Platicamos en éste puerto, con la Sra. Rosario Berdeja (Española)-del-Hotel San Francisco", en dondo se dice, que el sujeto con el nombre Calt, sehospedo alla por los dias do del mes de octubre/967 aunque la Sra.Rosariovieja conocida nuestra, dijo que nadie de los empleados recordo al sujeto on las fotos que les fueron mostradas, y que en ése hotel fué una casuali dad que a la fecha aun conservaran los registros de 1967 por que regular mente se destruyen al terminar el año. Tratamos de conseguir datos en algu nos hotolos y Kotolos del mos de octubre/967 checando los registros de pasa jeros, pero se nos dijo que las tarjetas del año pasa-do, bien ya fueron des truidas, o las tienen en su poder los contadores, o estan amontonadas en lossotanos, solamente con anticipación avisáramos de cuando deseamos que se nos proporcionen, para que las busquen. Acudimos a las Oficinas de Turismo Federal donde nuestro amigo el Sr. Victor Hernandez Riesgo, nos informó: todos los hote les tienen obligación de rendir un parte por triplicado, diariamente a la Po licia-a Turismo y a la Presidencia Municipal, del movimiento de entrada y sa lida de pasajeros, pero generalmente ésas dependencias destruyen los reportes casi de inmediato, la unica parte en donde se archivan, es aqui en Turismo. Elamigo mencionado ofreció hacernos un chequeo de todos los hoteles y motelesen octubre/967 buscando al sujeto con los distintos nombres que usaba, pero en especial como "Galt"; más tarde se nos avisó que en el chequeo que se llevó a cabo, no se encontraron datos, por que no estan completos los reportes de -hoteles del año pasado, ya que recientemente Turismo cambió sus oficinas de lugar, entonces todavía no se ponene las cosas en lugar adecuado, posiblemente en otro viajo, se podría ya contar con todos los expedientes de 1967.

Aunque anteriormente hicimos un chequeo general en este puerto, insistiendo entre las pupilas que trabajan en casas de asignación, tales como Rebeca y Raquel, así como las que trabajan en la zona Roja; nuevamente tratamos de encontrar a alguien de estas mujeres que recordara al sujeto por la foto que se les enseño, pero como antes, nadie proporciono datos al respecto. Esperamosque en el siguiente viaje sea posible checar tarjetas de registro en todos los moteles, ya sea por conducto de Turismo, o directamente con los establecimientos.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the F21. It is the property of the F21 and is loaned to your agency, it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

Information set forth below covers investigation conducted at Acapulco, Guerrero, Mexico and Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, pertaining to activities of captioned individual who, as FRIC S. GALT, visited Mexico during October and November, 1967.

# AT ACAPULCO, GUERRERO

On November 11, 1968, a confidential source abroad advised that on that date LUIS LUNA DEL CASTILLO, Desk Clerk, Hotel San Francisco, 92 Miguel Aleman, made available records which showed that ERIC S. GALT registered at that hotel, alone, on October 10, 1967. He occupied Room 202 at the rate of 75 pesos (\$6 U.S.) per day. He listed his nationality as "U.S." and his home address as "Alabama". LUIS LUNA stated that he had no recollection of this individual.

This same source advised that on November 11, 1968, Mrs. ROSARIO DEL CASTILLO, owner of Hotel Ean Francisco, stated that she had been in contact with the accountant for the hotel in an effort to locate the actual registration card for GALT. This card, she said, would list the guest's home address and the description of his automobile and would also bear his signature. She said the accountant was unable to locate the card and that it was believed to have been destroyed. Mrs. DEL CASTILLO also stated that she had spoken with several of the hotel employees and that none of them were able to recognize photographs of JAMES BARL RAY. She also made available her copy for October 10, 1967, of a report made daily to the Mexican Government, which lists subject's arrival on that date.

The source also advised on November 11, 1968, that a thorough review had been made of the hotel's guest list for October, 1967, and that there was no guest listed with the name of 'RAOUL" or any similar name.

