1. Further to para #2 of PCR dated 4 JULY 68, the name of the Lawyer is Bernie HORTON of New Orleans La USA Area code 504-288-9541.
2. Further to para #4 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68, investigations were conducted to obtain all Toll Tickets concerning the long distance calls, however, same proved negative as all Toll Tickets in this case were destroyed after the 60 day holding period.
3. Further to para #5 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68, it was established through the BELL that KIMBLE had phone #525-9567 whilst residing under the name J.R. KIMBLE at 3420 St. Germain St Montreal Apt #4 during the month of SEPT 67.
4. All documents concerning KIMBLE'S phone were examined and initialed by myself and Mr. Vollen HASTINGS Security Officer for BELL TELEPHONE Montreal, Que. Photostats of all documents are attached hereto. The originals are held on file this point and are shown on Exhibit Report #68/51. Copies of C246 are attached hereto.
5. As the BELL Security have no means of holding these documents in a safe place same are being held by this Force for possible use as evidence at a later date. A search warrant will be obtained in order to hold these documents in consideration of the BELL policy. A further report will be submitted concerning this search warrant.
6. Continuing with para #4 above the following documents were obtained and are explained in part starting with the original request by KIMBLE for a phone:

PHOTOSTAT marked "A" -

This is a form referred to as a 515 which is completed by the BELL at time of request for a phone:

- a) phone #525-9567 is KIMBLE'S
- b) phone #522-6530 is registered to John SUZ landlord at 3420 St. Germain St., Montreal
- c) Phone #842-1251 is registered to ROYAL VICTORIA HOSPITAL 687 Pine Ave., Montreal.

It will be noted that there is no way to identify the BELL employee who had taken this request over the phone or in person. Before contacting SUZ or ROYAL VICTORIA HOSPITAL to further this investigation, the photo of KIMBLE as requested in para #12 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68 is awaited.

Dealing with the same statement, under "Originated From" it is believed that "St. Paul Er" is St. Paul L'Ermite, Que., a town located approx 5 miles from the Island of Montreal. No investigation is contemplated at this time at St. Paul L'Ermite unless a photo of KIMBLE is available.

Still with the same statement, the name "Woodbg NJ" is believed to be Woodbridge New Jersey USA.

PHOTOSTAT marked "E" -

Statement of a long distance call made to New Orleans La from Union City New Jersey and charged to KIMBLE's phone #525-9567. The Toll Ticket #307071525 was on file and is explained under PHOTOSTAT "F".

PHOTOSTAT marked "H" -

This is an IBM card advising of a phone call made from New Orleans on the 23 SEPT ( note upper left corner) in the amount of \$22.85. This card is in reference to long distance call shown in PHOTOSTAT "D" under date 23 SEPT 67 in the amount of \$22.85. The only information available from this card is that the exchange the call was made from was New Orleans #944-????; last four digets unknown. The reverse of this card shows the date and time the card was received in Montreal.

PHOTOSTAT marked "I" -

This is an IBM card advising of a phone call made from New Orleans on the 24 SEPT ( note upper left corner) in the amount of \$21.35. This card is in reference to long distance call shown in PHOTOSTAT "D" under date 24 SEPT 67 in the amount of \$21.35. The only information available from this card is that the exchange the call was made from was New Orleans #944-????, last four digets unknown. The reverse of this card shows the date and time the card was received in Montreal.

PHOTOSTAT marked "J" -

This is the form made up upon the request that a phone be disconnected. Same was given out-order #135922. It was established that Mrs. H. DALLAIRE of the BELL TELEPHONE, 2100 Papineau Office was the person who had taken the request and filled out the document. DALLAIRE's initials appear at the top of the form in the space "EMP". At present DALLAIRE is on 1 year leave of absence from the BELL. The phone numbers appearing on this form are registered to:

1. With reference to para. 36, report dated 13 JUN 68, please be advised that 103 branches of various banks in the area mentioned were checked, as well as 125 branches of the Royal Bank of Canada in Toronto, Ontario, with negative results. All names used by the suspect were checked for possible bank accounts or safety deposit boxes (see Telex CIB1261 sent to the Commissioner, 8 JUL 68). Also, C.N.R. and C.P.R. telecommunications were checked for any money transactions from the U.S.A. under all names in question without result.

