

# WANTED BY THE FBI



JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, Harvey Lowmyer, John Willard, James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conner.

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee, sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., is one of the FBI's "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives." FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Top Ten" list to insure widespread dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to

speed his location.

Ray has been intensively sought since the murder of Dr. King

Ray has been intensively sought since the murder of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices were posted, determined that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias of Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen. Ray, who escaped on April 23, 1967, from the Missouri State Penitentiary, is also sought for unlawful flight to avoid confinement for robbery. His long criminal record also includes convictions for burglary and forging U.S. Postal Money Orders.

A white American, born in Alton, Illinois, on March 10, 1928, Ray is 5'10'' tall, weighs 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and short brown hair. He has a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe and his left ear protrudes noticeably. Known as a "loner" and "drifter," Ray has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher. He has taken dancing lessons and completed a course at a school of bartending.

On 4/4/68, Mrs. MEYER and her husband, CHARLES boarded the Seaboard Coast Line train, The Champion, at 2:00 p.m., headed for their home in Waverly. On the evening of 4/4/68, an unknown male, boarded the train somewhere around Jacksonville, Florida. Unknown male sat in same car with the MEYERS car, #32, seats 3 and 4. He sat with two elderly women, one of whom was a retired Woolworth Company employee from Newark, New Jersey, and the other was a resident of Pennsylvania. Mrs. MEYER did not know their names, however, determined that they boarded the train at Sarastoa, Florida. During the trip unknown male was very attentive to the two women. ALLEN JEROME WATSON, Box 105 South Shore Road, Corinth, New York, was interviewed at the Broughton Corporation, where he is employed as a turret lathe operator. He advised that he has been employed since April of 1962, at the Broughton Corporation, after having come to the area from Arlington, Texas, where he was raised. WATSON advised that he was on vacation from his job from April 1 through 7, 1968, because his daughter. PAMEIA LOU WATSON was hospitalized in the Adirondack Regional Hospital, Corinth, New York, with a bronchial condition. Her doctor is LEO GIORDANO, of Luzerne, New York. WATSON stated that he spent almost all of his time either caring for the youngsters who were home or visiting PAMELA in the hospital. It was while visiting her there that he first received work of the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHEREKING. He said he never left the Corinth area during the period of his vacation.

Continuing, WATSON stated that he could not understand why he was being interviewed in this regard, since he had never expressed any particular dislike for Negroes. He said that the FBI would have no trouble proving that he was in this area during the entire period.

WATSON was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, and said that it was unfamiliar. He said that he has no idea as to who KING's assassin was and he is anxious to have the murderer arrested. He continued that he has not been out of the State of New York since 1965, when he left for about three weeks to go to Alexandria, Virginia from where he soon returned to this area. He was last in Memphis, Tenessee, about ten years ago, when he passed through it by bus on a trip to Florida, en route from Texas.

On May 8, 1968, CLIVER MYER, 21 Thoga Street, Waverly, New York, retired school teacher and former village road commissioner and trustee, was interviewed at his residence in the presence of his wife. CHARLOTTE MYER, MYER furnished the following information.

He and his wife observed the photographs of JAMES EARL RAY in the May 8, 1968, issue of the Elmira Star Gazette. He and his wife observed RAY or a man strongly resembling RAY on the same train that they took from Orlando, Flopida, to New York State, The man did not resemble the photograph of RAY waering the sun glasses but did strongly resemble the photograph of RAY wearing a tie, shirt and suitcoat.

They had been in Florida visiting their son. JOHN D.M. MYER at Indian Harbor Beach, Florida. They returned to New York State via the Seaboard Coast Line Train "The Champion, car 32, leaving Orlando, Florida, at 2:00 PM on April 4, 1968. Sometime prior to 5:00 PM at a stop or two before the J Jacksonville, Florida, stop, a white male, 38 to 45, 5'11", 165-170 lbs, medium build, dark hair, cleft in chin, boarded this train. This man very strongly resembled the photograph of RAY. This man remained on the train all night, leaving the train at Baltimore, Maryland, or a stop before

Baltimore. The train arrived in Baltimore about 8:30 AM on April 5, 1968. This man acted strange and they were a little suspicious of him. He was on the train for the entire period 5:00 PM 4-4-68 until approximately 8:30 AM 4-5-68.

In as much as this individual would have been on the train at the time KING was shot, no further investigation is being conducted.

