BRADY SHOWN SPREAD OF PHOTOGRAPHS, UNABLE TO PICK OUT THE PHOTOGRAPH OF RALPH (LNU). WHEN SPECIFICALLY SHOWN THIS PHOTOGRAPH, SHE ADVISED SHE HAS NEVER SEEN THIS INDIVIDUAL. SHE NEVER WORKED AT BILL BAILEY'S AND SHE NEVER WAS EMPLOYED BY LEWIS CLARK. SHE FURTHER ADVISED AFTER PETE DAVIS SOLD HIS BAR, HE WENT TO WORK IN SAUDI ARABIA FOR ONE YEAR. BRADY WAS UNABLE TO SUPPLY NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF ANY OF THE OLD-TIME CUSTOMERS OF PETE'S BAR. EVERY ONCE IN A WHILE SOME OF THEM DROP IN AT HER BAR, BUT THIS IS NOT DONE ON A REGULAR BASIS. BRADY AGAIN STATED THAT SHE KNOWS OF NO FRIENDS OF RAY GODFREY EITHER MUSICIANS OR CO-WORKERS NAMED RALPH AND THAT WOULD INCLUDE RALPH SMITH OR RALPH SETZER (PHONETIC). SHE ALSO DOES NOT KNOW LEE GODFREY. DIANE BRADY FURTHER STATED THAT SHE WOULD

WILLIAM SANFORD VENABLE CONTACTED THIS DATE AND ADVISED THAT HE AND ROBERT MC GARITY, PREVIOUSLY OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1455 MORELAND AVENUE. AT THIS RESIDENCE WAS A LOUNGE KNOWN BY VARIOUS NAMES, INCLUDING PETE'S PLACE AND BILL BAILEY'S. IN 1966 BUCK BAILEY TOOK OVER THIS LOUNGE AND NAMED IT BILL BAILEY'S. AT APPROXIMATELY JANUARY, 1968, LEWIS W. CLARK HAD THE LIQUOR LICENSE CHANGED TO HIS NAME. PRIOR TO THIS TIME LEWIS CLARK HAD MANAGED AND RUN THE LOUNGE KNOWN AS BILL BAILEY'S FOR BUCK BAILEY. BUCK BAILEY NEVER PARTICIPATED IN THE MANAGEMENT OF THE LOUNGE. VENABLE DOES NOT KNOW ANYBODY BY THE NAME OF POWELL, DOES NOT KNOW ANY "DUKE". HE KNOWS RAY GODFREY BY NAME, HOWEVER, HAS NEVER PERSONALLY MET THE INDIVIDUAL. HE DOES NOT KNOW ANY OF GODFREY'S PERSONAL ASSOCIATES.

LEWIS W. CLARK CONTACTED AND ADVISED HE MANAGED BILL BAILEY'S LOUNGE, LOCATED AT 1455 MORELAND AVENUE FROM SEPTEMBER, 1966 THROUGH 1973. HE PERSONALLY ACTED AS BARTENDER AT THE LOUNGE NUMEROUS TIMES. AFTER BEING SHOWN A SPREAD OF PHOTOGRAPHS, HE PICKED OUT RAY GODFREY AND CLAUDE POWELL AS BEING PERSONS WHO FREQUENTED THE BAR. HE DID NOT RECOGNIZE THE PICTURE OF LEON POWELL. HE STATED CLAUDE POWELL IS A VERY QUIET INDIVIDUAL AND NEVER KNEW HIM TO BE IN ANY TROUBLE. RAY GODFREY WAS AN EXTREMELY EXTROVERED INDIVIDUAL, ALWAYS WANTED TO PLAY THE GUITAR IN THE BAR. HE WAS SHOWN A SPREAD, INCLUDING THE ARTIST'S CONCEPTION OF RALPH AND WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY ANYONE. HE HAD NEVER SEEN ANY OF THE INDIVIDUALS IN THE BAR. CLARK ADVISED THAT JUNE HALL WAS THE DAY BARTENDER AT BAILEY'S AND SHE MIGHT BE ABLE TO SUPPLY FURTHER INFORMATION. HE COULD NOT RECALL ANY OTHER EMPLOYEES WHO WORKED AT BILL BAILEY'S. DIANE BRADY NEVER EMPLOYED AT BILL BAILEY'S.