2. At 3:15 a.m., 12 JUN 68, an anonymous phone call was received at the information desk to the effect that if we wanted information on RAY see "Blanche" who used to work at the PIONEER TAVERN. A second call came in at 4:00 a.m. from one, Blanche VAN LUVEN, 140 Kingston Road, Ontario, stating that she had information on RAY. Spl. J.S. Dunlop from this Force and Det. Sgt. R. Marsa contacted this woman and took a long detailed statement from her, beginning 6:20 a.m., ending 10:16 a.m. Shortly thereafter VAN LUVEN admitted the first statement was not true, therefore, a second statement was taken, beginning 1:15 p.m. ending 2:35 p.m. Copies of statement and photograph of VAN LUVEN attached. It is felt that this woman might have spent one night with RAY (about the 24 APR 68) possibly at the LORD SIMCOE HOTEL in Toronto. The records at the Hotel were checked from 8 APR to MAY 6, 1968, but neither RAY nor VAN LUVEN can be identified either by the personnel at the Hotel or from records of patrons.

3. Blanche Beatrice HUTCHINSON & VAN LUVEN (DB: 25-6-29) was born in Edmonton, Alberta. She married Anthony T. KOBAYASHI, Japanese-Canadian, in Kelowna, B.C. 25 MAR 52 and was divorced from him in 1961 in B.C. She then moved to Vancouver, B.C., where she met Robert William VAN LUVEN, which resulted in a common law relationship. These people came to Toronto in November 1964 and during 1967 Robert's father, Fred VAN LUVEN, age 83 years, moved in with them. In APR 68, Robert VAN LUVEN found work and moved to Montreal, where he is still employed. Blanche is living at 140 Kingston Road, Toronto, Ontario, Apt. 13, with Fred VAN LUVEN, and now employed at LETROS TAVERN as Hostess. This woman can be described as a prostitute, alcoholic and confirmed liar, incapable of telling the whole truth. Although there is some doubt whether she actually did in fact have any association with RAY, one of the areas marked on the map, mentioned in para. 39 report submitted 13 JUN 68, is the parking lot used by tenants of 140 Kingston Road, Toronto, Ontario. Repeated interviews of this woman and searches of this area have failed to reveal any further information concerning RAY or explain the mark on the map.

4. Mr. Fred VAN LUVEN, although an old man, would appear to be quite honest and a decent type of person. Apparently Blanche VAN LUVEN became upset when she saw RAY's picture in the paper and after

explaining to the old man her relationship with RAY, he advised her to co-operate with the police. Fred VAN LUYK could not supply any definite information in this case.

5. In relation to the map mentioned above, marks on the map in the east part of the City are as follows:

- (1) Edgewood Avenue and Kingston Road, Toronto, Ontario.  
This is a parking lot used by apartment buildings located on Kingston Road, especially 140 Kingston Road, as stated. The superintendents of five apartment buildings were questioned, however, none could identify RAY or assist this enquiry.
- (2) Victoria Park and Woodhurst Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.  
A small weedy park - searched thoroughly with negative results.
- (3) Cassandra Blvd., Toronto, Ontario.  
General area is a housing development with a small park winding behind the houses - park searched with negative results. It will be noted, Paul Edward BRIDGMAN, mentioned para. 31 report admitted 1) JUNE 68, resides at 80 Cassandra Blvd.
- (4) Leslie Street and C.N.T. Tracks.  
Wilket Creek Park, South of Danforth Avenue is a forest and Creek area. Searched with negative results.

It might be noted that the areas marked on the map other than Ossington Street, the downtown district (Vital Statistics) and the 140 Kingston Road are termination points of the Toronto Transit Commission. It is suggested that possibly this map was marked by either the suspect or an accomplice for the use of Public Transportation. There has been no evidence to substantiate this theory.