On November 21, 1968, a second confidential source abroad advised that efforts had been made to find a registration for ERIC S. GALT in other hotels and motels in Acapulco but that these efforts had been unsuccessful to date. This source pointed out that few hotels in Acapulco have an orderly method or system of record-keeping and that it is usually impossible to establish with certainty, from records, that a particular individual has been a guest in one of these hotels.

On December 11, 1968, the second source reported that hotels and motels in Acapulco are required to make daily reports to the Federal Office of Tourism listing their guests, as well as arrival and departure dates. An official of this office advised the source that a check had been made of all records available to him for the month of October, 1967, and that no listing was found for GALT or the other names used by him in the reports furnished by any hotel or motel for the month of October, 1967. This official acknowledged, however, that these reports were probably not complete for 1967, since the office had recently changed its location and there was still not room for all the files and records which should be maintained by this agency.

The source also advised on December 11, 1968, that inquiries had been made throughout the tourist zone of Acapulco and also in the houses of prostitution and that no one was located who could remember subject from his photographs.

### AT GUADALAJARA, JALISCO

On November 13, 1968, a third confidential source abroad advised that records of the Pancho Villa Motel, Avenida Revolucion 1867, had been checked on that date. They showed that ERIC S. GALT registered there on October 15, 1967, alone, and occupied Room 3. He listed himself as a U.S. citizen with address 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, and his occupation as "employed by publisher". The source said that there was no time of departure shown in the records. GALT paid 40 pesos (\$3.20 U.S.) for the room. The source also found a second registration card for "ERIC S. GOLT, 26-08 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama" showing a registration on October 18, 1967. Again, there was no departure date shown for this registration.

This source determined that the girl who worked as a maid during that period was CARMEN IBARRA OCHOA. She was interviewed and said that she remembered nothing about the subject. The source advised that the doorman during that period, GEEGORIO DEL REAL ROMERO, was no longer employed by the Lotel.

On November 15, 1968, the third source advised that the owner of the Pancho Villa Motel, ELPIDIO VELAZQUEZ, had returned to Guadalajara after being out of the city for several days. VELAZQUEZ stated that he could not recall the subject or recognize his picture. Mrs. VELAZQUEZ, the owner's wife, stated that she recalled subject from a photograph with sunglasses which was taken in Mexico in 1967. She said, however, that he did not wear glasses while at the motel. She remembered that he had a car but could not describe it.

Mrs. VELAZQUEZ said that when subject arrived at the motel he was complaining of a toothache. She said she recommended a doctor. The next day she became concerned when he did not come out of his room and she rapped on his door. He answered that he was all right and was about to check out. She stated that he must have done so before 2 p.m., October 16, 1967, because he was not charged for another day. She stated that he arrived at the motel again on the morning of October 18, 1967, and departed before 2 p.m. on October 19, 1967. She recalled that he was alone at the motel on both occasions. She said she did not recall his luggage but that he wore a white sport shirt with short sleeves and brown trousers.

The third source reported that he interviewed Dr. OSCAR GOMEZ PALOFOX, Madero 975, on November 15, 1968. Dr. PALOFOX stated that he recalled a house call which he made to the Pancho Villa Motel but he could not recognize subject's photograph. He said that the man he treated had an abscessed molar and that he had injected tetrafinicol, a penicillin-type drug, to kill the infection. He recommended to the patient that he go to the Hospital Militar and ask them to recommend a dentist. He said that he made this call to the motel at about 1 or 2 p.m. on October 15, 1967.

On November 17, 1968, the third source advised that he had learned that the former doorman of the Pancho Villa Motel had reportedly returned to his home village of Valparaiso, Zacatecas. On November 24, 1968, the source advised that he had tried to locate GREGORIO DEL REAL ROMERO in Valparaiso,

Zacatecas, but had determined that DEL REAL has not been seen there for several months. His relatives told the source that they believed he had gone to the United States to seek employment but that they did not know how he could be contacted.

### MEXICAN GOVERNMENT RECGRDS

On November 11, 1968, a fourth confidential source abroad advised that an official of the Inspection Service of Mexican Immigration in Mexico City had advised that border crossing records are maintained permanently on file in Mexico City. He said that these records had been exhaustively searched in April, 1968, without locating information to confirm the departure of ERIC STARVO GALT from Mexico. He did find a record that GALT entered Mexico on October 7, 1967, at Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, and was issued tourist card #7475449. He stated that a further review of records, during November, 1968, still failed to locate information establishing that GALT or JOHN L. RAYNS departed Mexico at Tijuana, Baja California, in November, 1967.