JUNE HALL CONTACTED AND SHOWN SPREAD OF PHOTOGRAPHS. SHE PICKED OUT CLAUDE POWELL, RAY GODFREY AS PERSONS WHO FREQUENTED THE BAR. SHE STATED CLAUDE POWELL VERY QUIET INDIVIDUAL WHEN

JACKIE POWELL, WIFE OF CLAUDE POWELL, JR. INTERVIEWED AT HER RESIDENCE AND ADVISED THAT ONLY TIME SHE HEARD ABOUT INCIDENT INVOLVING OFFER OF MONEY TO ASSASSINATE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. WAS WHEN HER HUSBAND MENTIONED IT TO HER AFTER KING HAD BEEN ASSASSINATED. HER HUSBAND TOLD HER HE HAD BEEN OFFERED A SUM OF MONEY TO ASSASSINATE KING, BUT REFUSED CONTRACT. SHE STATED SHE HAS BEEN MARRIED TO CLAUDE FOR TWENTY YEARS AND THAT THE WHOLE STORY, IN HER MIND, IS A FABRICATION BY HER HUSBAND AND HIS ALCOHOLIC BROTHER, LEON. SHE WOULD NOT BELIEVE ANY OF THIS STORY; HOWEVER HAD NO FACTS TO BACK UP HER OPINION. SHE STATED AGAIN THAT SHE FELT GOVERNMENT WAS WASTING THEIR TIME AND SHE

Telephone records at the Scottish Inn, Midland, Texas, reflect several outgoing calls, none of which were made by Claude Powell, Jr.

William Dean Woodcock, Claude's roommate and business partner, advised that Claude told him of the alleged meeting at Pete's Bar in Atlanta, Georgia, after initial interview by FBI Agents. Woodcock said that to the best of his knowledge, he is the only co-worker of Claude's who knows of the alleged meeting. He said Claude told him because of their business relationship and his interest in the reason the FBI was contacting Claude. He believed Claude would have no reason to lie concerning the alleged meeting.

the first CLAUDE POWELL, JR., Room 211, Scottish Inn, was interviewed in his motel room during the late evening of February 5, 1976. Special Agent

Discrepancies in his version of an alleged meeting with an unknown white male at Pete's Bar Atlanta, Georgia, as compared with LEON POWELL's were discussed. CLAUDE stated that any discrepancies are a result of a long passage of time since the incident and his statement is accurate in his recollection. He clarified his relationship with RAY GODFREY stating that GODFREY was a friend whom he has known for many years but GODFREY was more closely associated and a better friend of LEON's. CLAUDE also commented that he later learned GODFREY made an initial contact with LEON approximately one week prior to the unknown white male's proposition to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING but he did not know anything about the meeting at Pete's Bar until the unknown white male seated himself and made the offer, nor did he have prior knowledge of what transpired between GODFREY and LEON.

Other than these changes, CLAUDE stands by his original statement, emphasizing that his statement may differ in some aspects with LEON's statement but the fact is, both he and LEON witnessed the offer of a substantial amount of money by an unknown white male to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING.

In addition, CLAUDE stated he and LEON talked about the alleged meeting with the unknown white male frequently after its occurrence but as time passed, they talked about it less and less. He said that he and LEON worked together on the same job at the time of the alleged meeting and continued to do so until approximately three months ago. He knows of no one who could verify that they were in Atlanta, Georgia, at the time of the alleged meeting but stated that both, he and LEON, were residing in Decatur, Georgia, during this time. CLAUDE POWELL, JR., Room 211, Scottish Inn, the interior of Pete's Bar, including the booth where each participant of the alleged meeting was seated and a sketch was made by Special Agent FRANZ W. NENZEL. CLAUDE was questioned specifically concerning his polygraph examination in response to the question "Do you know who asked you and LEON to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING?", and he denied having any prior knowledge of the unidentified person who offered he and LEON \$25,000 to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING.

