(C) ILLEGAL WEARING OF THE UNIFORM -- During the recent racial disturbances following the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., four subjects were arrested in Chicago, Illinois, for Illegal Wearing of the Uniform. Another subject was arrested in Northern Virginia when it was determined he illegally wore a U. S. Army Captain's uniform during the disturbance in Washington, D. C. In each instance the interested United States Attorney's Office authorized prosecution under the Illegal Wearing of the Uniform Statute.

It is evident that where Federal troops or National Guard units are utilized for riot duty, excellent opportunities arise for participants in the disturbances to disguise themselves in the uniform of the Armed Forces. Wherever these racial disturbances arise, we should be particularly alert for violations of the Illegal Wearing of the Uniform Statute.

Insure local police departments are cognizant of our jurisdiction in these matters and that all such matters discovered are promptly referred to your office for appropriate investigative attention.



The following investigation was conducted by the writer on 4/9/68:

At 1:05 a.m., Detective RAYMOND MARTIN, Binghamton, New York Police Bureau, Detective Division, telephonically contacted the writer at home to advise that one CLIFFORD BROWN, 1002 River Road, Chenango Bridge, New York, telephone 648-4004 had telephonically contacted the Binghamton Police Department as short time before to advise that he had seen a man driving an automobile in Binghamton, about Midnight, that resembled the composite drawing of the assassin of subject that had appeared in the local press a couple of days before. He stated that this individual was driving a 1968 Chevrolet with Tennessee K01526, which was parked on St. Cyril Avenue in Binghamton.

Investigation reflected that this license is issued to DWIGHT S. HENDERSON, 1520 Theodore Street, Memphis, Tennessee, with a current address of St. Cyril Avenue, Binghamton, New York. A check of the NCIC teletype system reflected that this was not listed as a stolen automobile. Credit bureau files of the Triple Cities Credit Bureau reflect that DWIGHT S. HENDERSON, wife MARJORIE GUTHRIE, was in the US Marine Corps SN 2133044, reading E-4, was 19 years old in January, 1966, and had a former address in Binghamton at $278\frac{1}{2}$ Main Street in 1964.

An address in September, 1967, was 170 Mesa Vista Home, Yuma, Arizona, and a former employment in 1964 was listed as John's Atlantic Service Station on Main and Oakdale Road in Binghamton, New York.

On 4/9/68, Captain PHILIP VANDERBECK, Binghamton, New York Police Department, Detective Bureau, advised that he had determined through investigation that in the glove compartment of his was papers bearing the name of DWIGHT S. HENDERSON, USMC SN 2133044 and a Binghamton address of 28 St. Cyril Avenue, Binghamton.

Mr. JOSEPH POLLSKY, 23 St. Cyril Avenue, the father of a patrolman in the Binghamton PD, advised on 4/9/68, that he had lived at that address for more than 25 years and had seen a new Chevrolet sport coupe, black over yellow, bearing Tennessee plates, parked in front of 28 St. Cyril Avenue, almost every day during the past week or two and did not know the identity of the individuals driving it. He stated that the car had been there most of the time during the day and a young couple with a little baby had gotten into the car at different times and driven away and returned.

Detective MILT FROBEL and Detective JACK COLLETT of the Binghamton Police Bureau advised that they had observed the car parked in front of 28 St. Cyril Avenue during the morning of 4/9/68, and no one had gotten into the car and driven away.

On 4/9/68, the writer in the company of Detectives FROBEL and COLLETT interviewed DWIGHT S. HENDERSON at 28 St. Cyril Avenue, with his wife and they furnished the following information:

He is the United States Marine Corps, rating of Sergeant, SN 2133044 and displayed identification papers and card including photograph.

It was noted that this individual did not resemble the composite drawing that had appeared in the Binghamton mpers a few days previously. His DOB is , he is 6' tall, 160 pounds, brown eyes, brown hair, and wears glasses. His glasses were checked and it was apparent he had bad eyesight and claimed that he had worn glasses since he was eight years of age and must wear them all the time and his license so indicated. His wife is MARJORIE GUTHRIE, father, FRANK M. GUTHRIE, JR., 1250 Theodore Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee, and his wife's father was a policeman in Memphis for 21 years. He is presently employed at a GE plant near Memphis. HENDERSON stated that he had been stationed in Yuma, Arizona, for the last several months and had been visiting in Memphis, Tennessee, at his wife's people's house for the past few weeks and had purchased a new automobile at Memphis, Tennessee. He stated that the 1968 Chevrolet parked in front of his home was his car and he had driven the car from Memphis to Savannah visiting friends and to Binghamton, New York, and had arrived in Binghamton, New York on 4/1/68, and has been staying at that address with his parents since that time. His mother and step-father are Mr. and Mrs. BARTON PETRANY, and Mr. PETRANY works at Endicott Johnson Show Factory and his mother works at Buckingham's on Broad Street, on the east side of Binghamton. He is under transfer from Yuma, Arizona, to New York City, in the Marine Corps and has to report at New York on 4/17/68. He stated that on the night that MARTIN LUTHER KING was assassinated he was with his wife at home and they attended a movie to see Gone with the Wind and he thought is was Thursday night or possibly Friday night. His wife stated that it was Thursday night because she recalls on the way home from the movie they listened to the news on the radio in the car and heard that KING had been assassinated.

