was overheard as general rumor among Klansmen and he did not know the source, was doubtful of its truthfulness.

The information in substance was that on 3/17/65, CHAMBLEE advised that he had received unverified information that in 1964, the original Knights of the KKK of Mississippi had hired a "killer" from the State of Oklahoma to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. when KING was in Jackson, Mississippi. This "killer" was known as "TWO JUMPS" and came to Jackson, Mississippi to "case" the layout and while in Jackson, stayed at the Terrymore Motel. He was to use a high-powered rifle with telescopic sights. This deal allegedly fell through when the Klansmen could not raise the \$13,000 demanded by "TWO JUMPS."

CHAMBLEE also reported "TWO JUMPS" was allegedly also the killer of a Bureau Top Ten fugitive later identified as JOHN GIBSON DILLON. "TWO JUMPS" allegedly killed DILLON at the Flamingo Motel in Jackson, Mississippi and thereafter transported the body to Oklahoma or Kansas where it was dumped in an old well.

The Oklahoma City Division by airtel of 4/8/65, advised Bureau and Jackson Division that complete background in the case involving Top Ten Fugitive JOHN GIBSON DILLON did not substantiate that DILLON was killed in Mississippi. From facts available to Oklahoma City, it was doubtful in fact if DILLON was killed in Mississippi.

The Jackson Division on 4/2/65 interviewed PCI CLENNIE JOE BUCHANAN, described by Jackson as a notorious confidence man and gambler who had at that time been under development as an informant of the Jackson Division for some two months.

BUCHANAN was asked if he knew an individual named DONALD SPARKS or GENE SPARKS to which he promptly replied, "Who, TWO JUMPS?" He was thereafter shown and photograph of DONALD EUGENE SPARKS, Tulsa, Oklahoma Police Department Number 38224 dated September 7, 1963. BUCHANAN promptly identified this photograph of SPARKS as being identical to the person he has known for many years as "TWO JUMPS." BUCHANAN went on to relate that SPARKS got the nickname of "TWO JUMPS from his ability as a cowboy and according to BUCHANAN, SPARKS was an excellent "broncho buster" and could ride almost any horse. BUCHANAN considered SPARKS to be an extremely hard and tough individual who would not hesitate to kill anyone. Extensive investigation was conducted in several field offices to concretely identify "TWO JUMPS" and from the identification of PCI CLENNIE JOE BUCHANAN, Jackson, Mississippi, it was felt that DONALD EUGENE SAPRKS was identical to "TWO JUMPS."

Investigation by the Jackson Division at the Terrymore Motel in Jackson failed to disclose any registration that could be identified as being that of SPARKS. In addition to the above identification of SPARKS as "TWO JUMPS", Phoenix CI PX 737-C was interviewed at Phoenix on 1/26/65. This informant advised he knew DONALD EUGENE SPARKS and was well aware that SPARKS' nickname is "TWO JUMPS."

Based on this identification on 5/14/65, an attempt was made to interview DONALD EUGENE SPARKS, Inmate Number 71755, at the Oklahoma State Penitentiary. Following his being advised of his rights, SPARKS stated at the outset he would not furnish any information. He did deny being contacted by anyone at any time to commit a murder and said he did not kill anyone for money or any other reason. He denied ever being hired by anyone in the South and specifically in Mississippi to commit any murder. He denied knowing anyone connected with the Ku Klux Klan.

SPARKS at this time stated he had never cooperated with any police officers and did not intend to start doing so now. He said he had been contacted by numerous officers and would appreciate it if police officers would not bother him again since they wasted his time, as he was working in the plumbing shop in the Penitentiary and could not be away from his job. SPARKS terminated the interview by getting up and leaving the room.

