
Inmate at Missouri State Penitentiary and knew James Earl Ray and Raymond Curtis. Sero recalls saying, in presence of Ray and Curtis, that someone in Memphis had speculated that, if King attempted economic boycott there, it would be worth a lot to businessmen to have King killed. Sero said the conversation was pure speculation.

Sero described Ray as a "hayseed," "a born loser." Said Ray had never gotten away with a criminal offense. Seems to recall Ray disliked Negroes. Mould not describe Ray as a loner but as unable to make friends or mix socially. Ray was regular user of amphetamines in prison. Said Ray had great need for recognition and idolizes notorious criminals. Sero says it is believable that Ray might have

killed King without pay.

Said Ray has no important criminal connections; Ray never spoke of family; Ray once indicated he had friends in Kansas City, Missouri.

Sero has not heard from Pay since he left MSP.