CLAUDE stated that he telephonically contacted his brother, LEON POWELL, at telephone number 404-289-1545, Decatur, Georgia (telephone number is for DAVID POWELL, CLAUDE's nephew) after initial interview by FBI Agents at Midland, Texas. CLAUDE stated that he and LEON discussed the interview.

In addition, CLAUDE stated he had discussed the alleged meeting with the unknown person at Pete's Bar with WILLIAM DEAN WOODCOCK, his partner in business and roommate at the Scottish Inn. WOODCOCK is the only fellow employee whom he told of the alleged meeting.

CLAUDE stated that the unknown person who offered them the money to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING did not have any type of an accent. He repeated that all aspects of his statement including description, time reference and conversation between the unknown person who made the offer to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING were true and accurate to the best of his recollection.

CLAUDE stated that he and LEON talked about it in the bar. He stated that they worked together at the bar for the time of the meeting and continued to do so until approximately three months ago. He knows of no one who could verify that they were in Atlanta, Georgia, at the time of the alleged meeting but stated that both, he and LEON, were residing in Decatur, Georgia, during this time. 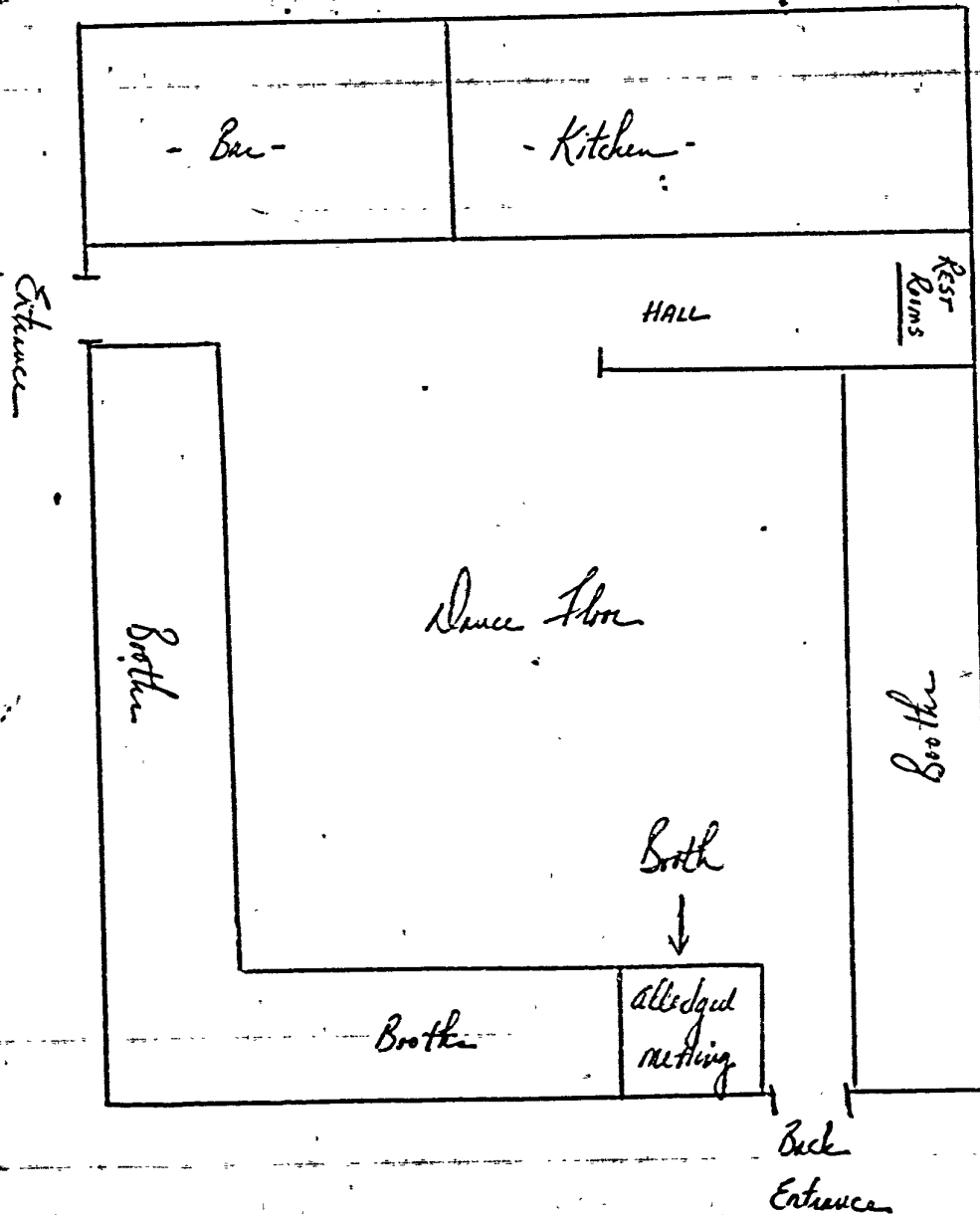

