At approx 10:35 a.m. ⁴⁻¹³⁻⁶⁸ she departed Chicago, Ill on Flight No. 157 (TWA) at O'Hare Airport. Prior to her departure she had noted a white male at the boarding area who appeared to be very nervous. When this individual noticed she was watching him he left the area and was observed talking briefly to another white male.

The w/m subsequently boarded the plane with her and obviously attempted to see what she was writing (she was making notes concerning his actions). After boarding the plane the w/m went out of his way to obtain a seat behind Miss Egan.

Miss Egan stated she became suspicious of the individual after hearing the investigation for Dr. King's murderer was centering in the mid-west.
