Mrs. Bridges sent her children to school at about 8:30 a.m., Friday, April 5, 1968. Thereafter she looked out her apt. window and saw white automobile pull up in parking lot directly across from door to her apt.; car backed into parking space. She saw that license was out-of-state, and later learned that it was Alabama. She saw lone male occupant get out of car and walk across parking lot toward Memorial Drive; he then approached Memorial Drive by left-hand lane between two apt. buildings. She lost sight of him when he went between the buildings.

Her identification of man: 30-35 yrs.
old, 5'10" to 6', 165 lbs, medium build

wearing navy blue suit and white shirt,
dark hair; no hat, no luggage, no glasses.
Did not see his face.

Mrs. Cayton sent children to school at about 8:15 a.m., April 5, 1968. She cleaned most of her apt., then (between 8:15 and 9:30) saw man approaching her apt. from parking lot, which is to left of her front door. Man came to back yard of the 2 apt. buildings to her left, stopped at beginning of the lane to back yard as if to get his bearings, and went toward Memorial Drive. She then lost sight of him. (Buildings referred to by Mrs. Cayton are not same as referred to by Mrs. Bridges or Mrs. Payne.)

Description of man: late 20's or early 30's; 5' 8" to 5'9", black wavy hair, white male; wearing dark blue suit, white shirt and conservative tie; carrying small

notebook with a piece of paper hanging
out of edges. No glasses, no hat.