6. As noted in para. 40 of previously submitted report, Eric L. GALT was checked on 17 JUL 68. He was contacted personally by myself and Cpl. J. J. Munloy in this matter on 19 JUL 68. Eric L. Vincent GALT was born 9-1-15, presently employed as Warehouse Foreman, UNION CANADIAN CANADA LIMITED, Toronto, Ontario. His father, James Henry GALT died 23 FEB 19 and was buried in England; his mother, Naomi (Mrs. James) GALT now resides 11 Melvyn Ave., Scarborough, Ontario. No relatives are buried in Toronto. GALT does not know either BRIDGMAN or BRIDGMAN, nor has he had any dealings with RAY. He banks at the Toronto Dominion Bank, Eglinton Square and NATIONAL TRUST CO., LTD., Golden Mile, Toronto, Ontario. He is a member of the VIKING GUN CLUB, CANADA SHOOTING, an underwater diving club and is currently president of the Underwater Council. GALT made a trip to the U.S. sometime in 1963 and a second trip in 1966. The second time he and family travelled to Islamorada, Florida, where they stayed at the INN AND SUITE HOUSE for one week. GALT and family made two brief trips to Montreal, one in 1963 and the second in SEPT 1966.

At no time did GALT loose or misplace any documents during these trips in either the U.S. or Montreal. He could not supply any information to explain why RAY might have been using his name, if in fact the Eric Starvo GALT used by RAY was intended to be the name of the Eric ST. Vincent GALT of Toronto. GALT at one time signed his name, Eric ST.V. GALT, but four years ago stopped signing the short form of his middle name. The middle name was signed ST with a small circle as the period as STo and the letter V again with a small circle as a period as STVo. The main reason for discontinuing this habit was the company forms requiring a signature were so small he had to cramp the whole signature.

7. Mr. Samuel MARSHALL, Assistant Manager, LOBLAWS GROCETERIA, 1453 Queen St. West, Toronto, advised that RAY entered his store 2:30, 23 APR 68, from the rear and asked him for a full time job. RAY was notified that full time help was only hired from the head office and not by various branches, the correct address and phone number were supplied to RAY. At this point RAY left the store and subsequently boarded a street car and left the area. RAY described as 5'10", 160 lbs., sports jacket checked, grey pants, neat dresser, dark brown hair, identified from F.B.I. Bulletin as well as picture taken in late January or early February 1968 in California. The Head Office of LOBLAWS was checked; however, there is no record of RAY applying for a job under his own name or aliases.

8. Mr. Emerson BENNS, Manager, LOBLAWS GROCETERIA, Baffertin and Eglinton Sts., Toronto, Ontario, was contacted by Cst. Giffin. He advised that during the middle of April 1968, a man wearing a checked jacket, shirt, tie and sunglasses came into LOBLAWS GROCETERIA, 1453 Queen Street West, Toronto, Ontario, to seek employment, where he, BENNS, was working at the time. BENNS thought he recognized the man from a picture displayed in Time Magazine about this time. He followed RAY from the store and watched him board an eastbound street car. BENNS then returned to the store and phoned the Metro Toronto P.D.; however, the M.T.P.D. were unable to locate RAY. No further information was available from BENNS.

9. On 14 JUN 68, Postal Investigators phoned to advise that an envelope addressed to Paul BRIDGMAN, 102 Ossington Ave., Toronto 3, Ontario, had been intercepted in the mail. Cpl. Dunlop and Det. Sgt. Marsh picked up the envelope and found it to contain advertising material from DIRECT FILM SERVICE, P.O. Box 100/C.P. 100, Stn Youville, Montreal, Quebec, mailed from Montreal, 13 JUN 68. Written in pen under the type-written name and address are the words Re: E.S. GALT.