By airtel to the Bureau dated 5/17/65, in case "WHITE KNIGHTS OF KU KLUX KLAN OF MISSISSIPPI, RACIAL MATTER", the Bureau was advised of the attempted interview with SPARKS. Additionally, 9 copies of an FD 302 dated 5/17/65, was furnished to the Jackson Division. This showed the interview with SPARKS. At that time, it was the considered opinion of Agents that had worked cases involving SPARKS, his associates, and Agents who handled the former case involving former Top Ten Fugitive JOHN GIBSON DILLON, that information that SPARKS was hired to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and that he did kill DILLON was not accurate nor truthful information. It was pointed out that following DILLON's murder there was a massive amount of rumor, speculation and hearsay information circulated among the criminal element concerning the death of DILLON. It was this hearsay information that was probably being reported by Jackson's informant in all honesty.

The Bureau's attention is directed to the fact that HERMIT EUGENE WING, aka, ANTI-RACKETEERING, is the subject of a current pending file, Oklahoma City 92-588, Bureau file 92-9329. He is an Oklahoma ex-convict, Burglar, Armed Robber, who travels extensively throughout the United States. He was last interviewed by Bureau Agents, 3/5/68, where he was living at Bartlesville, Oklahoma. He was at that time employed at Jeanie's Lounge in Bartlesville.

On 4/20/68 Mrs. Sonhie M. Strause, 3726 Tangerine So., St. Petersburg, Florida, telephone 867-5711, whose husband operates the M & S Roofing Co., 3522 Tangerine So., telephone 867-5604, advised that on 4/19/68 the Florida State Employment sent to them for a few hours work a man bamed RICHEL WHITE, though on his card the name was shown as Richard White. Because of the temporary employment she did not take any background information, nor get his Social Security Number.

She described him as 40; 5'10"; 180; muscular build; hlue eyes; brown hair; his ears were the same as the photograph and the picture of Galt on TV.

She was not positive in the identification, but thought several items of his story was suspicious. He said that he had been in St. Petersburg since January, but his complexion was white. After working in the sun for 3 1/2 hours he came in beet red. When he reported for work he wore a white shirt and was clean and neat. He said that he had just retired from Service, and had worked as a file clerk. He had no military carriage.

The man was soft spoken, but had no particular southern or rural accent. She does not rememberhis hair exactly.

When he came back in from the job, he cleaned up before he left. He worked for 3 hours for \$1.50 an hour.

He told the man with whom he worked that he was living at the Fairfax Hotel. He had not been able to get any steady employment since coming to St. Pete.



On \$\$\delta \delta \frac{19}{68}\$, Brigadier Warren Fulton, Salvation Army, 400 N. Ft. Harrison, Clearwater, Fla. advised S\$\delta\$ John R. Hippard as follows; via telephone:

On 4/19/68, an individual, (FNU) NXKKEXN O'BRIEN, entered the Salvation Army office and requested aid in obtaining some sort of "nerve medicine". FULTON stated that his group could not get this medicine for O'BRIEN, because it was a type of drug which took a prescription from a physician to obtain it.

FULTON advised O'BRIEN that he could get him in the VA Hospital (Bay Pines) and in that manner, O'BRIEN could get medication. O'BRIEN advised that he was, in fact, a veteran and had an honorable discharge from themilitary; however, O'BRIEN stated that Veterans hospitals were "nothing but a slaughter house", as he had been in one at one time and they had removed part of his spinal column, and that this is what caused his nervousness.

FULTON STATED that O'BRIEN was extremely nervous and appeared to not want FULTON to call anyone on the phone; he also, pulled at his ear in a nervous gesture. FULTON said that he offered to get ** O'BRIEN* a bus ticket to St. Petersburg, Fla., as ** O'BRIEN* had advised that he was going to stay with "friends" in St. Petersburg. FULTON stated that after making this offer, ** O'BRIEN* abruptly left the office.

FULTON advised that O'BRIEN had been referred to his office by the CHURCH BY THE SEA on Clearwater Beach, Fla. FULTON said that about 1 hr. after O'BRIEN had left his office he (FULTON) thought that O'BRIEN resembled FRIC STARVO GALT, aka., and he called the CHURC SEARCHETHES INVESTIGATION.