On 4/9/68, Mrs. LINDA KROUSANSKI, 18 Margaret Street, Johnson City, New York, advised that she is a cousin of DWIGHT HENDERSON and that he is in the Marine Corps and is visiting at his residence with his wife from Tennessee for a period of a couple of weeks before reporting for duty in New York City. She stated that she babysat for the HENDERSONs at their residence on St. Cyril Avenue, on Friday night, 4/5/68, when DWIGHT and his wife went to see the movie Gone with the Wind. They have a young daughter less than a year old and Mrs. KROUSANSKI stated that she recalls talking to DWIGHT on the telephone Thursday afternoon 4/4/68, and coming over late Friday afternoon, 4/5/68, in order to babysit.

WASHINGTON (AP) — The elusive Eric Starvo Galt, who is wanted for the killing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., was identified by the FBI Friday as a 40-year-old drifter and ex-convict named James Earl Ray.

The FBI said Galt's real identity was traced through "a systematic and exhaustive search of latent fingerprints" developed in the King case against the fingerprints of more than 53,000 persons for whom wanted notices are on file in the bareau's identification division.

Galt is only one of the names Ray has used in brushes with the law which began, according to the FBI dossier, when he was 21.

The FBI said he has used the names of James McBride, James Walton, W. O. Herron and James O'Connor.

He was described as about 5 feet 10, weighing 163 to 174 pounds, with blue eyes and brown hair and two scars: a small scar in the center of the forehead and another on the paim of his right hand.

The FBI said he escaned on April 22, 1967, from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, where he was serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery in St. Louis.

Ray, who is now being sought on a Tennessee murder charge in the King slaying, has an arrest record dating at least to 1949 when he served time in Los Angeles on a burglary charge.

This followed his discharge from the Army. The FBI said he served as an enlisted man from February 1946 to December 1948 when he received a general discharge for ineptness and lack of adaptability.

His Army record showed a three-month sentence at hard laber for being drunk and

The bureau's dossier on Ray indicates he has been a drifter since he left school in the 10th grade at Alston, Ill.

In 1952, according to the FBI, he was convicted in Chicago for armed robbery and served two years in Joliet and Pontiac, Ill. state prisons. In 1955, the FBI said, he was convicted of forging U.S. postal money orders in Missouri and was confined to Leavenworth penitentiary until 1958.

The FBI said Ray was sent to the Missouri State Penitentiary on March 17, 1960, and spent some time in September 1966 in the maximum security ward at the state hospital in Fulton, Mo.

The city clerk at Alton, Ill., Paul A. Price, said a James Carl Ray was born there on the son of a d

aborer.

The principal at Alton Senior to High School said his records g showed three James Rays attended the school during the period Ray would have been there, and he was trying to determine whether any of them was the man identified by the FBI as to Galt.

The bureau did not say what set of fingerprints in the King case was matched with those of Ray, but it is presumed that prints were found on a rifle dropped near the scene of the killing as well as in the furnished room occupied by the sniper.

The FBI also has reported recovering a white Mustang automobile in Atlanta, Ga., believed to have been used by the killer.

In a warrant obtained by the FBI Wednesday, the fugitive was accused of conspiring with an individual "alleged to be his brother" to "injure, oppress, threater, or intimidate Martin Luther King Jr."

Rooming Houses Checked

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (UPI)—FBI sources indicated today that the "alleged brother" of Eric Staryo Galt may be in their custody, helping them search for the man accused of slaying Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

A check of rooming house operators in Birmingham revealed that within the past three days, FBI agents have been making the rounds asking them if a man answering Galt's description had stayed with them in the past two weeks.

In Washington, an FBI spokesman said "The FBI has no one in custody in connection with Dr. King's slaying." The "brother" has not been formally charged with any part in the slaying.

A source in the FBI said that after Galt purchased a gun at a Birmingham sporting goods store about a week before King was killed, he took it to the man he said was his brother.

His brother, the source said, told him "that's not the gun we need" The source refused to say whether the knowledge of this conversation meant that the unnamed second man in the alleged conspiracy was in their custody.

