In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to

She advised on 5/8/68 she saw the latest photograph of
James Earl Ray in the local newspaper and noted he strongly
resembled the aforementioned man who was driving the 1958 Pontiac.
She could recall nothing about this man other than he had a sharp
pointed nose and was wearing a sport shirt.

Concerning the car she recalled it had a wide chrome band
~~across~~ across the back of the front seat. She did not recall seeing
the license tag and had no idea as to what state issued the tag.

Mrs. Edward West advised he did not notice the above mentioned

On 4/9/68, Unit 12, United Klans of America, Inc. (UKA), Orlando, Fla., held a special meeting at the Klavern starting at about 7:45 PM, with approximately 53 persons present, including 7 UKA members from the Ocoee area, and 2 members of the former Florida Pioneer Club.

Jones and Marek did most of the talking at the meeting and the discussion concerned the recent killing of Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. According to Jones and Marek, trouble was expected in the streets of the cities of this country anywhere and everywhere, as a result of the King killing and the Negroes were suppose to, as a result of this killing, foment race riots.

Plans were worked out among Unit 12 so that only one person in eight of the local members would know their Klan's plan of action in event of trouble in Orlando area. This one individual would then contact eight members and pass on the word to them.

In spite of all the discussion of race, rioting and killing, at the meeting, three members of Unit 12 were instructed to go home following the meeting and it is believed that they did so.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 10:15 PM.

The Bureau has advised that subject spent a considerable sum of money from 4/23/67 to 4/4/68, and the source of this money has not been determined. In view of this, photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, aka should be displayed at once to appropriate witnesses in unsolved BRs and BBs in those instances where witnesses are available.

Also consideration should be given to requesting police departments to display photograph of JAMES EARL RAY to witnesses in their unsolved robberies.

Insofar as the leads to handle unsolved BRs in Tampa and Polk County, SA CARO in headquarters is handling same. It is to be noted that only the Orlando RA has an unsolved BR and the Ft. Myers RA has an unsolved BB.

In view of the above, Agents who receive a copy of this memo should take the action indicated above. SRAs receiving same should assign Agents to contact appropriate PDs to solicit their cooperation to show photographs of JAMES EARL RAY to witnesses in their unsolved robberies. It should be noted that major PDs and SOs should be contacted in this regard.

Geneva Avenue, Sanford, Florida, advised that while getting a haircut at Garfield's Barber Shop, known as The Gator Barber Shop, he observed an individual who closely resembled the person whose picture he saw in the Sanford paper on 5/13/68. FLEMING said this person drove up to the barber shop in a Yellow Cab, and he overheard the person say he was a former cab driver in New York City. He said the person is not a native of Sanford.

Fleming said that this person had his hair cut by a barber who is tall and wears dark-rim glasses.

HAROLD SANDVILL, Barber, Gator Barber Shop, advised that he recalls cutting the hair of a Yellow Cab driver around noon on 5/13/68. SANDVILL was shown photos of JAMES EARL RAY, and stated that this person is definitely not the person whose hair he cut.

PIERCE HAS NEVER BEEN A BUILDER AND HAS HAD NO AFFILIATIONS IN CUBA, DOES NOT KNOW EDDIE WILBURN AND HAS NEVER BEEN A MEMBER OF ANY KKK GROUP.

The following investigation was conducted by SA A. LEWIS BARNETT on 5/28/68:

MR. DURWOOD SIPPOLA, Local Officer, Salvation Army, 2100 Jackson Street, advised that his organization has no facilities for housing indigents in Fort Myers. He stated in rare and needy cases usually involving families, the Salvation Army will arrange overnight lodging in hotels or motels. MR. SIPPOLA reviewed his records for the past 18 months and advised that they contained no names similar to JAMES EARL RAY or his aliases. He viewed the photograph of RAY and stated that RAY did not appear familiar to him. MR. SIPPOLA was furnished a copy of the Identification Order concerning RAY and stated he would compare the photograph and description with any white males seeking assistance from the Salvation Army.

MR. RAUL JORDAN, Store Manager, St. Vincent de Paul, 2219 Main Street, advised that occasionally the charitable organization of St. Vincent de Paul, operated by the Catholic Church, offers assistance to needy individuals. He stated that in rare instances this assistance takes the form of providing lodging in public hotels or motels. MR. JORDAN stated that his records do not indicate that the organization has ever assisted anyone by the name of RAY or any of his aliases. He stated the photograph of RAY did not remind him of anyone with whom he had ever come in contact. MR. JORDAN was furnished an Identification Order concerning RAY and requested to immediately advise the FBI should he come in contact with anyone who could possibly be identical with RAY.
