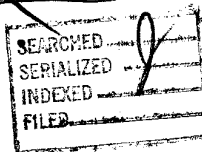

By airtel 5/7/68, the Bureau advised that Memphis has been designated OO in this case.

On 4/26/68, Lt. KENNETH KENNEDY, Albany PD, was contacted in regard to subject, JAMES EARL RAY. Lt. KENNEDY advised that there were no known "hippie" rooming houses in the Albany area. He said that the "hippie" element resided wherever they could find shelter, not in any particular district. It would be a very difficult task to find where all the "hippies" were living. He said that some of the "hippie" element was known to frequent the UN Diner at 11 New Scotland Avenue. Lt. KENNEDY was advised to be on the alert for JAMES EARL RAY.

Bureau has advised as follows in connection with captioned case:

"There has been speculation that James Earl Ray concocted the alias of Eric Starvo Galt by combining the names of characters from books by Ian Fleming and from a book "Atlas Shrugged" by Ayn Rand. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family."

The Bureau further advised that in view of the above and in order that agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of RAY's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, a complete list of various characters utilized in these books has been forwarded and is being maintained in the Albany file in captioned case.

All agents handling leads in this case should be alert to this possibility.

In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to

unidentified dead for the period beginning 4-5-68; and if fingerprints on such dead are maintained, they should be compared with those on the Identification Order on Ray in order to effect identification or nonidentification. This should be handled in the normal course of business and only reasonable investigation should be pursued along these lines.

The Identification Division has placed an appropriate stop on unidentified deceased inquiries it may receive. If feasible, appropriate offices and Legats, Mexico City and Ottawa should place similar stops with appropriate state, local or national agencies in your territories.

Result of examination:

It was concluded that none of the machines used to prepare K227 through K238 was employed in preparing the laundry marks appearing on Q69 and Q70 and that the machine used to prepare K228 was not used to prepare the laundry marks appearing on Q97 and Q99.

Differences were noted between the tapes designated K227 and K229 through K235 when compared with the laundry marks appearing on Q97 and Q99, but the lack of sufficient identifying features precluded a definite opinion from being reached.

Specimens K236, K237 and K238 are not adequate for comparison with the laundry marks on Q97 and Q99. The submitted items have been retained.

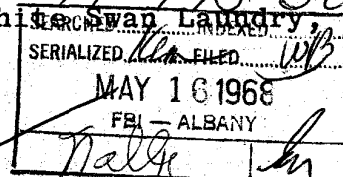

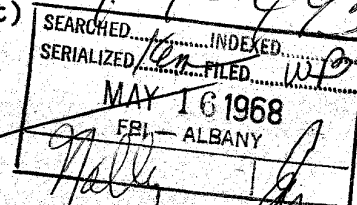

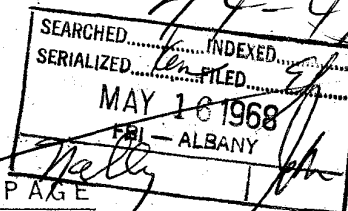

Details have been furnished to Captain PHILLIP VANDERBECK, Binghamton PD and Lt. ARTHUR KELLY, Broome County SO, regarding subject and they will bear in mind the possibility of subject being involved in major thefts, BBs, or larcenies.

On 5/2/68, Lt. ARTHUR KELLY, Broome County SO, and Sgt. CARL JOHNSON, Binghamton PD, both in charge of Identification Bureaus of their respective agencies, advised that they maintain a few unidentified latent fingerprints and have compared subject's prints with them with negative results. They advised they would maintain this information and compare any acquired unidentified latents in the future with those of the subject.
