Mrs. Brewer reiterated prior statement with a few more details. Gave names of previous managers. She began job on March 12, 1968, identified occupants of rooms on 4/4/68.

Mr. and Mrs. Brewer heard gunshot about 6 p.m. (while watching Rawhide on TV). Left room but saw no one leave.