LEON POWELL INTERVIEWED AND ADVISED EVERY NOW AND THEN HE REMEMBERS ADDITIONAL OR CORRECTING DETAILS REGARDING THE INCIDENT. DISCREPANCIES IN VERSION OF INCIDENT PETE'S BAR, ATLANTA, AS RELATED BY CLAUDE AND HE (LEON) DISCUSSED. [ORIGINAL CONTACT WITH GODFREY WAS APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK BEFORE MEETING WITH RALPH (LNU).] MEETING DEFINITELY OCCURRED IN NOVEMBER OF 1967. COULD NOT RECALL ANY SPECIFIC DENOMINATIONS OF THE MONEY IN THE BRIEFCASE, HOWEVER THE BRIEFCASE NOT FULL OF MONEY AND RALPH STATED SOMETHING TO THE EFFECT, "HERE'S 25". RALPH OFFERED THEM "25 NOW AND 50 WHEN HE'S IN THE GRAVE" OR SOMETHING TO THAT EFFECT. TO THE BEST OF LEON POWELL'S MEMORY, RALPH NEVER MENTIONED MARTIN LUTHER KING, BY NAME. LEON STILL DESCRIBED RALPH AS A WHITE MALE, SIX

AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT, THE NAME OF THE BAR WAS BILL BAILEY'S. DAVIS SOLD THE BAR TO A WOMAN WHO DID NOT HOLD IT VERY LONG AND THEN SHE SOLD IT TO A FELLOW NAMED BAILEY. HOWEVER, MOST OF THE OLD TIMERS STILL CALLED THE BAR PETE'S BAR. CANNOT RECALL WHO WAS IN THE BAR AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT.

LEON ADVISED TO THE BEST OF HIS MEMORY BOTH HE AND HIS BROTHER WERE WORKING FOR RAY COOLEY, AN INDEPENDENT DRY WALL CONTRACTOR, AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. COOLEY IS NOW EMPLOYED BY FISHER DRY WALL, ATLANTA.

LEON AND CLAUDE TALKED ABOUT THE INCIDENT AT VARIOUS TIMES AFTER IT HAPPENED. THEY TALKED ABOUT THE OFFER SHORTLY AFTER LEON'S WIFE LEFT HIM IN EARLY 1968. THOUGHT THE MONEY WOULD BE NICE BUT DID NOT WANT TO MURDER ANYONE. TALKED ABOUT INCIDENT WHENEVER THEY WERE HARD-UP FOR MONEY. LEON TALKED WITH HIS BROTHER, CLAUDE TWICE WHILE CLAUDE WAS IN TEXAS AFTER HE CONTACTED THE FBI.

POWELL FAMILIAR WITH W. VENABLE, AKA YANK, AND BILL MC GARITY. THESE TWO INDIVIDUALS OWNED THE PROPERTY AND THE BUILDING IN WHICH PETE'S BAR WAS LOCATED. NEITHER VENABLE NOR MC GARITY ARE RALPH.

POWELL QUESTIONED ABOUT FRIENDS OF GODFREY. ONLY REAL CLOSE ASSOCIATE OF GODFREY'S THAT POWELL COULD THINK OF WAS A RELATIVE NAMED LEE GODFREY. LEON WILLING TO TESTIFY TO EVERYTHING HE HAS TOLD THE FBI.