On November 18, 1968, a fifth confidential source abroad advised that an official of the Mexican Federal Automobile Registration Bureau had stated on that date that the temporary permit issued to GALT's car at Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, in October, 1967, had been cancelled, indicating that the car had left Mexico. This official said that he was directing a communication to the Chief of Mexican Customs at Tijuana, Baja California, requesting certification as to the departure of the car from Mexico and the date.

On December 18, 1968, the fifth source advised that the same official stated on that date that he had still not received confirmation from the border concerning the departure from Mexico of the 1966 Mustang which GALT was driving when he entered Mexico on October 7, 1967.



In addition, cooperative contacts at the Mexico City headquarters of Telefonos de Mexico have been requested to determine whether a record of any such telephone call would still be in existence and, if so, to attempt to locate this record. Experience bin passed cases has shown that local telephone exchanges in many parts of the country usually forward their toll tickets for long-distance calls to a central point in their area or to the main office in Mexico City.

MEX 34, an investigative informant, has continued his efforts to locate additional records in Acapulco pertaining to the visit there by GALT in October, 1967. The informant has furnished three written reports since December, 1968, reflecting that ahe has continued to check in the hotels and motels and listing more than 15 of these establishments which he has contacted during periodic visits to Acapulco. To date, no additional information has been developed regarding GALT's brief visit to Acapulco in 1967.

With regard to the allegation that RAY and a "fat" bartender in Puerto Vallarta were dealing in marijuana, it is believed that this is a reference to LUIS GARCIA, bartender at the Hotel Oceano, who was extensively interviewed in Puerto Vallarta during April, 1968. GARCIA admitted having associated with GALT, appeared to be cooperative and furnished a number of leads which were valuable for the additional investigation conducted at that time. He did not, however, provide any information about having dealt in marijuana with GALT and, to the contrary, stated on one occasion that he terminated his association with GALT because the latter indicated an interest in buying marijuana.

ELISA AREILANO TORRES advised on 4/17/68 that she had lived with GALT for about five days in Puerto Vallarta and claimed that she had parted company with him because he wanted her to buy marijuana which she refused to do. She said he told her he had made various trips to Yelapa, a nearby beach area, in order to buy marijuana.

With regard to the possibility that local authorities might have information concerning GALT's dealing in marijuana in Puerto Vallarta, the violations of narcotics

laws are under the jurisdiction of the Federal Judicial Police in Mexico. GEORGE EMRICH, Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs (BMDD), U. S. Embassy, Mexico, D. F., has advised that his office is in nearly daily contact with the Federal Judicial Police and that there have been no reports from that agency concerning narcotics activities by Americans in Puerto Vallarta. EMRICH stated the Federal Judicial Police do not have a representative in Puerto Vallarta and, about five years ago, asked the U. S. Narcotics Agents in the Embassy to send someone there to investigate the narcotics traffic. At that time, a source of U. S. Narcotics did spend about three weeks in Puerto Vallarta and found areas where marijuana was being grown and sold, inot only in Puerto Vallarta but also in Yelapa and Mismaloya, two nearby beach areas.

A source of local U. S. Narcotics Office advised them in May, 1967, that there had been a large influx of narcotics traffickers into Puerto Vallarta because of a crackdown by authorities in Acapulco. This source said that marijuana and other drugs were readily available in Puerto Vallarta and that there is practically no law enforcement there. Another source of U. S. Narcotics in the United States advised in September, 1965, that he had been in touch with an individual who lived on an island near Yelapa and who told him that he would be able to buy any amount of marijuana eif he went to Yelapa.

It is noted that the LHM forwarded bytthis office under date of 7/24/68 sets forth the information mentioned above which was received from ELISA ARELLANO TORRES concerning GALT's trips to Yelapa and statements from several other individuals interviewed regarding trips that GALT did make to Mismaloya.