The FBI also released a pnotograph of Galt, 36, described as a "loner" with a "rural quality" in his voice. There was immediate conflict or uncertainty among itnesses who said they had seen Galt.

"No, that's not him," said Peter Cherpes, operator of a rooming house where Galt stayed from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7, 1967

"I can't be sure," said Percy Strickland, a roomer at the house.

The woman who runs the Memphis flophouse from where the killer shot King as the Negro leader stood on his motel balcony also was undecided about the picture. "I just don't know if it's him," said Mrs. Bessie Brewer.

But the FBI insisted the picture was of Galt. "It's him, all right," said Joseph H. Gamble, special agent in charge of the Birmingham FBI office. He said the photograph was taken this year, "in March, I think."

The FBI issued two pictures of Galt, also known as Harvey Lowmeyer and John Willard. Galt's eyes were closed in one photo. The other featured eyes sketched in by an FBI artist.

The FBI complaint, filed in Birmingham, charged that Galt and an individual "whom he alleged to be his brother entered into a conspiracy" to harm King, and Galt purchased a rifle in Birmingham about March 30.

According to the FBI, Galt claimed to be a riverboat cook and merchant seaman and was an avid dancer with a preference for country and western music. He also likes beer and vodka, the FBI said, and "probably does not have a high degree of education."

Agents said Galt 'ook a course at a bartending school in Los Angeles this year and graduated March 2.

JERRY RAY stated that the subject was last seen in 1964 when he was in prison in Missouri. Among other relatives identified was a paternal uncle EARL RAY whom JERRY stated would be about 70 years of age and who served a term in Illinois State Prison, Menard, Illinois. JERRY stated that his uncle, EARL, reportedly died at Syracuse, New York, about November, 1958. Chicago set out lead to verify the death of EARL RAY at Syracuse. On 4/22/68, SA JOHN L. King Supect Picked Alias From Books

WASHINGTON. — The assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King has spawned a weird literary mystery with undertones of murder, conspiracy and even suicide.

At the heart of it are two aliases used by James Earl Ray, 40, so ught nationwide by the FBI in the slaying of the civil rights leader in Memphis on April 4. The false names are "Eric Starvo Galt" and "Harvey Lowmyer."

Eric Starvo Galt is the most intriguing for "Galt" is the last name of a character in Ayn Rand's "Atlas Shrugged," a 1957 novel that has nearly become a bible for some ultra-rightists.

The literary Galt saw politicians, pseudo-intellectuals, bureaucrats and many others as destroyers of America who must be eliminated. Galt is a brilliant man, a leader of "loners," although a loner and individualist himself.

"Starvo" sounds suspiciously like "S t a v r o" in Ernst Stavro Blofeld, the super-fiend of Ian Fleming's "On Her Majesty's Secret Service," "Thunderball" and "You Only Live Twice."

The blurb in "On Her Majesty's Secret Service" quickly established what sort of man Blofeld is: "In a closely guarded bastion of evil high in the Swiss Alps, Ernst Stavro Blofeld puts the finishing touches to a most fiendish plot . . a most diabolical plot for murder on a mass s c a le." In "You Only Live Twice," B l of e l d constructs a garden of evil in which poisonous snakes and plants are provided for suicides.

"Eric" is the code name of "Matt Helm," Donald Hamilton's super-tough secret agent.

"A quiet mission of assassination is no sweat for Matt Helm," advises the cover of "The Ambushers," which goes on to tell how the secret agent is a man "who has to play God."

Harvey Lowmyer, of course, raises the ghost of Lee Harvey Os w I d, assassin of President John Kennedy in 1963. The name "Harvey Low myer" was believed to have been used by the killer of King sometime after Kennedy was shot to death, like King, with a rifle.

Many of the other aliases are non-literary, common names like "James O'C o n n e r," "James McBride," "James Walton" — n a m e s a man named "James Ray" might pick up at a moments notice.

But the Galt and Low myer name's have a strange quality that has given the FBI sleuths cause to pause. Every fact of the literary mystery is being considered by the FBI, but a spokesman was as bewildered as newsmen over what twisted mind would have developed names so loaded with death and with the bizarre

FBI: King Suspect 'Galt'

Is Escaper Named Ray

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The FBI said Friday that the "Eric Starvo Galt" who was sought across the nation for murdering Dr. Martin Luther King was in fact James Earl Ray, who escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary 51 weeks ago.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover said a systematic search of fingerprints uncovered in the case against the prints of more than 53,000 persons led to the determination "that Galt and Rav are identical"

But the announcement raised some perplexing questions. On Wednesday, when Hoover identified Galt as the man sought for conspiracy in the slaying, he said that Galt had taken dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965. But Friday's FBI announcement said Ray was in prison between 1960 and April 23, 1967, when he escaped.