10. Cpl. M. Power, Montreal C.I.B. General, was contacted and subsequent investigation by him revealed that Paul BRIDGMAN was recommended to DIRECT FILM SERVICE by a person signing the name E.S. GALT. Obviously this is a crank recommendation relating to the investigation and not uncommon as far as the DIRECT FILM SERVICE is concerned. It will be noted that RAY was arrested 8 JUN 68, wherein the envelope is dated 13 JUN 68. No doubt the publicity given this case prompted someone to this action.

11. Mr. Holmes Yon CHIN, COMMUNITY CLEANERS, 789 Dundas St. West, Toronto, Ontario, phone number 843-0877 was contacted as a result of Telex C181307 from the Commissioner dated 10 JUN 68. CHIN verified that the laundry mark, letter C circled over number 24, was his laundry mark; however, he could not supply any details on who owned the clothing. When laundry is brought to his shop, he issues a tag to the customer; when the customer returns, the tags are matched and the laundry handed over. No information is recorded. CHIN failed to recognize the second laundry mark, 80-083. Attached hereto, are copies of Ontario Provincial Report Occurrence No. 8 dated 19 JUN 68, prepared by Mr. T. O'BRYEN, the O.P.F. laundry and dry cleaning mark expert.

12. Mr. T. O'BRYEN searched his records concerning the second laundry mark, 80-083, appearing on a pair of men's shorts, and as a result gave the following laundries as possibilities:

- (1) WONG'S LAUNDRY

Immediately to the date established for the arrival of the assassin of Rev. Martin Luther King here in Toronto I gave a report to the Metro Police Department 52 Station on College St. I did recognize the wanted man from the newspaper sketch and gave a description of him and the place seen here in Toronto to Metro Police. At that time he met with a woman. I feel as a citizen I have done my duty and would like to know if my information was in any way helpful towards the search. Also if there is any reward for information leading to the capture.

13. KROBTH was interviewed, however, there is some doubt that he actually saw RAY or even reported the event. KROBTH stated that he was walking south on Elizabeth Street, Toronto, Ontario, during the afternoon of 8 APR 68, when he saw RAY with a red-haired woman in the vicinity of the City Hall. As he is a caretaker next door to # 52 Police Station, College Street, he says he reported same sometime between 12:00 midnight and 3:00 a.m. 9 APR 68. There is no record at this station of a complaint received from this person. KROBTH is not known to be a mental case, however, he is considered to be very eccentric. He was notified that RAY was not arrested as a result of information supplied by him. On the completion of the interview KROBTH was satisfied with the action taken.

14. Enquiries relating to G. Alexander Stone, author of a letter written 10 JUL 68 addressed to Ottawa and to a letter addressed to Mayor Lindsay, New York City, and Police Chief Memphis, 16 APR 62, signed "Concerned" involving Joseph FORDHAM, have not been completed to date. A further report will be submitted covering these two phases of the investigation.

15. Checks were made at the following in an effort to find some trace of RAY:

- (1) Air Canada flights from Toronto to Montreal during period RAY is not accounted for APR 19-26/68. Negative at this point....All records held at Accounts Department Winnipeg. If deemed necessary, may these documents be searched.
- (2) CNR RAILING from Toronto to Montreal - No records maintained.
- (3) Records for newspapers, Telegram, Star and Globe & Mail checked to verify whether RAY used their facilities to obtain background information on SNYDER or FORDHAM. Central Library also checked where these newspapers are all kept up to date - negative.
- (4) Bell Telephone Company contacted re Long Distance Tolls from pay phone No. 531-9662 located at 1077 Dundas St. West, the phone used by RAY. Negative, records destroyed after one month. All long distance calls made from phone at both 962 Dundas St. West and 107 Ossington St. checked negative re RAY.
- (5) Motor Vehicle Branch contacted concerning duplicate driver's or operator's licence issued under names in question - negative.
- (6) Registered Pawn Brokers checked under name RAY and all aliases - negative.