He stated both RICH and RAY also in hospital at Missouri State Prison after both contracted hepatitis after using needle to "shoot it up". He advised that RICH has a picture of RAY in his wallet and has received some letters from Canada possibly dealing with RAY's whereabouts. He stated RICH has a lengthy arrest record.

The unknown caller inquired as to whether there was a reward outstanding for information leading to the location and arrest of RAY. He was advised that there was no Federal reward outstanding, but the State of Tennessee had offered a reward. He said that he could be known by the number "148" if his information was of alue and he merited any kind of a reward.

The above information was telephonically furnished to SA JOHN F. CURRAN to handle.

Mr. DONALD BROTON, Textile Marking Machine Company, 2204 Erie Boulevard, East, Syracuse, New York, advised upon examining a color photograph of a tee-shirt and pair of men's shorts, both of which bore a laundry mark on a red colored tape, that this laundry mark was made by a thermo-seal machine, that the code on the tape, which he could state was not code recommended by the company, was undoubtedly 02B-6. He further stated that undoubtedly this mark had been made by a machine which was in good condition with a new ribbon and that in all probability the clothing had not been worn since the laundry mark was put on the garments.

Mr. MOTON stated that the mark was made by a machine which was rather unusual in that out of a total of approximately 3,500 such machines made, this particular mark would have been made by one of between five and ten machines.

He stated that this code marking was made by a machine which had five character designation. He noted that the dash in the code was also a character. He stated that these characters would be as follows:

The first two characters would be 15 point type and the last three characters would be 18 point type with the middle character, that is the letter B in the above code, a narrow rather than a regular size type.

Mr. BROTON noted that the normal make-up of thermoseal machines with five characters would be for the first three characters to be 15 point type and the last two characters, 18 regular point type.

Mr. BROTON made records available which disclosed the identities of locations of machines capable of producing the above code.

The infomant stated that there are people in Syracuse who are teaching hate, but that these people are receiving very little support. Informant pointed to the inability of the NOI to establish a mosque in Syracuse, as very good proof of this fact.

Informant stated that there are areas of disagreement, and there are many things that many Negroes in Syracuse are striving for, but Black Nationalism was not one of them.

157-2344 Informant stated on 2/27/68, that the Stake and Take Restaurant which had been operated by the NOI in Syracuse, had a sign in the window indicating that the restaurant was closed over the weekend; however, subsequently on that date the informant had observed that the restaurant was in operation.

On 3/8/68, the infomant advised that four individuals had been observed on the corner of East Genesee Street and University Avenue distributing the Muslim paper. Informant stated that these individuals were well-dressed and were

most assuredly from out of town, but none of them were recognized. Informant stated that there was little or notinterest in anything that these individuals were doing.

Informant stated on 3/14/68, that the NOI individuals who were distributing papers previously had not been seen since the previous week.

157-257 On 3/14/68, informant advised that CHRISTOPHER POWELL was still publishing his paper, "The Hometown News", and that there was no indication that the paper was going to go out of business of to move its location from the East Genesee Street address.

On 4/25/68, the informant stated that the paper was still being published by the subject, as the newspaper had been observed on the previous date at a grocery store. Informant stated there were still no indications that the paper would go out of business.

Informant stated regarding this individual that the subject is not speaking in any way in the statements made by him before various groups for the Negro community. Informant stated that there is no reason to believe that subject is considered by the Negro community to be a leader, and that there is no indication that the subject could obtain any leadership position no matter how hard he might try.

157-255 On 3/14/68, the informant advised that no information had been received regarding ERLE IRONS since last contact. Informant stated that no information had been received from usual sources regarding IRONS and whether he had returned to Syracuse.

On 4/25/68, informant stated that there was still no information indicating that ERLE IRONS was residing or working in the Syracuse area.

157-256 Informant advised that JONATHAN WILLIAMS is allegedly the treasurer of the Poor People's March. Informant stated that it is informant's belief that this is the kind of thing that WILLIAMS has wanted to do since he got involved in the civil rights movement.

Informant recalls that WILLIAMS made a statement on one occasion during the days that he was involved with CCRE, stating that he would like to become treasurer of the organization. Informant believes that subject would steal whatever he can from the Poor People's March without making it too obvious, and that his sole purpose is in making himself look like a big shot.

100-20139 Informant stated that there has been no outstanding activity connected with the Ten Days of Protest in the Negro community, although the informant noted that there was a play presented at the Regent Theatre on 4/24/68, entitled, "Something from the Center" which was a rather hateful oracle.