SHERIFF PAUL HIGDON, FANNIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, ADVISED LEE CARROLL GODFREY IS A WHITE MALE, DOB FEBRUARY 19, 1933.

Arnold Ray Godfrey, 1105 Lakeshore Drive, Jonesboro, Georgia, telephone 477-5036, was telephonically contacted on 1/16/76, and requested to submit to a polygraph examination at which time he stated, "I'm innocent, I don't want to talk to the FBI any further". Godfrey stated if the FBI is interested in pursuing this matter any further, he will not talk unless the FBI contacts his attorney, Jack V. Dorsey, 934-8921, or 633-9607.

On 1/19/76, LEON OWEN POWELL, 2786 Alston Drive, Apartment 9, Decatur, Georgia, telephonically contacted the Atlanta Office of the FBI, advising he was sick and desired to postpone his polygraph examination until the week of 1/26 - 30/76.

On 1/29/76, LEON OWEN POWELL voluntarily appeared at the Atlanta Office of the FBI to submit to a polygraph examination. POWELL was advised of his rights by SA JOHN B. REYNOLDS as shown on a warning and waiver of rights form, which he signed after reading. POWELL also executed a consent or waiver to take a polygraph examination form.

On 1/29/76, at 7:45 PM, LEON OWEN POWELL, after executing FD-328 (Polygraph Consent Form), was afforded a polygraph examination in the Atlanta Office of the FBI. Assisting in the collateral interview was SA AUGUST W. BULFER. POWELL, during pre-polygraph interview, substantially furnished the same information as in previous interviews with the exception to information concerning money offered by GODFREY. POWELL, according to his recollection, stated GODFREY never mentioned the amount of money to be paid, but indicated he stated he was looking for someone who was interested in making "big money". Also, GODFREY indicated "big money" would be paid for killing MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. POWELL previously stated GODFREY made the statement \$50,000 was to be paid. However, when going over the polygraph questions to be asked him, he requested that the amount be deleted from the question and the words "big money" be substituted for \$50,000. According to POWELL, the conversation with GODFREY came about while they were sitting in Pete's Bar during the fall of 1967, and the conversation was concerning MARTIN LUTHER KING's activities at which time someone stated KING should be killed and POWELL's brother, CLAUDE POWELL, made a statement to the effect that he would kill him for the right amount of money. POWELL advised a couple of days after the initial conversation with GODFREY while they were in Pete's Bar, a white male entered the bar inquiring about the POWELLS. After locating them, he stated he came to talk to them concerning a matter that had previously been discussed, after they acknowledged in the affirmative that they knew why he was there. The white male, whom POWELL identified as RALPH, then asked if they were ready to go through with it.

POWELL stated this white male never mentioned the killing of KING or discussed how the killing would take place, but only displayed a small briefcase which contained a large amount of money. One question of the polygraph examination was "Did RALPH say he had \$25,000 in the briefcase?". However, POWELL stated RALPH never indicated the exact amount, only stating he had "twenty-five". POWELL, when questioned as to whether he meant \$2,500 or \$25,000, stated RALPH never did state the amount but he realized that that much money in that size briefcase would have to be at least \$25,000. RALPH also made the statement that there would be "fifty more" when MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., was buried. However, when he questioned them as to whether or not they would go through with it, CLAUDE POWELL stated they would have to think about it, at which time RALPH departed the bar stating if they had not made up their minds by that time, he could not do business with them.

POWELL was afforded four separate examinations, the first being a card test where POWELL viewed three different cards of different colors but was advised to deliberately lie to the color of two of these cards. It was noted the results of this examination indicated no significant reaction to these questions and this test was inconclusive.

Examinations two, three, and four, all containing relevant, irrelevant and control questions, the relevant questions concerning statements made by GODFREY and contact by RALPH, were also inconclusive, in that POWELL did not react significantly to any one of these questions. POWELL did react to two questions concerning GODFREY, particularly the questions, "Did GODFREY ever ask you if you were interested in making big money?", and "Did GODFREY tell you the big money was to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.?". The reaction indicated on the chart was not significantly strong enough to draw a conclusion as to deception and it is possible this reaction could be attributable to POWELL's changing his story from the original interview of GODFREY making the statement concerning \$50,000 to now stating "big money".