16. All efforts to trace the movements of RAY from APR 6 - MAY 6, when he was known to be in the Toronto area, have not been successful. Investigation has failed to disclose any employment for RAY nor have the numerous hotel and beverage rooms employees, who have been contacted, identified him as having visited their establishments. It is possible, however, that RAY could lose himself in the low class bars and hotels in Toronto without fear of being discovered.

17. Referring to correspondence from the Officer i/c C.I.B., Ottawa, dated 3 JUL 68, please be advised that the Metro Toronto Police Department Hold-Up Squad have been notified of the robbery in question.

18. Investigation is continuing in this case and a further report will be submitted to meet the undernoted Diary Date.

In the event you are charged with a criminal offense as a result of this investigation, do you now wish to say anything. You are not obliged to say anything unless you wish to do so; but whatever you do say will be taken down in writing and may be given in evidence.

Q. Do you understand this caution?

A. Yes.

Q. You voluntarily gave a statement earlier today concerning your actions with a man you know as RAY. You now say that parts of this statement is incorrect and untrue. What do you wish to say about this now.

A. The part I told you about RAY and I being at the Motor Hotel is untrue. I was with RAY once only. I am positive he is the same man I have identified to you from photographs today and recognized the picture in the news, as or immediately as the man I had been with. I picked him up myself at the Metropole Hotel.

Q. The fact you went to the Lord Alton Hotel with RAY is true or untrue?

A. That is exactly true. I don't remember going there but I woke up in the Lord Alton. RAY used foul language while he was making love to me, words like, "Doll you're a good fuck", he used other words similar to this. He always referred to me as "Doll". He used slang language his grammar was poor.

Q. You say his grammar was poor, what do you mean by this?

A. He simply could not put sentences together properly.

Q. Did you ever see him with glasses on?

A. No, I never even saw glasses. He never had a suitcase or anything. He had a light grey turtle neck sweater.

Q. Is there anything else you wish to say?

A. No other than I was drinking and I've told you what I remember.

At 11.30 a.m. June 18th. 1968, Cpl. DUNLOP  
contacted the examiner of the laundry & dry cleaning marks file,  
by phone, and imparted the following information:-

- (a) previous details of marks on shirt & jacket were not correct;
- (b) the marks on the shirt, 'TF 2307-2219' should have been given  
as 'PF 2307-2219'; these marks are now known to be manufacturers;
- (c) the marks on the jacket, '37153', previously amended to '3-7153'  
are now known to be '3-7-15-3'; and appear on right chest pocket  
of jacket & right trouser pocket; these marks are described as  
stamped; still not known if applied directly or appearing on tag;
- (d) laundry mark appearing on collar of shirt now described as a  
letter 'C', completely enclosed in a circle, with a horizontal  
line immediately below circle, and, directly underneath the line  
two digits, '24'; still unknown if the marks are by hand, or machine.

An immediate comparison of the laundry mark was  
started, and, working on the assumption that letter 'C', or digits  
'24' might be 'Indicator Letter', or 'Indicator Numbers' quickly  
eliminated the digits, and, established that letter 'C', circumscribe  
by circle, immediately over digits, was the method of identification  
used by the COMMUNITY CLEANERS, 789 Dundas St. W. Toronto.

In the circumstances of the COMMUNITY CLEANERS, and  
laundry agents, SANITARY LAUNDRY, 673 College St. Toronto, the  
identifying mark is applied, by hand, in black indelible ink,  
directly on the collar of shirts; the encircled letter 'c' indicates  
the address of the laundry, and, the digits indicate the customer  
invoice number.

Despite amendments to dry cleaning marks it is not  
possible to relate to any of the samples on file, and, owing to  
absence of photograph, or adequate details, it cannot be positively  
concluded if these marks are, in fact, dry cleaners.

At 3.55 p.m. Sgt. S. Walker, in cooperation with Staff  
Sgt. J. Foley, 'phoned submission of COMMUNITY CLEANERS to R.C.M.P.

In summation, this office is of the opinion that the  
submission, in respect to COMMUNITY CLEANERS, will prove positive;  
further examination of the dry cleaning marks must await photo  
clarification.