It is the opinion of BNDD Agents now assigned to the Embassy that there is traffic in marijuana in the Puerto Vallarta area and that neither the local or federal authorities have any effective means of controlling it or obtaining information concerning it. They believe that Mexicans employed in the various tourist enterprises in Puerto Vallarta would be unlikely to admit to any investigator that they had dealings with GALT in marijuana.

The State Judicial Police in Jalisco do have a small contingent in Puerto Vallarta. MEX 24, who has handled other aspects of this investigation, has been instructed to attempt to determine, on his next road trip to Puerto Vallarta, whether any information is available to this police unit which would establish whether GALT was involved in traffic in marijuana during the time he spent there.

The Bureau and Office of Origin will be promptly advised of any concrete results obtained during this inquiry.

On 4/14/69 PCI RAMON DEL RIO stated that subject's original registration card had never been found, that these cards are destroyed shortly after departure of guests. Any record of telephone calls on that card are destroyed at the same time.

He said that the hotel maintained no other record of long distance calls apart from the records kept individually on the hotel guests. The records of each guest are destroyed two months after departure.

PCT said investigation at the telephone company in Acapulco determined that it would be impossible to find any records of long distance calls made in October of 1967.

Finally, he advised that he had been unable to determine if any other persons, police officials or otherwise, had been checking on subject's presence at the hotel.

On 4-10-69 Mr. ROBERTO H. ORELLANA R., General Traffic Manager, Telefonos de Mexico, Mexico City, advised that inquiries directed to regional offices of the above phone company in Acapulco, Puerto Vallarte and Guadalajara revealed that records of long distance phone calls made from hotels in those cities are destroyed 8 or nine months after the calls are made. As a result no information was available from any of these cities of any significance to captioned matter. However, phone officials in Guadalajara advised that Comandante FNU LIMON, a police official in that city had expressed a similar interest in phone calls made in 1967 from the Pancho Villa Motel. The phone company official cryptically suggested to ORELIANA "try phone number TU 5-2313 in Corpus Christi, Texas", this suggestion, presumed by ORELLANA, evidently based on LIMON's inquiry.

Re case 100-1029, ORELLANA stated that on 3-10-69 telephone service for JOSE LUIS GONZALEZ COISCOU was discontinued by the phone complay because of GONZALEZ failure to pay his bill, but on the same date service was reinstituted with the same phone number (24-07-15) issued to GONZALEZ.

Re case 105-7063, ORELLANA stated that phone number 180-711-24590 is subscribed to by Centro de Investigaciones Culturales, Calle Principal #7, Cuernavaca (Fracc. Rancho Petela):

On 4/14/69, PCI RAMON DEL RIO CARBAJAL, Chief of the Federal Judicial Police, Acapulco, Guerrero, advised that additional investigation conducted by him confirmed that the original registration card of ERIC S. GALT had never been found at the Hotel San Francisco, 92 Miguel Aleman, Acapulco. He said that he was advised that these cards are destroyed shortly after the departure of guests and any record of telephone calls by a guest would have been kept on this card and that no other records of telephone calls are maintained.

Continuing, the PCI said that the investigation at the telephone company in Acapulco had established that it would be impossible at this time to locate any records of long distance calls made in 10/67.

Concluding, the PCI stated that he had been unable to establish whether any other persons, police officials or otherwise, had been checking on subject's presence at the hotel.

On 4/10/69, ROBERTO H. ORELLANA R., General Traffic Manager, Telefonos de Mexico, Mexico City (protect identity), advised on a confidential basis that he had directed inquiries to the regional offices of this company in Acapulco, Puerto Vallarta, and Guadalajara. He said that records of long distance phone calls made from hotels in these cities are destroyed when they are approximately 9 months old. Consequently, Mr. ORELLANA advised, he obtained no information from records as a result of his inquiries with the telephone company regional offices in these cities.

Mr. ORELLANA further advised that he had been told by officials in the regional office in Guadalajara that a police officer in that city had inquired about telephone calls made in 1967, from the Pancho Villa Motel. This is believed to be a reference to the inquiries made by MEX 24, who carries police credentials, in November, 1968.