Suspect Sentenced

Ray was sentenced to 20 years on Dec. 18, 1959, on a charge of armed robbery in St. Louis Circuit Court. He and another exconvict, James Owens, were convicted of robbing a St. Louis supermarket of \$190.

deliberated 20 minutes, Ray attempted to escape from the court room by jumping into an elevator. He made two unsuccessful attempts to escape from the Missouri Penitentiary before he succeeded last year.

Hoover did not mention the discrepancies between his statement Wednesday and his latest announcement. FBI officials handed the announcement to reporters but would answer no questions.

The FBI handed out two pictures of Ray taken in 1960. In several ways, they matched pictures of Galt taken in 1968. In both pictures, deep lines ran from the subject's nose to his mouth. The ears looked identical and so did the lines around the eyes.

In its announcement Wednesday the FBI said a warrant had been filed charging that Galt entered into a conspiracy with "an individual whom he alleged to be his brother." It said the conspiracy "continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate Martin Luther King Jr."

Shot From Ambush

King was slain on the porch of a motel in Memphis on April

4. He was shot from ambush by a man in a rundown rooming house across the street. The man escaped in a white Mustang, later found abandoned in Atlanta.

No mention of the alleged brother was made in the new announcement. It was reported Thursday that an informer, cooperating with the FBI, led to a belief that King's slayer was in California.

A reliable source told UPI that FBI agents were in communication with Galt's "alleged brother."

Galt a Loner in Slaying

of Dr. King, FBI Believes

ATLANTA — The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt is the lone subject of the FBI's investigation into Martin Luther King's assassination despite an FBI complaint charging that Galt conspired with his alleged brother in the slaying.

A federal source pointed out to a Los Angeles T i mes reporter that the complaint alleging a conspiracy could have been based on nothing more substantial then testimony by a witness that he had heard Galt say he and a brother planned to kill Dr. King or to use the rifle believed to be the murder weapon.

The FBI apparently knows little about the man called Galt—probably not even whether he has a brother. The complaint charges that "on or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham... Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, enter e red into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968." to violate King's civil rights.

The civil rights law does not authorize federal prosecution unless thert is evidence of a consolracy.

SEVERAL SOURCES have said said purchased two rines from a Birmingham sporting goods store on March 29 and made a remark to the sales clerk that could have formed the basis for the conspiracy charge. He reportedly purchased a .243 Remington rifle, then returned later in the day and exchanged it for a 30.06 rifle, declaring that he and his brother had decided the .243 was a heavier cartridge load and not suit ed for their hunting purposes.

Dr. King was injured fatally by a sniper on April 4 while standing on a balcony outside his Memphis motel room. A white Mustang registered in Galt's name and resembling one witnesses said fled the assassination scene was found abandoned in a public housing parking lot in Atlanta on April 11. Witnesses here said a man parked the car and left it early on the morning of April 5.

Indications are that Galt left a cold trail, but a federal source in Birmingham close to the investigation said the government has "a very strong case" if the subject can be apprehended. The assassin left a trail of clues, including the 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic site, but the FBI apparently has been unable to establish whether Galt is his real name or to locate anyone who knew anything about him prior to recent years.

MEANWHILE, THE SEARCH for Galt continues with scores of FBI a g e n t s scouring the Birmingham, Memphis and Atlanta areas for pe r s o n s where the mave seen him. In Birmingham,



FBI Names Killer of Dr. King

WASHINGTON (AP) — The FBI Friday identified Eric Starvo Galt, wanted for the killing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., a's James Earl Ray, 40, an escapee from the Missouri State Penitentiary.

The FBI said he was identified through "a systematic and exhaustive search of latent fin-gerprints" uncovered in the King case against the fingerprints of the more than 53,000 persons for whom wanted notices are on file in the bureau's identification division.

Ray was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City April 23, 1967. He was serving a 20year sentence for an armed robbery in St. Louis and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission.

Ray, who had been at the prison since March 17, 1960, spent some time in September 1966 in the maximum security ward at the state hospital in Fulton, Mo.

The man known as Galt was charged Wednesday with the first-degree murder of King April 4 in Memphis, Tenn. He also is charged in a federal warrant with conspiracy and murder in the King assassination.

The FBI said Ray has an arrest record dating at least to 1949, when he was convicted for

He has served terms in a Los Angeles County jail, state prisons at Joliet and Pontiac, Ill., and a federal penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kan.

The FBI said Ray has used the names of James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conner.

Ray claims to have been born March 10, 1928 in Illinois-but the FBI did not say where. He is about 5-feet-10, weighs 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair and two scars: A small one on the center of his forehead and another on the palm of his right hand.
