

Transmitted herewith are five sample laundry tapes bearing Code # 02B-6.

Enclosed sample tapes were obtained from from Thermoseal tape machine, Serial Number 31973, Nodel HSL1, owned and operated by Blum's Individual Laundry and Dry Cleaning Co., 463 Cotten Avenue, Macon, Georgia.

Investigation at Blum's revealed this establishment does not use a code similar to Code #02B-6. Their code consist of 1- through 99 for let number, a letter for week and last two digits for bundle numbers running -1 through 20. Red tape is used by Blum's for special work. They do not ordinarily place a tape on small items such as shorts unless the work only consists of two or three items. Blum's machine has only five characters. The tape is cut one and one eighth inch long and there is no indication that the machine has malfunctioned in the past causing tape to be cut one and one sixteenth inch long.

FRI Laboratory is requested to compare enclosed sample tapes with tape from suspect's shorts previously submitted by the Memphis Office.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI"S IDENT-IFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN

1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54;

AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT DURING HIS CRIMINAL CAREER, RAY