During the polygraph examination, POWELL appeared to have difficulty breathing and the upper pneumograph had to be continually adjusted by the examiner. POWELL did not appear overly nervous, did not display any outward sign of emotion, but did state all during the polygraph that he was very nervous concerning this whole matter and that he had a hard time breathing

properly, particularly as the polygraph examination progressed. When questioned concerning responses indicated on the chart, POWELL would only state that he was telling the truth, and that he told all he knew and could recall concerning this incident. POWELL indicated he had a high school equivalency degree, however, he appeared to be of limited intelligence and appeared to be much older than forty years of age. During questioning, he admitted to doing a lot of beer drinking, however, denied drinking anything during the day of the examination.

A review of these charts reflects that POWELL responded generally in the same manner to all questions asked with no significant response to any individual question whereby a conclusion could be drawn as to his being truthful or untruthful. Therefore, these polygraph examinations were determined to be inconclusive.

On 1/19/76, at 8:15 PM, CLAUDE POWELL, JR., was afforded a polygraph examination by SA LOREN K. LEE, of the San Antonio Division of the FBI, who was unassisted in the collateral interview.

POWELL's "yes" responses to questions, "Did someone offer you and LEON \$50,000 to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR?", and "Did someone ask you to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR?", were less than responses to control question, indicating POWELL is truthtelling in stating someone did, in fact, offer him and his brother \$50,000 to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. POWELL's "no" response to question, "Do you know who asked you and LEON to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.?" and his reactions following the answer indicate a possible knowledge regarding the unidentified person mentioned in the above questions.

POWELL was left with the impression that results of the polygraph examination were unclear and that the strong possibility existed wherein the FBI would request an additional test in the immediate future. Results of the test were not discussed in any way with POWELL nor was interrogation effected.

On 1/4/76, LEON OWEN POWELL interviewed and advised in late October or early November, 1967, he and his brother, CLAUDE POWELL, JR., were approached by a mutual friend, RAY GODFREY, regarding the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. A week after this initial meeting, an individual named RALPH (LNU), contacted he and his brother and advised them he would pay \$75,000 to assassinate MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. The POWELLS turned the offer down and have not seen RALPH (LNU) since then. CLAUDE POWELL, JR., interviewed at Midland, Texas, and furnished same information. RAY GODFREY located and interviewed and stated he never talked to POWELL brothers about murdering MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and furthermore, has no knowledge of any individual named RALPH. Other relatives of POWELLS contacted and advised both LEON and CLAUDE POWELL are hard drinkers and question veracity of statements.

PURPOSE: To advise of the status of the investigation recently instituted to resolve an allegation by Leon Owen Powell and his brother, Claude Powell, Jr., that prior to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., they were offered payment to murder Dr. King.

BACKGROUND: This case pertains to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on 4/4/68. James Earl Ray pled guilty to this murder and presently is in local confinement.

You were advised in previous memoranda that we are conducting an investigation at the request of the Civil Rights Division (CRD), U. S. Department of Justice, to resolve a recent allegation (made in January, 1976) by Leon Owen Powell and his brother, Claude Powell, Jr., that prior to the assassination of Dr. King, they were offered payment to murder Dr. King.

Leon Owen Powell claims he and Claude Powell, Jr., while in an Atlanta bar in October - November, 1967, were approached by a mutual friend, Ray Godfrey, who asked the Powells if they were interested in making \$50,000. Godfrey told them he would put them in contact with an individual who would pay them to murder King. Approximately one week later at the same bar, the Powells were approached by an individual named Ralph (last name unknown), who said "I guess you know why I'm here" and subsequently opened his briefcase displaying what he said was \$25,000, and then said, "If you decide to take the job, there's \$50,000 more when it's completed." Powell said they told Ralph they needed time to think it over. Ralph replied "if your mind is not made up now, I can't do business with you." Powell said
